

This Bf109D-1 of JG 132 Richthofen wears a different pattern of RLM 70 Schwarzgrün and RLM 71 Dunkelgrün over RLM 65 Hellblau. Note the black prop and RLM 70 spinner. See page 82.

This Bf109C-1 of JG 130 wears the same pattern as the Bf-109C, above: RLM 70 Schwarzgrün and RLM 71 Dunkelgrün over RLM 65 Hellblau. Black prop and RLM 70 spinner with white center band. See page 81.

This He51B-1 of JG 135 wears RLM 63 Hellgrau overall with blue flashing and 600mm fuselage band. RLM 63 prop spinner with blue tip. RLM 63 prop blades. Note the aluminum drop tank assembly. A handed version of decal 23 (decal 24) is provided — just in case. We cannot determine if decal 21 appeared on the starboard side, but an extra is also provided — again, just in case. See page 60.
