



Aircraft 2 - P-51D-20 'Kitten'. Lt. George Long. Jr., East Wretham, January 1945. Natural Metal finish, Yellow canopy frame leading edge gun panels and rudder. The name Kitten (decal 7) may have had a Yellow border. Your choice! (photo page 117, reference 3). Pilot flew from Dec. of 44 to Sept. of 45, destroying one locomotive and shared eight more. A/C crash landed during take off on January 16, 1945, killing Lt. D.A. Mac Lean during his first operational take off. Kitten had a very dirty fuselage insignia, but we do not believe it was Grey.

Aircraft 3 - P-51D-15 'CisCo'. East Wretham, Autumn 1945. Natural Metal finish, Insignia Blue wing tips and rudder. On Tamiya kit, apply decal 17 to canopy frame, then trim and attach clear part, then apply decal 18. No other information is available on this aircraft.
