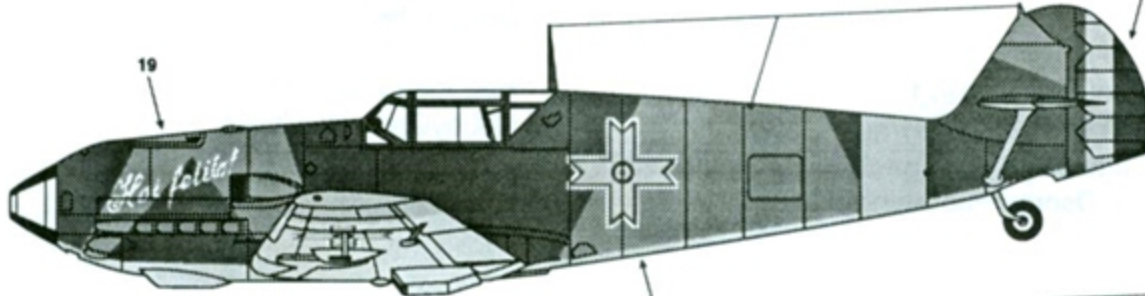
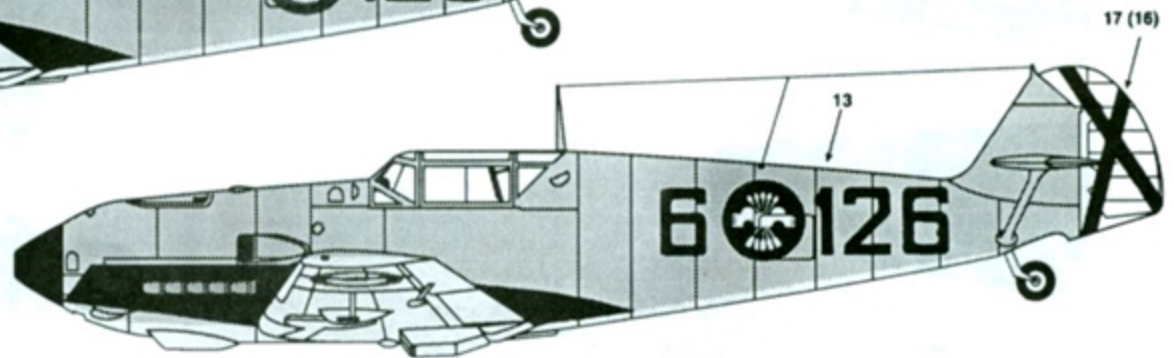

Bf 109E-4, Swiss Air Force, 1941-24. Upper surface camouflage RLM 70 & 71, under surfaces RLM 65. Propellor blades and spinner RLM 70. White cowling and red rudder. Red & white national insignia and neutrality stripes.

Bf 109E-4, Hungarian Air Force, 102nd Fighter Group. Upper surface camouflage dark green, brown, medium gray., under surfaces light blue. Yellow fuselage band. Red, white, and green bands on horizontal and vertical tail surfaces. Prop blades RLM 70. spinner black.
