

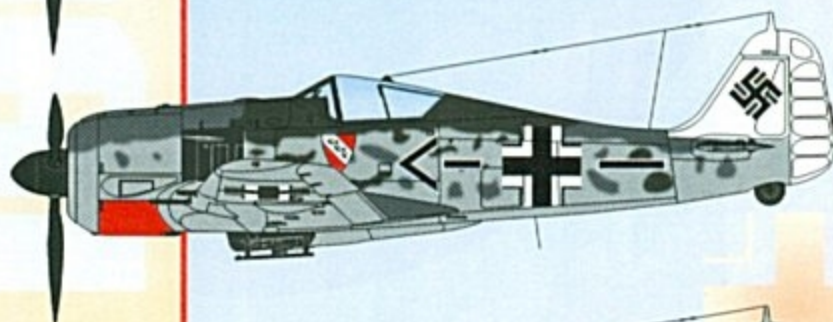

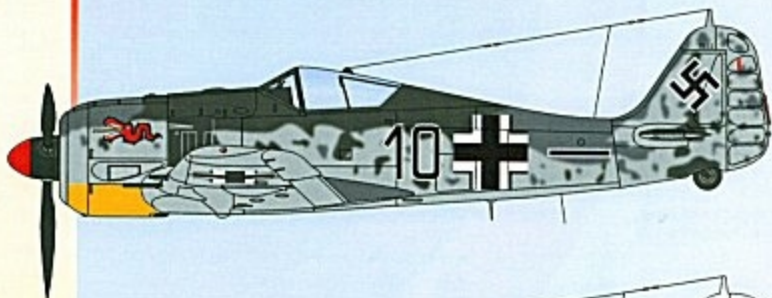

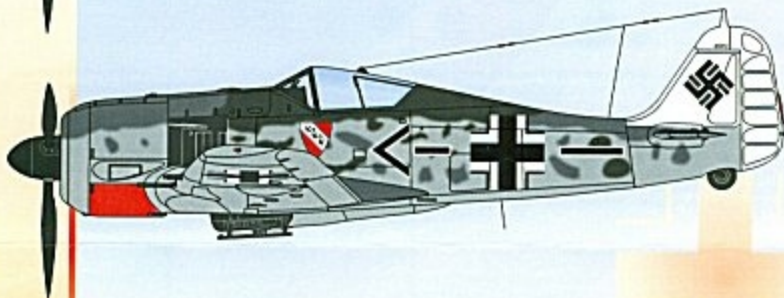

January 1943. Red spinner tip and
Yellow lower cowlng.



A/C#2. FW-190 A-5, W. Nr. 410012,
stab JG1, September 1943. Black or
RLM 70 propeller/spinner with Red
lower cowlng. White tail with
swastika showing RLM 76
camouflage between the arms.

camouflage of RLM 74/75/76 on all
these A/C. Very light fuselage
mottling.

unknown, 10/JG1. Flown by UFFZ.
