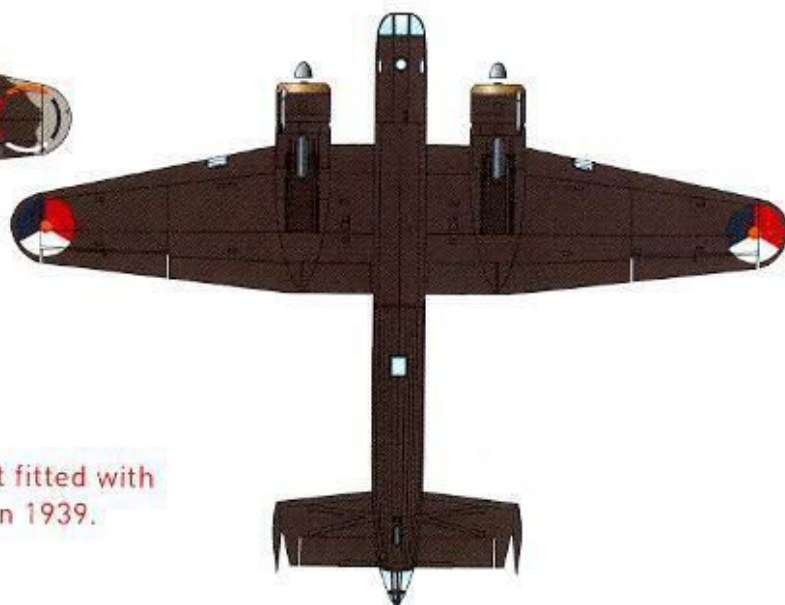

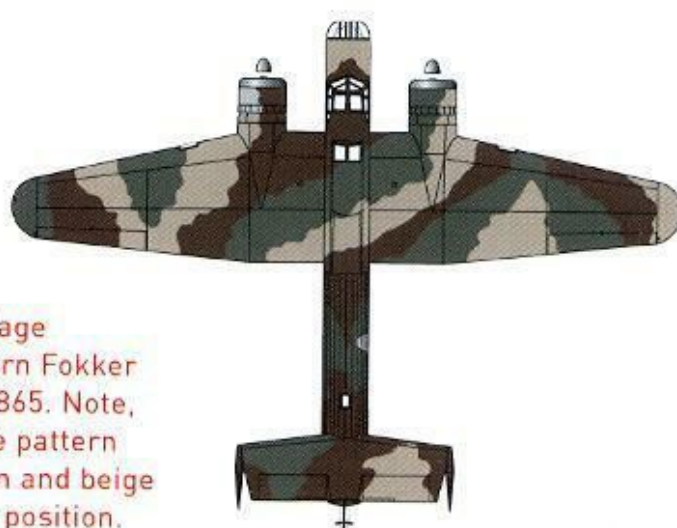

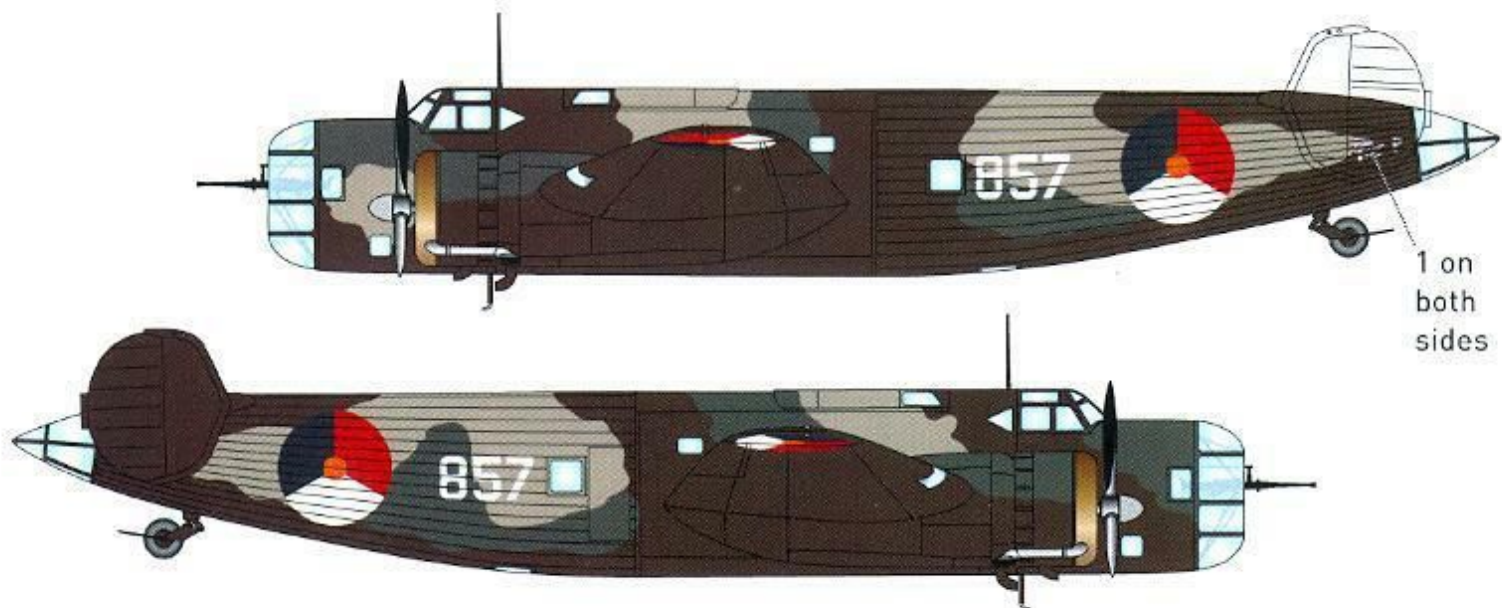

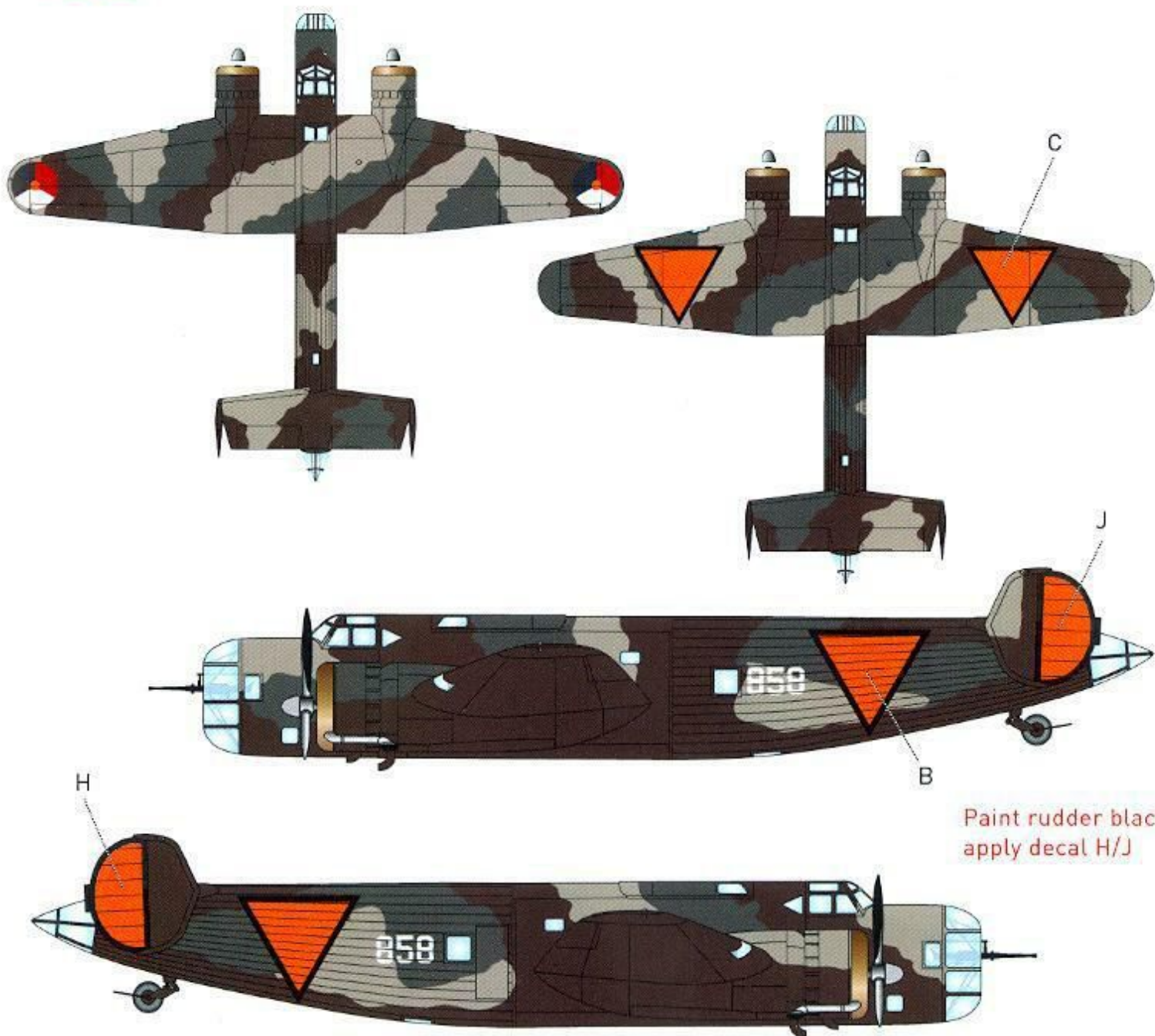

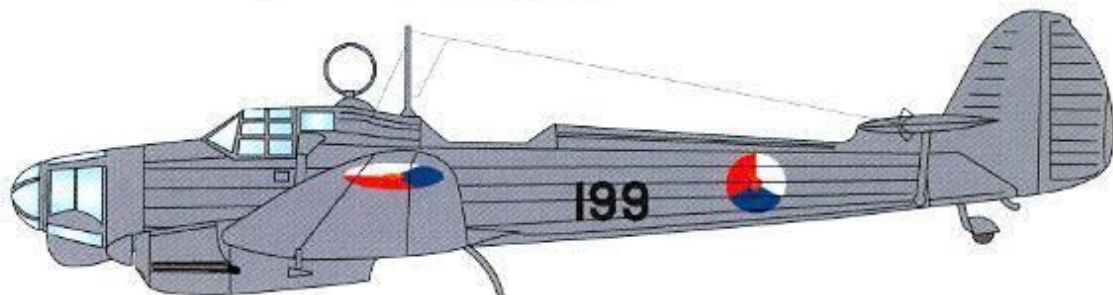
**Fokker T.V. 858. BomVa.** LVA/Dutch ArmyAF 1940, Camouflage in 2st pattern. Dutch triangle in six positions. Damaged by Dutch AA and landed at HaamstedeAB, destroyed by air attack on May 13.

