

INSTRUCTIONS:

These decals are on a continuous decal film.

Applying the decals.

1. When you are ready to start applying the decals, We recommended that you cut as close to the item as possible to achieve the best results from each decal.
2. When soaking in water you only need to soak them for a maximum of 11seconds and then slide the item off the paper and straight on to the model.
3. Once on the model and in the right position, lightly press down on it with a dry tissue to soak up the excess water.
4. Once the decal has set and is dry you may then use some decal setting solution to help the decal adhere to the paint on the model.

Notes:

These decals are still raw and do not have a clear varnish finish on them.

This is to prevent them from cracking and turning yellow over time in storage.

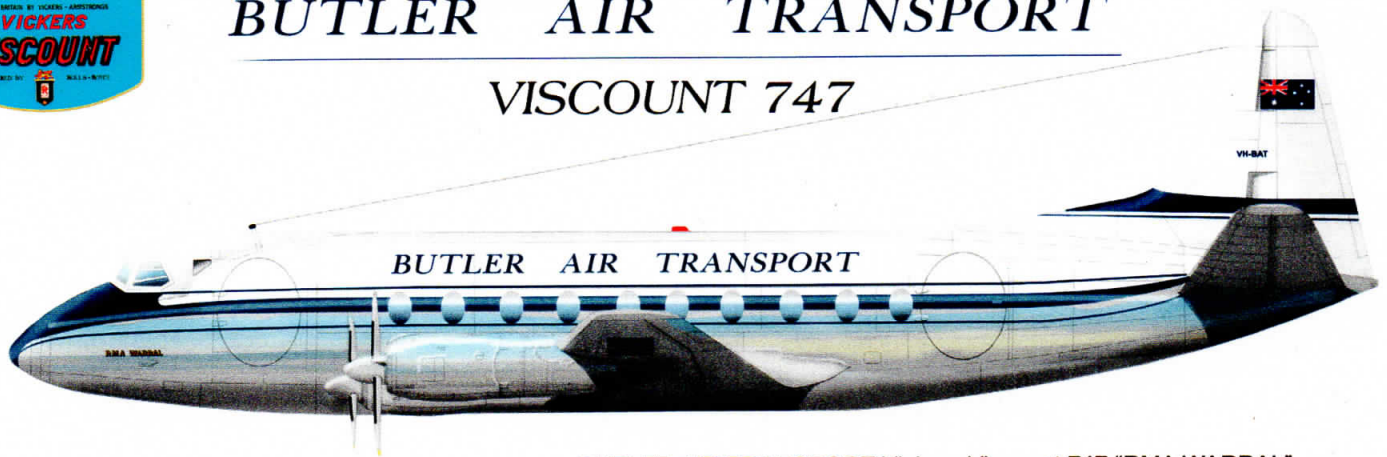
How ever, there is a thin film of oil on them so before you apply any clear lacquer to them once they are on the aircraft we recommend that you give them a light wipe over with a soapy damp cloth. Then you can apply some clear acrylic lacquer to your model.

Warning: Be very gentle with the decal film when applying to the model. As the decal film is very thin and may tear if mistreated.



