





The 8th FW consists of the 35th Fighter Squadron and the 80th Fighter Squadron. Until the war on terrorism commenced after 9/11, the Wolfpack was known throughout the USAF as the most forward-deployed unit in the USAF.

Constantly on guard and ready to strike, the 8th FW maintains a very heightened state of readiness. Since Kunsan is only 15-minutes (150 miles) away from the DMZ, the aircraft are always armed and ready to defend South Korea. Both squadrons fly the Block 40 version of the F-16. This version is optimized for ground attack in addition to its air-to-air capability and excels especially at night.
