In 1943 aircraft was transferred to Escadrila 52 vanatoare to protect Cernavada bridge and Constanca harbour

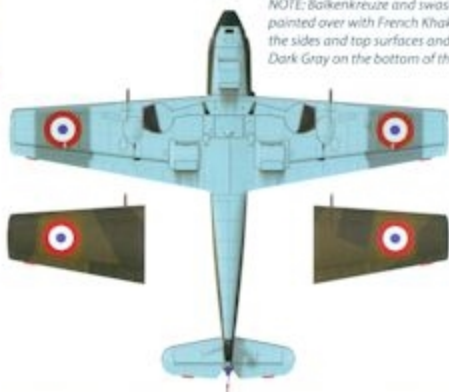


**Messerschmitt Me 109 E-3 Wk.Nr. 1304**

During the combat with French pilots of GC III/7 on November 22, 1939, German pilot landed by mistake on the French airfield Strasbourg-Woerth.

NOTE: Balkenkreuze and swastika painted over with French Khaki on the sides and top surfaces and Dark Gray on the bottom of the wings



With the "new owner" markings the aircraft was used for flying tests with the newest French construction Dewoitine D.520 and also with Bloch MB.152 and Spitfire I that was received from the British. During those tests plane had a camera installed under the left wing.
