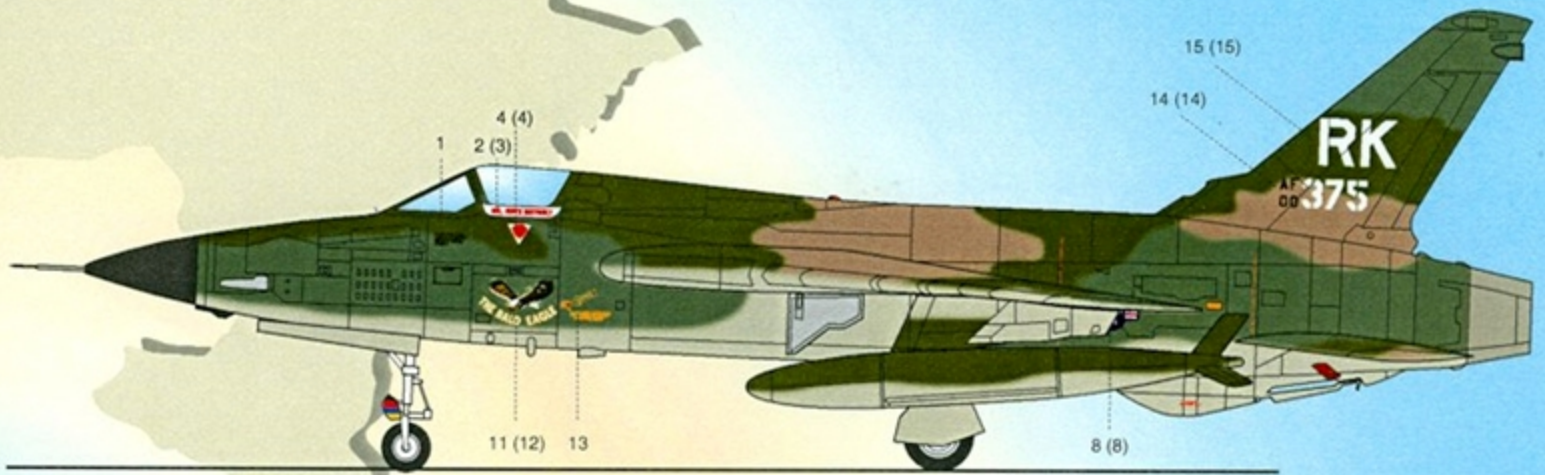

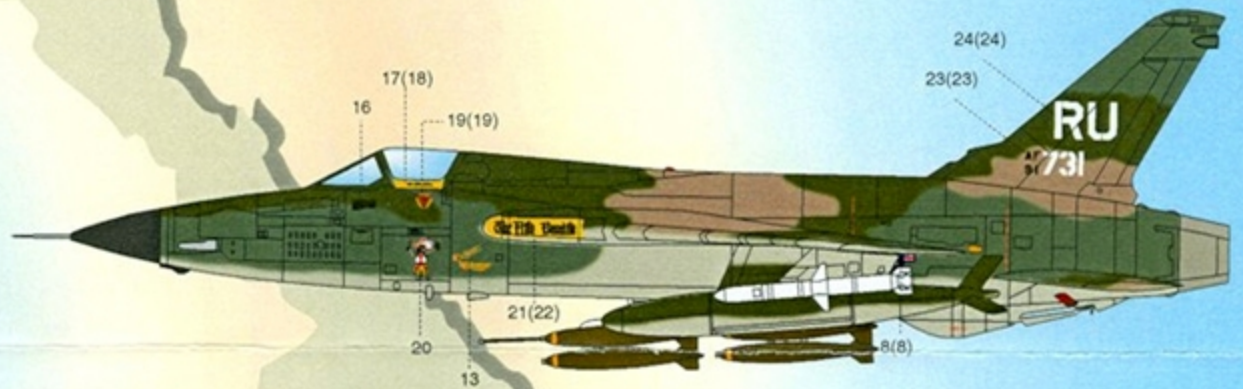

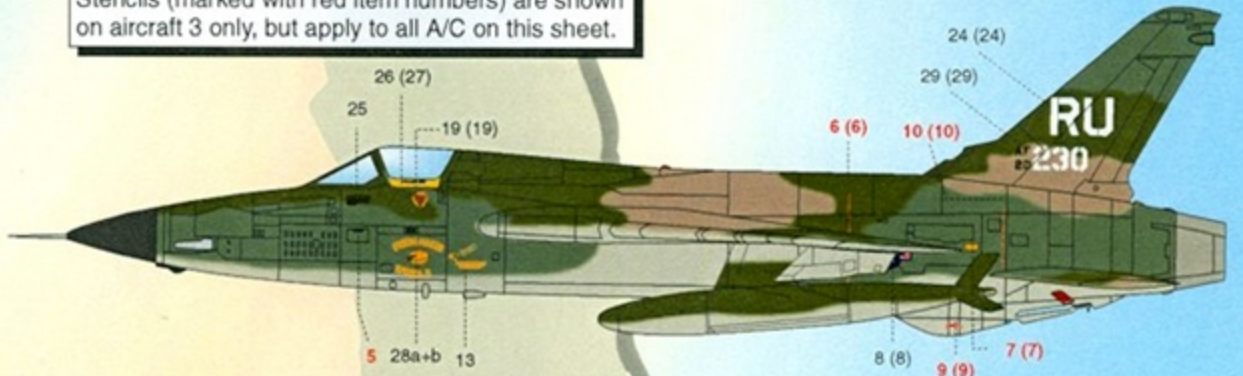

