





## Bf 109E-3 III./JG51

Oblt. Werner Pichon-Kalau von Hofe, Technical Officer, mid-summer 1940. This aircraft carries the III Gruppe 'Axt von Niederrhein' insignia and an unusually small circle to the Gruppe Technical Officer chevron. Upper camouflage is the earlier RLM 70/71 scheme.





Bf 109E-3 'Yellow 11' L/JG27 Oblt. Werner Schuller, Plumetot, July 1940.

This aircraft carries a replacement rudder still painted in factory primer. Note also the White scissors in honour of a 3. Staffel colleague, Lt. Ulrich Scherer, KIA 20 July.

## Bf 109E-3 Stab/JG2

Maj. Harry von Bülow-Bothcamp, Geschwaderkommodore of JG2.

This aircraft carries a heavily stippled style of camouflage and 'Richthofen' insignia below the cockpit. Von Bülow-Bothcamp, a WWI veteran, would later lose command of JG2 as part of Goering's reorganisation of Luftwaffe commanding officers.