Overall LVA Blauw FS05189/05275. Kit: Special Hobby. Weihe 195 and 196 with LVA 'hooked' registration. Dutch insignia not correct in position, blue on lower position, instead of white. Dutch insignia on sheet DD Insignia.

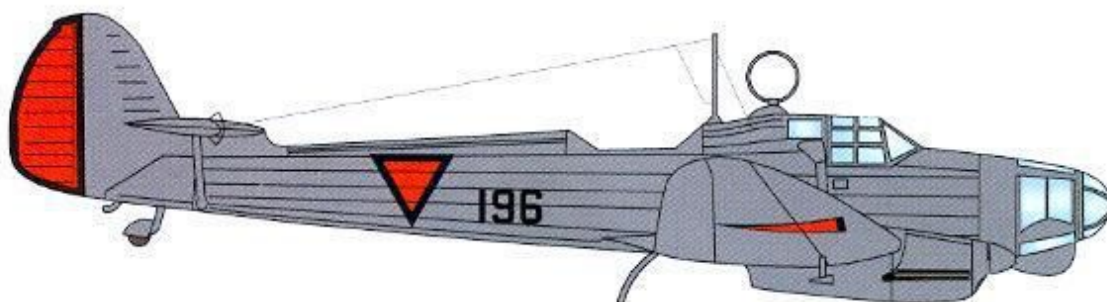