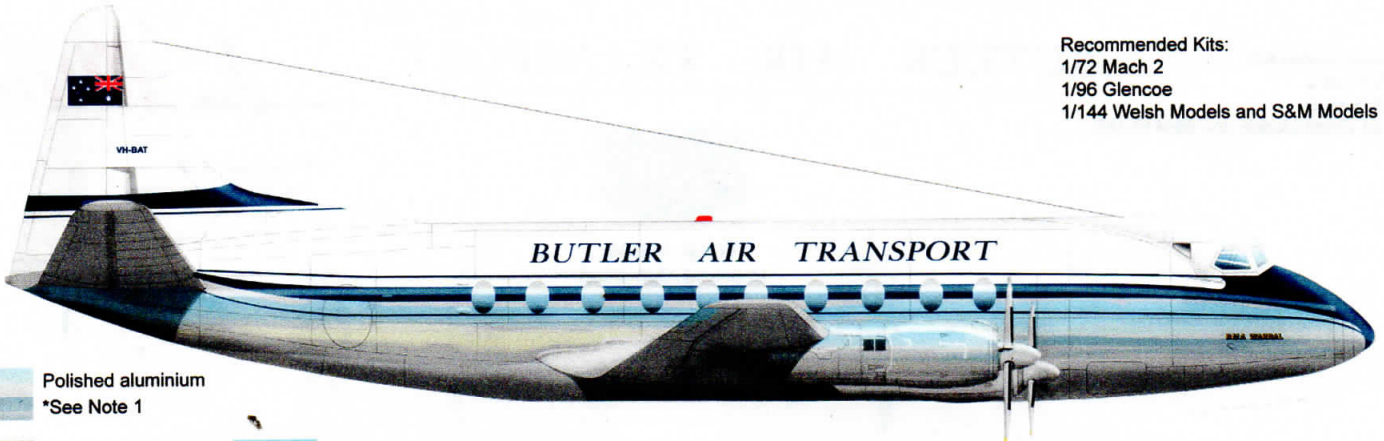

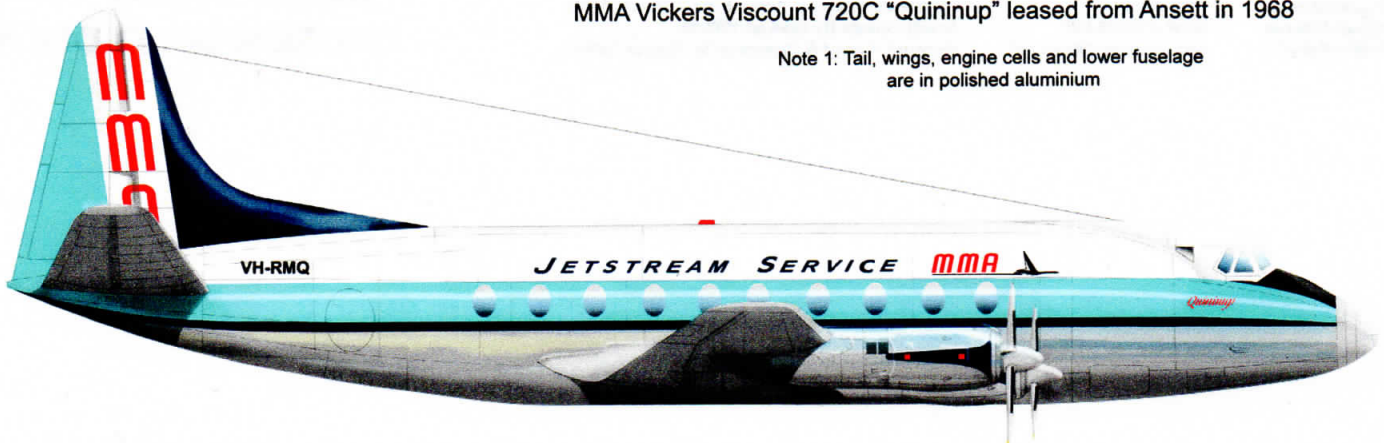

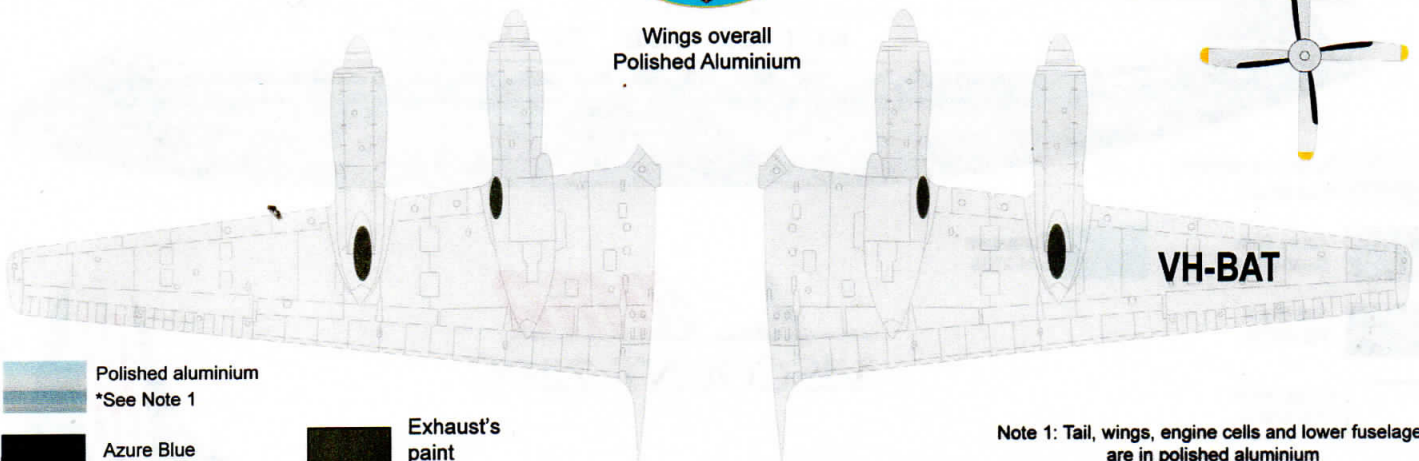

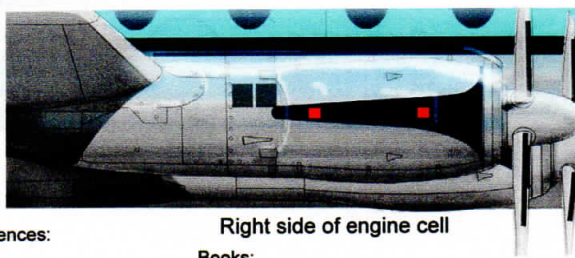

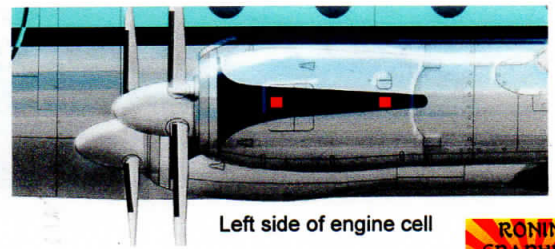