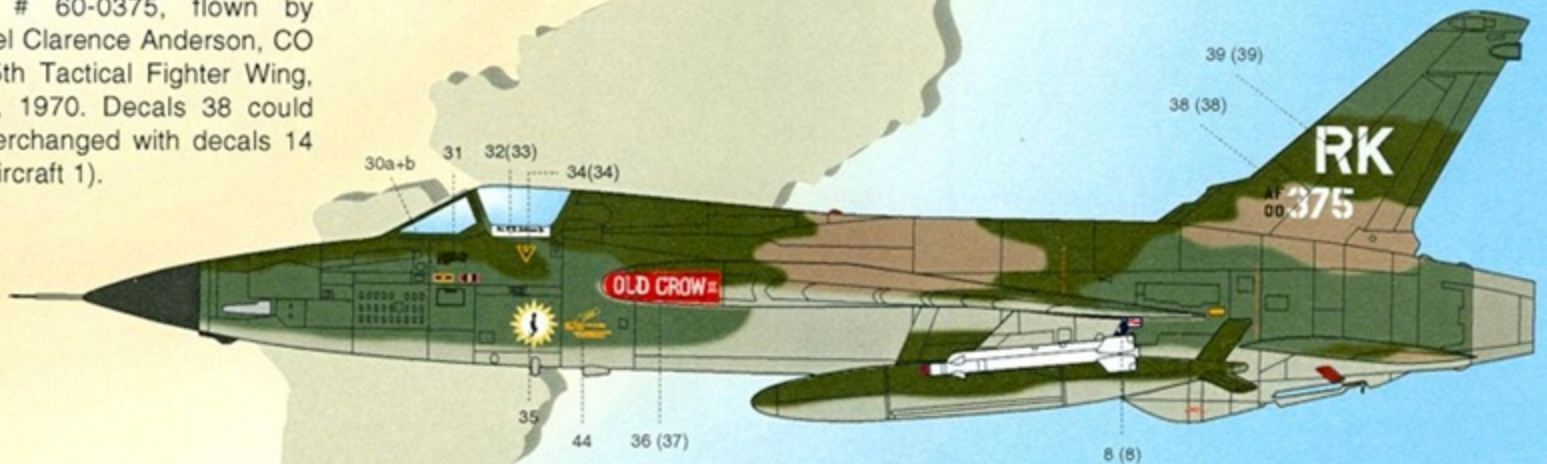

Stencils (marked with red item numbers) are shown on aircraft 3 only, but apply to all A/C on this sheet.

