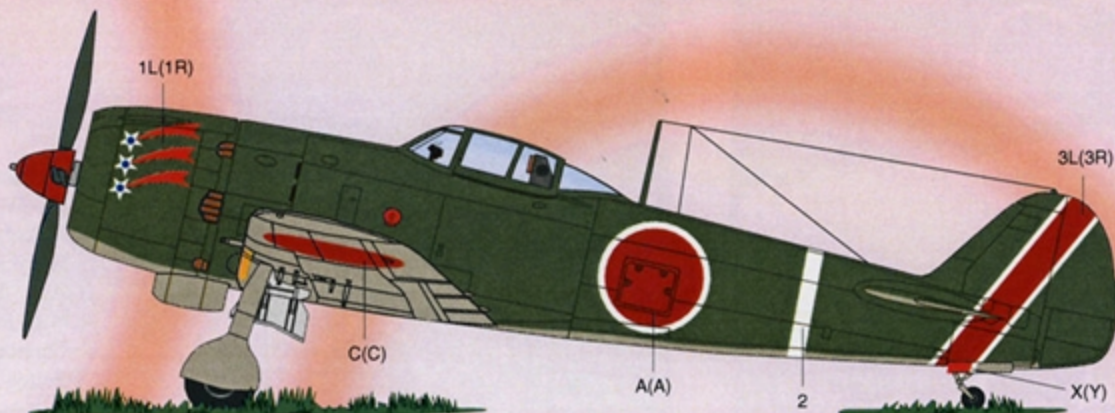

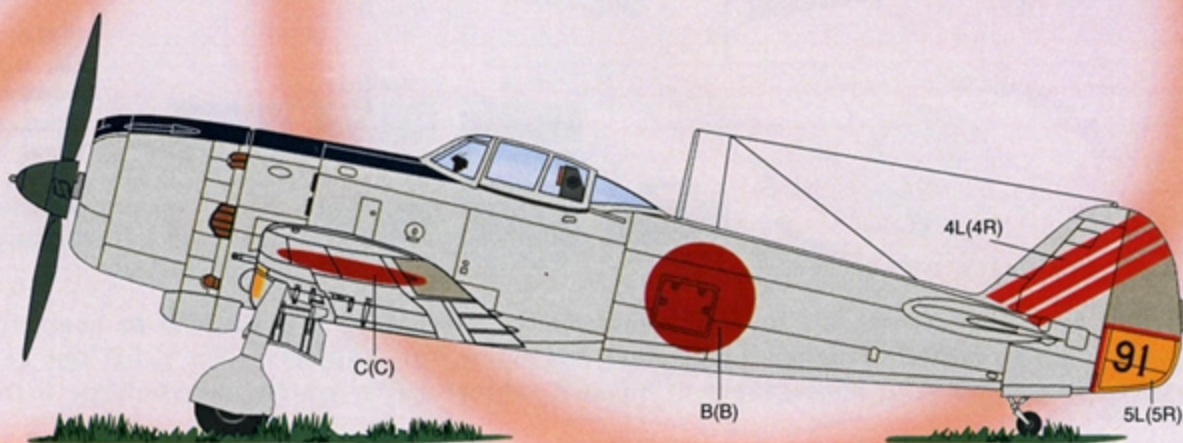

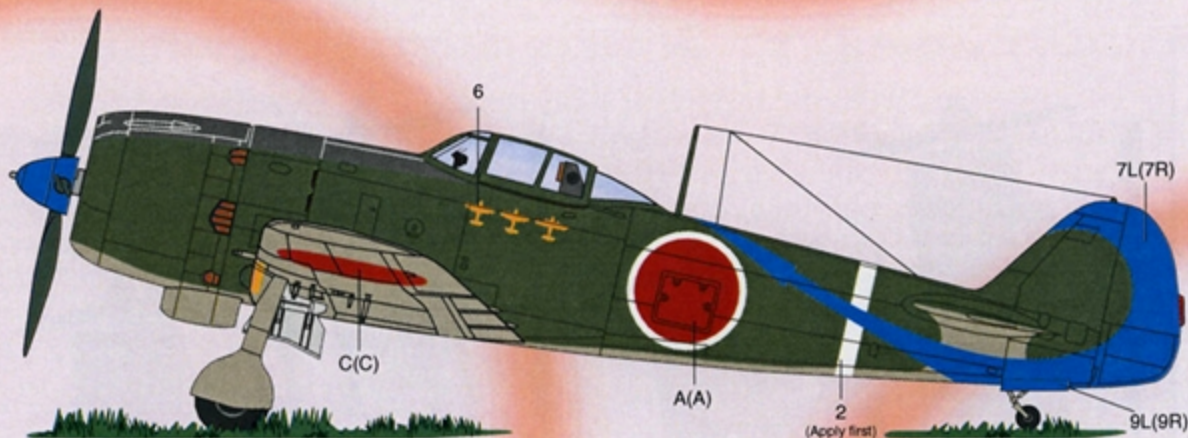

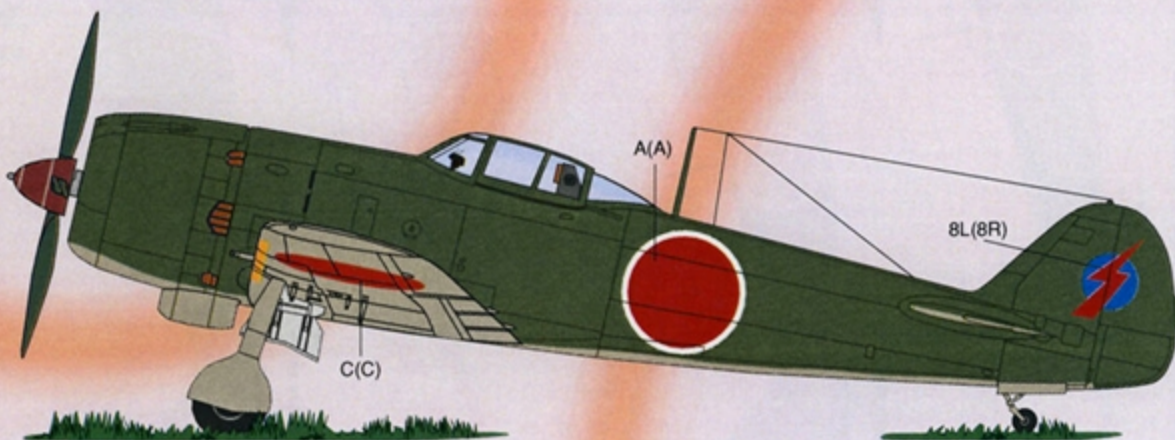
Ki-84Ko Hayate, 73rd Hiko-Sentai, 2nd Chutai, Philippines, October, 1944. Natural metal overall with Black anti-glare panel. Dark Gray/Green spinner/prop assembly and Gray/Green ailerons, elevators and rudder.



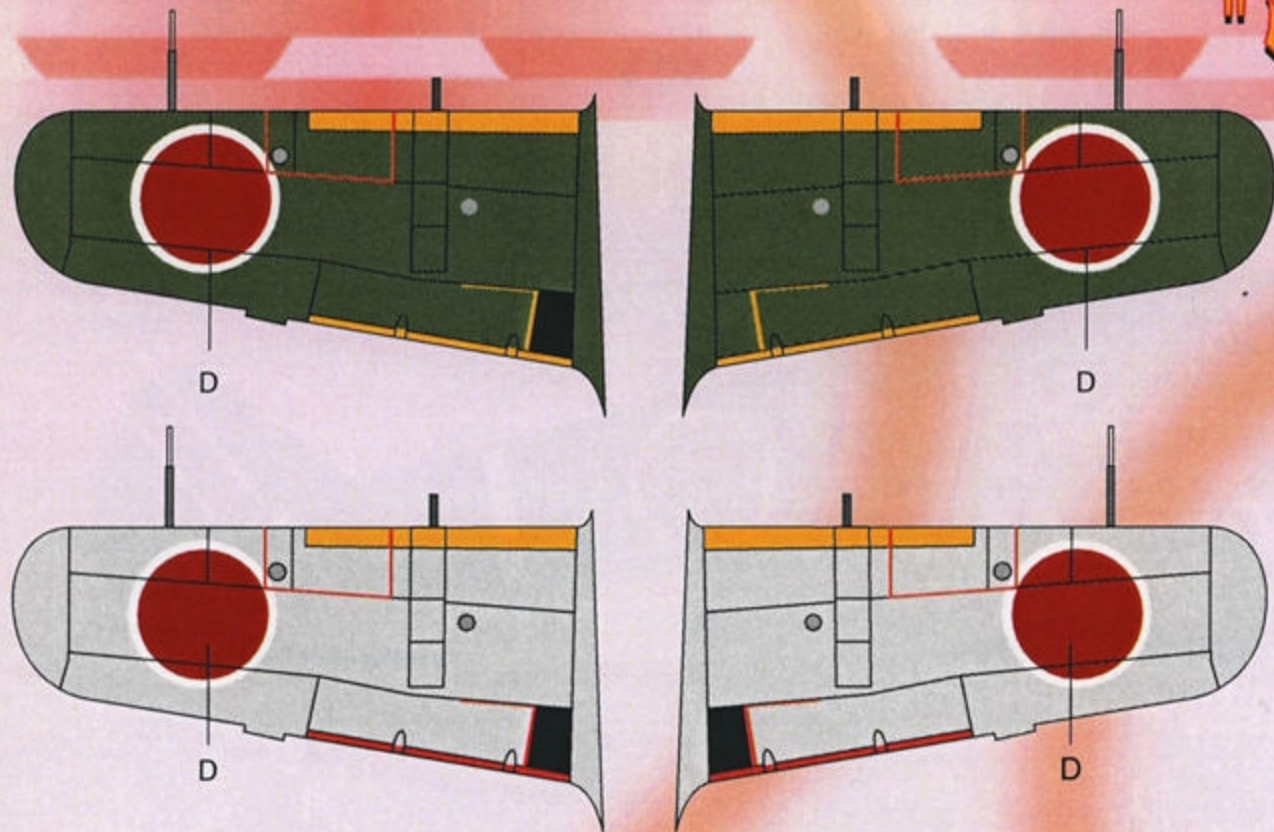
Ki-84a Hayate, 29th Air Combat Regiment, HQ Company, Taichu, Formosa, summer 1945. Upper surfaces Nakajima Dark Green, lower surfaces Gray/Green. Inner leading edges of wing Yellow. Spinner Blue to match tail design. Anti-glare panel faded flat Black. Rudder trim tab Red.



Ki-84a Hayate, 13th Air Combat Regiment, Thailand, 1945. Upper surfaces Nakajima Dark Green, lower surfaces Gray/Green. Inner leading edges of wing Yellow. Spinner IJAAF Red Brown.

**NOTE:**

Flat Black or very Dk. Blue/ Black antiglare panel. Propellers are a Gray Green color (just a little lighter than uppersurfaces). Wheel wells are natural metal. Cockpit interior is also believed to have been Natural Metal with a coat of clear protective lacquer. Use stencil and wing walk markings from the kit decal. SAYONARA!
