

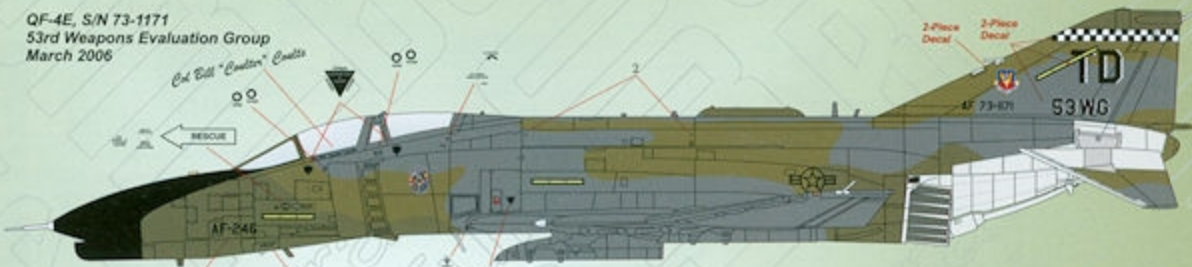

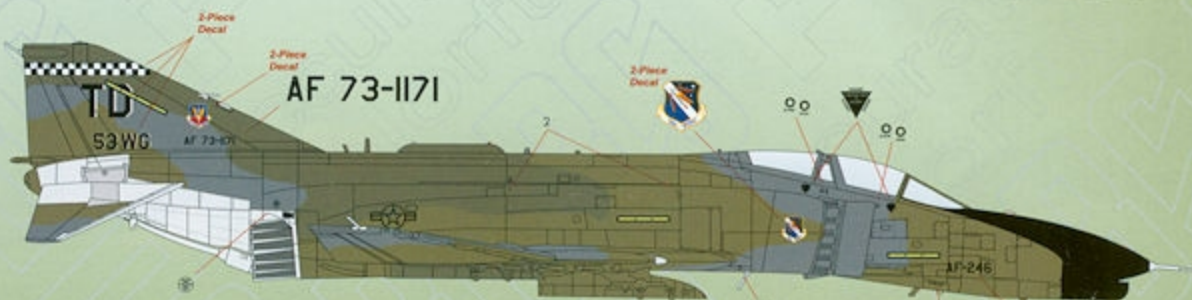

#### QF-4E Modifications

BAE Flight Systems in Mojave, CA is the contractor that performs all of the modifications to these A/C. These mods are quite extensive when you realize what's going on "under the skin". On the exterior though, there are only a few minor differences between a line aircraft and a drone A/C.

Most of them are antenna related. These extra antennas are added for scoring, telemetry and remote pilot operation and are very easy to add to your kit. Luckily, Twobob's Resin has come to the rescue and their QF-4E resin conversion set can be used to perform all of these mods.