**Focke Wulf-58B-2 'Weihe'. 197.** LVA/Dutch ArmyAF 1939.Ypenburg/WaalhavenAB. The Netherlands. Verbindingsvliegtuig C.L.vd. Destroyed on TexelAB during the German invasion. Insignia in six positions.



**Focke Wulf-58B-2 'Weihe'. 199.** LVA/Dutch ArmyAF 1939.Haamstede/SoesterbergAB. The Netherlands. Vliedschool. Destroyed on Schiphol during the German invasion.

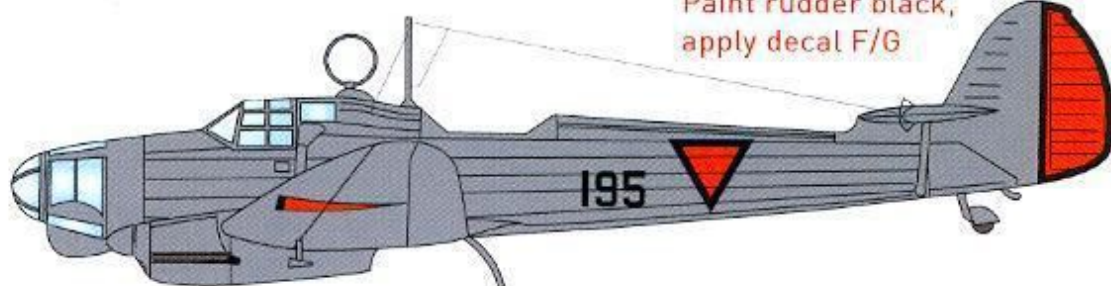
