

The loadout for Victory 103 on both missions, as was for all of VF-103 during cruise, was:

2 GBU-12 2 AIM-9 Lantirn



Victory 101 F-14B Tarps Upgrade Buno 162705

Victory 101 was officially the last VF-103 Tomcat to ever launch from an aircraft carrier.

During cruise Victory 101 was the victim of a catastrophic engine failure. Fortunately the aircrew and the aircraft were sitting on the cat waiting to launch when the engine siezed.

Both 110 and 111 dropped GBU-12's during Operation Phantom Fury.

Victory 110 dropped 2 bombs on one mission and a single bomb on a second.

Victory 111 dropped both it's bombs on a single mission.

Officially launched 8 Nov 04 after weeks of aerial and artillery strikes, the goal was to regain control of Fallujah before National Elections in Jan 05. VF-103 flew numerous Close Air Support and other missions, logging more action than any other F-14 squadron since OIF.

In the 4 months VF-103 was on station in the NAG, a total of 21 GBU's were dropped and nearly 400 sorties flown.
