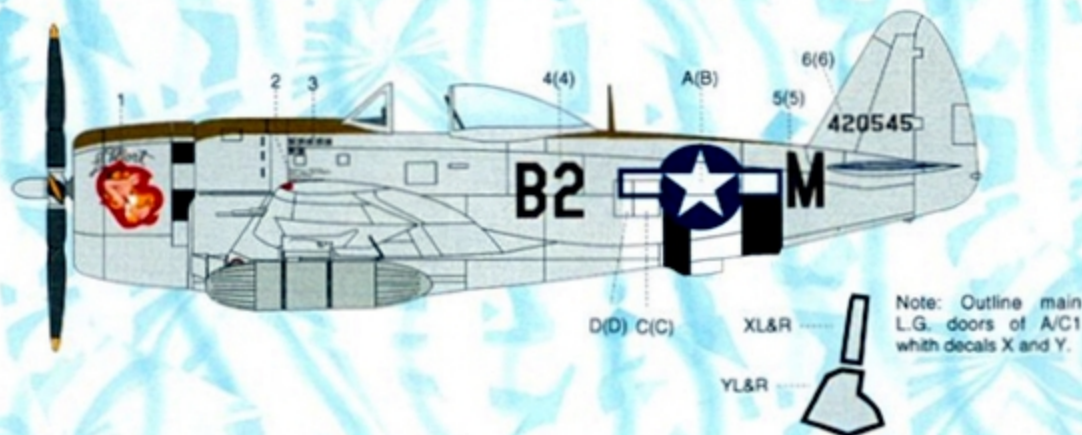

P-47 THUNDERBOLT

FIGHTER BOMBERS

A/C Type	P-47D Thunderbolt .
Pilot & Unit	1st Lt. Melvyn R. Paisley. 390 F.S./ 366 F.S.
Locale & Date	Handorf, Germany, May 1945.
Camouflage & Markings	Natural Metal w/ Dark OD anti-glare panel. Two Black cowl flaps on each side.
Remarks	Notice uneven D-Day bands only on fuselage. Pilot shot down an Fw-190 with a M-10 Air-Ground Rocket during operation Bodenplatte. Final score . 5 kills.



A/C Type	P-47D-30 Thunderbolt .
Pilot & Unit	Capt. Lowell K. Bracland. 355 F.S./ 354 F.G.
Locale & Date	Rosieres-en-Haye, December, 1944.
Camouflage & Markings	Natural Metal with a very dark anti-glare panel. The cowl was Blue with White diamonds. Blue prop bullet. Black stripes on tail surfaces.
Remarks	Pilot's final score, adding two Korean kills, was 14.5 Kills.



A/C Type	P-47D-30 Thunderbolt .
Pilot & Unit	1st Lt. Donald O. Scherer. 366 F.S./ 358 F.G.
Locale & Date	Sandhofen, Germany, April 1945.
Camouflage & Markings	Natural Metal finish with O.D. anti-glare panel. Red cowl and Orange empennage. Only ace of the "Orange Tails" Sqd.
Remarks	Scherer flew more than one P-47 during his career. Ole Trapper is the only documented one. Note dorsal fin.



All these Aircraft use the Curtiss Electric Assymetric paddle blade prop.
