

Fw 190D-9's

Fw-1900-9 of ILJG301, Straubing. Bavaria Spring, 1945, RLM 83 Dunkelgrün and RLM 75 Grauviolet over RLM 76 Lichtblau with very light fus-elage, and moderate fin-and-runder mottling. Black spinner with White spiral. Reference 5, page 4 shows the style of the #5 on Blue 15. Wr.Nr. unknown. A fictitious number has been provided in case you want to use it. Your choice.


Focke-Wulf Fw-1900-9 of II.JG6, Furth, Germany, Spring, 1945, with unusual rank and tactical markings. RLM 83 Dunkelgrün and RLM 75 Grauviolet over RLM 76 Lichtblau with a sparse motting of RLM 83 Durwelgrün on the fin and nudder. Black sonner. Fuselage extension was Natural Metal, heavily splotched with a Dark Gray, or perhaps there was a Reich Defense band, overpainted with a dark color, Ref. 6, back cover.

Focke-Wuf Fw-190D-9 of II.JG26 abandoned at Celle, Spring, 1945. This aircraft appears to wear an unusual scheme of RLM 83 Dunkelgrün and RLM 81 Brunviolet (not RLM 75) over RLM 76 Lichtotau. Black spinner with white spiral. Notice splotches on L. G. covers, possibly RLM 83. Ref. 5 page 2, Ref. 1 page 77, back cover.
