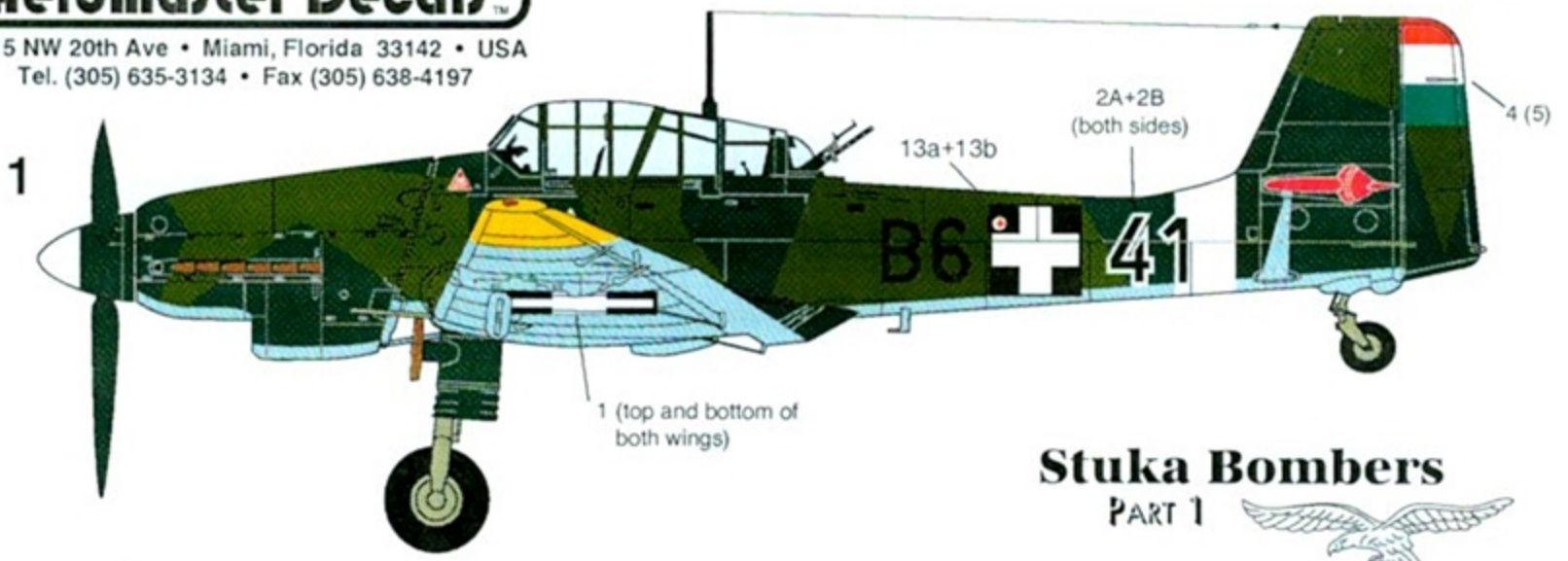

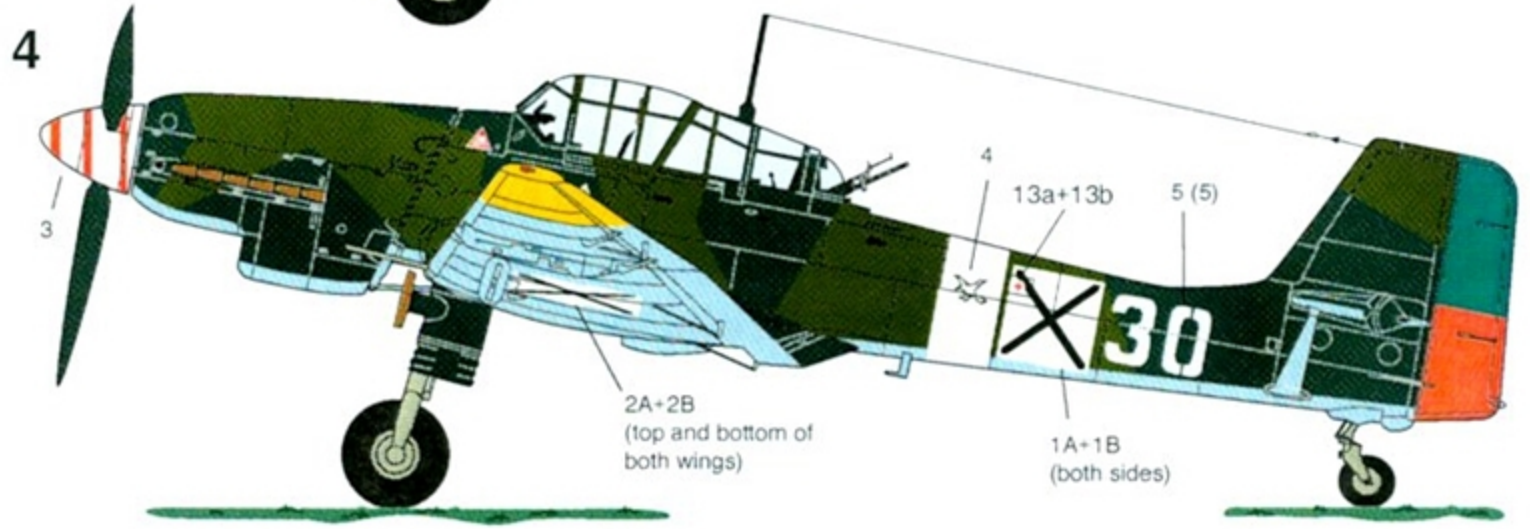
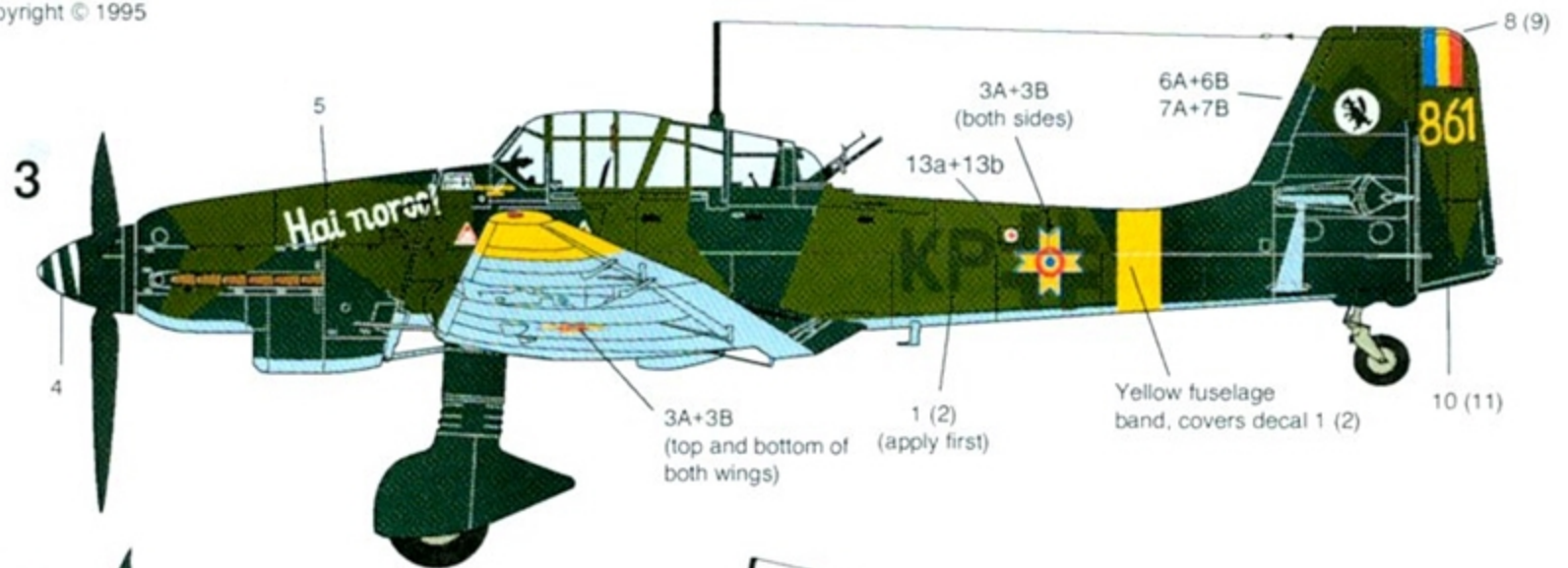

1 JU-87D-5, B6+41, Hungarian Air Force, 1943. Paint scheme is standard Luftwaffe pattern of RLM 70 and RLM 71 over RLM 65. White tail stripe is 48 centimeters wide. Yellow panels on outboard undersides of both wing tips. Spinner and propeller are RLM-70 with white tip. Note the siren props and spats removed from landing gear. See upper view for details of stabilizer markings.

2 JU-87D-1, OK-XAC, of the Slovakian Air Force, 1943. Paint scheme is standard Luftwaffe pattern of RLM 70 and RLM 71 over RLM 65. Spinner and propeller are RLM 70. Note the siren props.

3 JU-87D-8, 861, of 3/6 Dive Bomber Group, Royal Romanian Air Force, September, 1944. Paint scheme is standard Luftwaffe pattern of RLM 70 and RLM 71 over RLM 65. Former Luftwaffe markings painted over prior to application of new national markings. Yellow tail stripe is 48 cm. wide. Yellow panels on outboard undersides of both wing tips. Propeller and spinner are RLM 70 with white spiral stripe. Under wing crosses overpainted with light blue, similar to RLM 65.

4 JU-87D-5, 30, of the Royal Bulgarian Air Force, 1943. Paint scheme is standard Luftwaffe pattern of RLM 70 and RLM 71 over RLM 65. White fuselage stripe is 48 cm. wide. Top 76 cm. of rudder is light green, bottom is red. Yellow panels on outboard undersides of both wing tips. Spinner is white with red spiral stripe. Propeller is RLM 70. Note the siren props and spats removed from landing gear.
