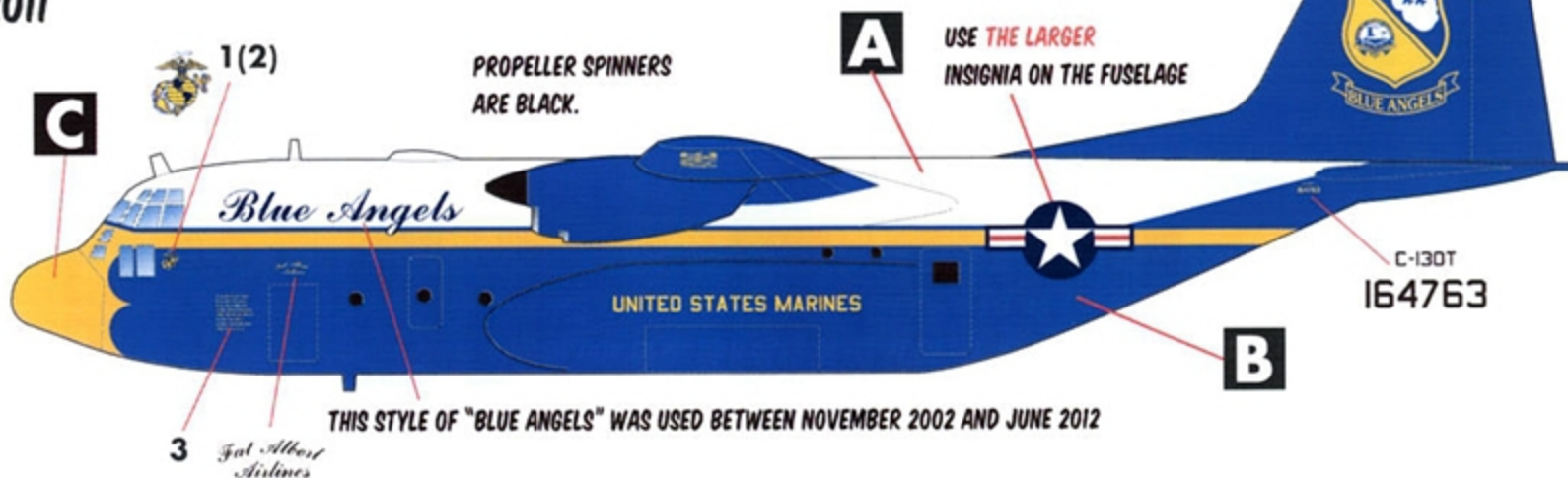

C-130T BUNO. 164763 HAS BEEN ASSIGNED TO THE BLUE ANGELS SINCE NOVEMBER 2002.

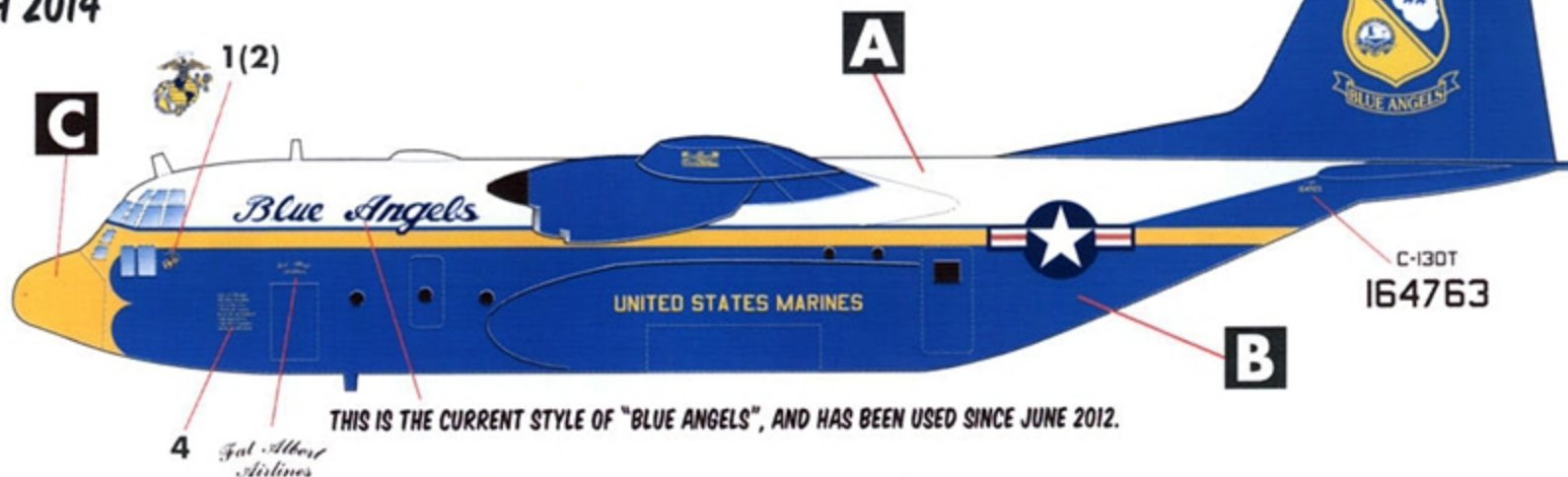


WE RECOMMEND USING THE NATIONAL INSIGNIA AS A TEMPLATE FOR THE THICKNESS OF THE YELLOW AND BLUE LINES ON THE FUSELAGE. NOTE HOW THE YELLOW STRIPE IS ABOUT THE SAME THICKNESS AS THE WHITE PART OF THE NATIONAL INSIGNIA, AND THE BLUE STRIPE MATCHES THE THICKNESS OF THE BLUE BORDER OF THE INSIGNIA.