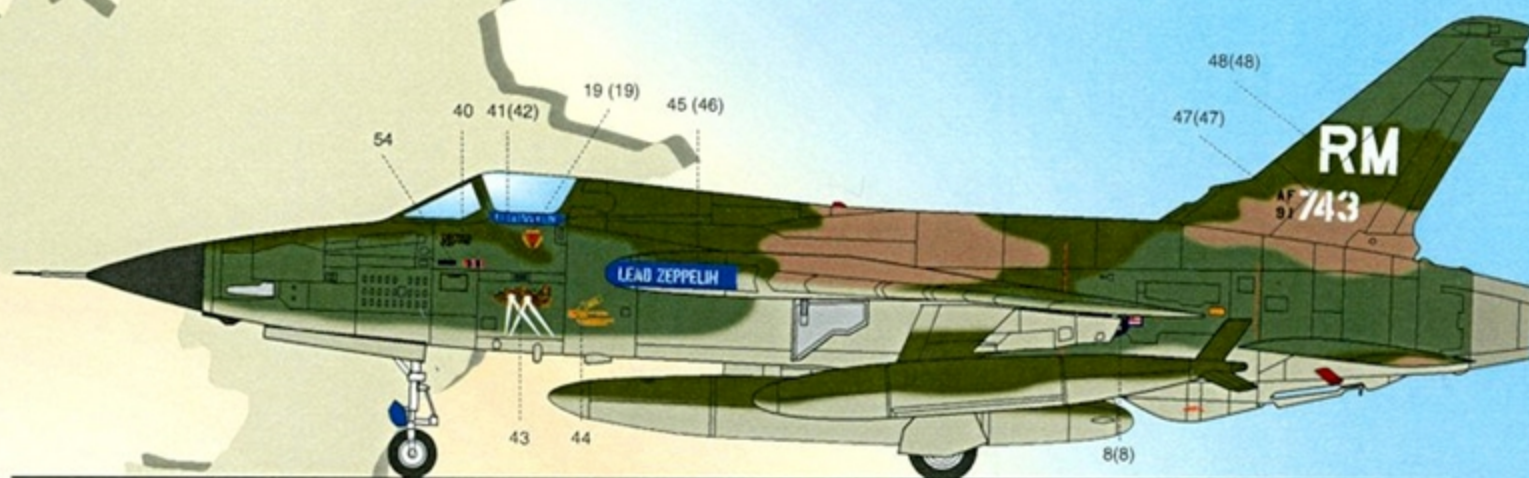

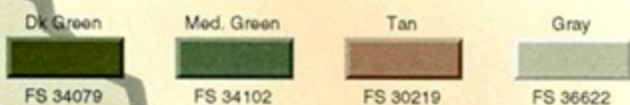

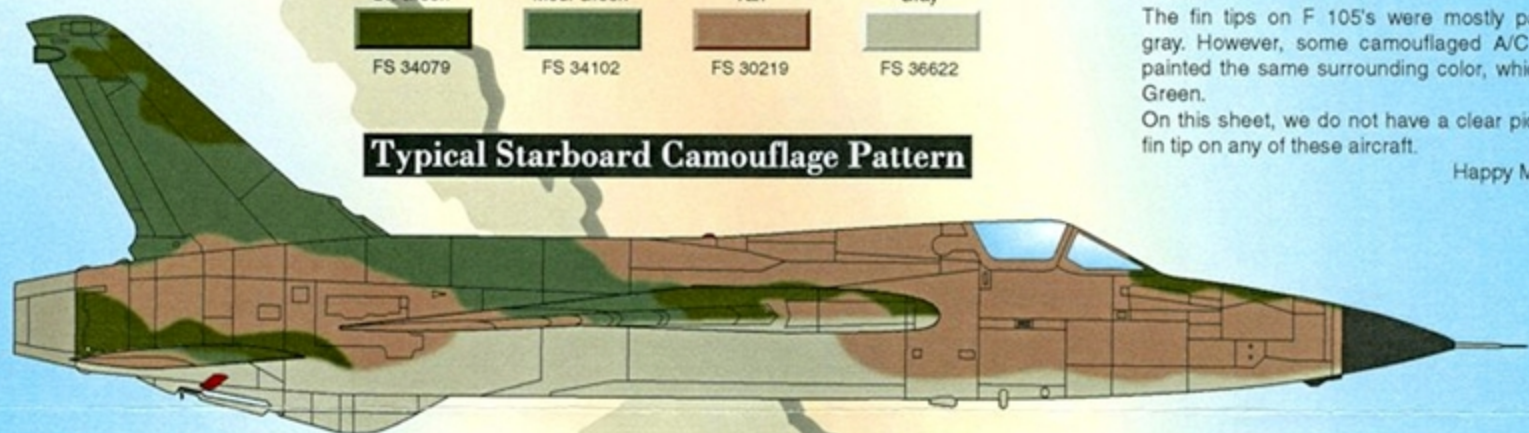
Typical Starboard Camouflage Pattern

The fin tips on F 105's were mostly painted light gray. However, some camouflaged A/C had them painted the same surrounding color, which was Dk Green.

On this sheet, we do not have a clear picture of the fin tip on any of these aircraft.
