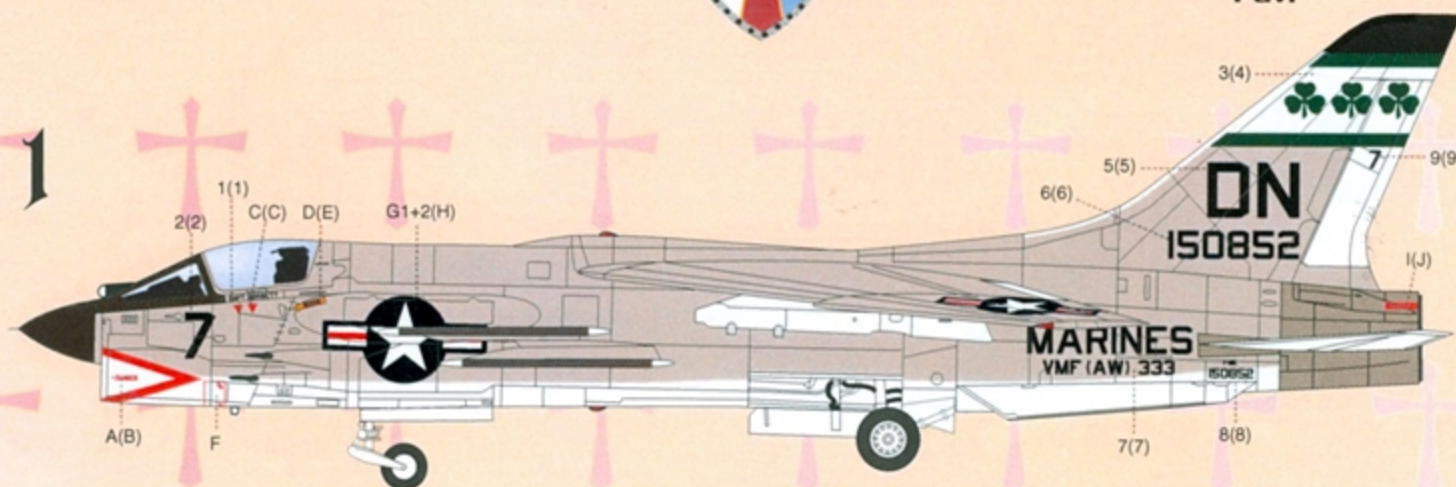

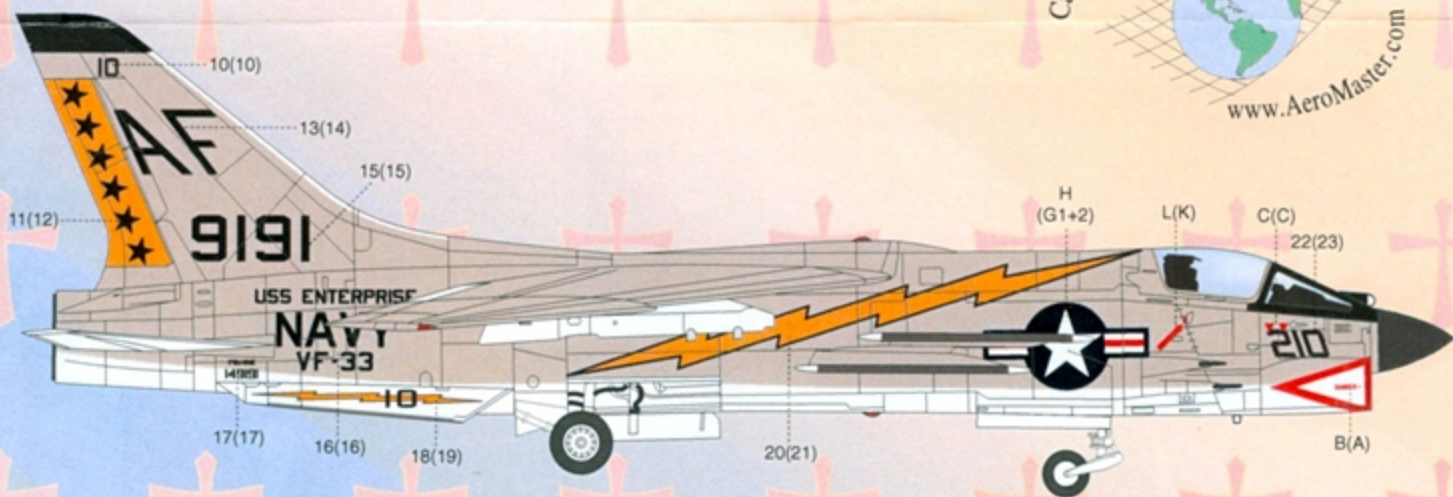

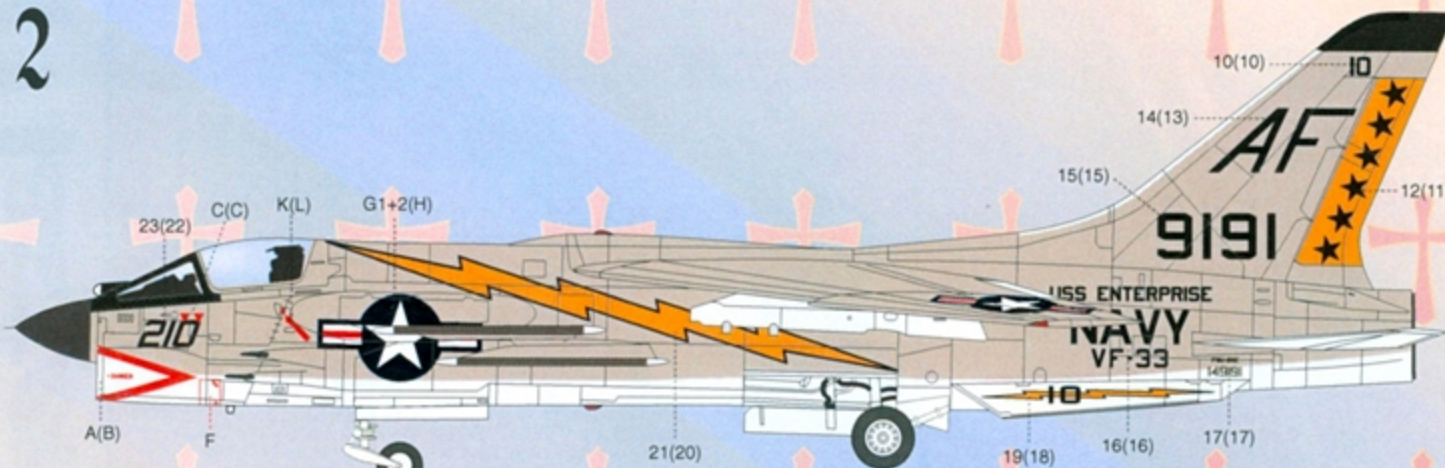

Assemble insignia parts as shown when in-flight refueling door is to be opened. Center red stripes in the bars. Note the left and right hand bars.

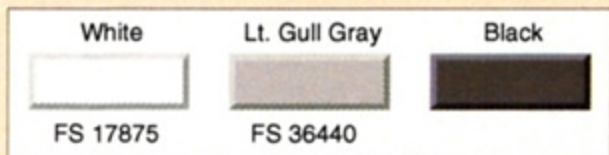


Modeller must remove the fin ECM bump as shown.
