




True

Colouring Note

The F.W.44J. "Stieglitz" was used by many Air Forces in the years 1932-1945. These included Finland, Sweden, Rumania, Turkey, China, Bolivia, Chile, and of course Germany; both during WW2 and before Nazi dictator-ship.

The Aircraft depicted in the 3 View (D-2692) was one of these, it sported the Black-White-Red pre Swastika Tailmarkings. The Aircraft was finished overall in Hellgrau 63 with all codes in Black. The cheat line marking on the fuselage was in Rot 23 with the top decking in Schwarz 22. All struts were Hellgrau 63, with the cockpit in RLM02 Grau, with the Prop in Natural Wood.

The engine was Gun Metal with the Cylinder Caps in Aluminium. The Collector Ring & Exhaust pipe were a Rusty Brown colour.

The Swedish variant (SK12 Designation) was one of the most colourful, being finished with Black-Green fuselage and fin and Wings and Tail in Bright Orange. The Rudder had Yellow and Medium Blue vertical stripes wing markings in the old "White Disk with Black Crowns" style. The planes were so coloured to aid detection in case of a forced landing.