THE **LARGER** INSIGNIA ON THE DECAL SHEET ARE FOR THE FUSELAGE, THE **SMALLER** FOR THE WINGS!

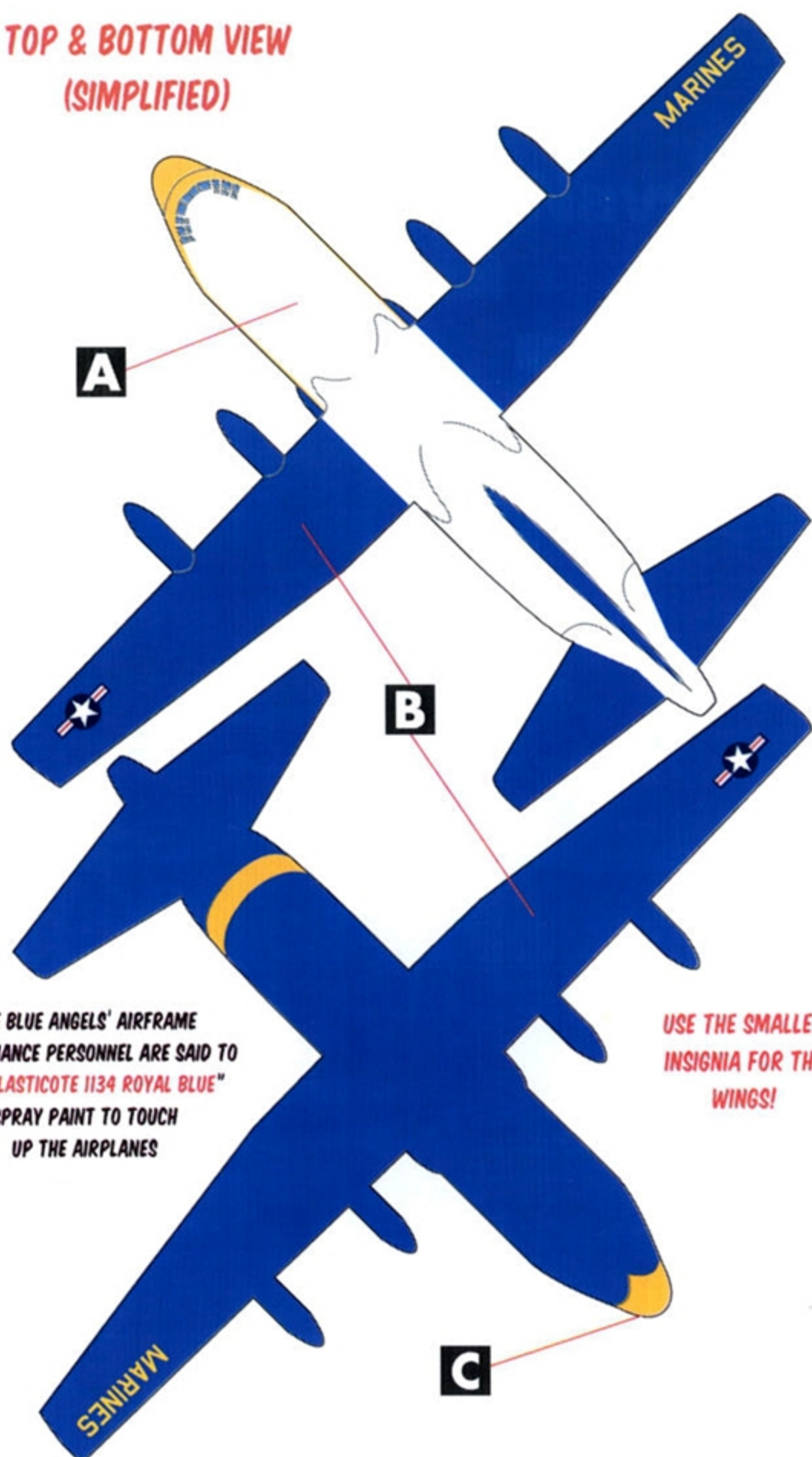
THIS OPTION DEPICTS 164763 AFTER IT RETURNED FROM MAINTENANCE IN EARLY 2012.



"FAT ALBERT" IS TECHNICALLY A KC-130T. THESE AIRCRAFT ARE BASICALLY THE SAME AIRFRAME AS C-130H, BUT ARE EQUIPPED WITH T56-A-423 ENGINES. YOU CAN USE THE TESTORS / ITALERI C-130E/H KIT AS THE BASIS OF YOUR PROJECT, AND MODIFY THE ANTENNA FIT USING THE PHOTOGRAPHS AT THE REFERENCE PAGE.
