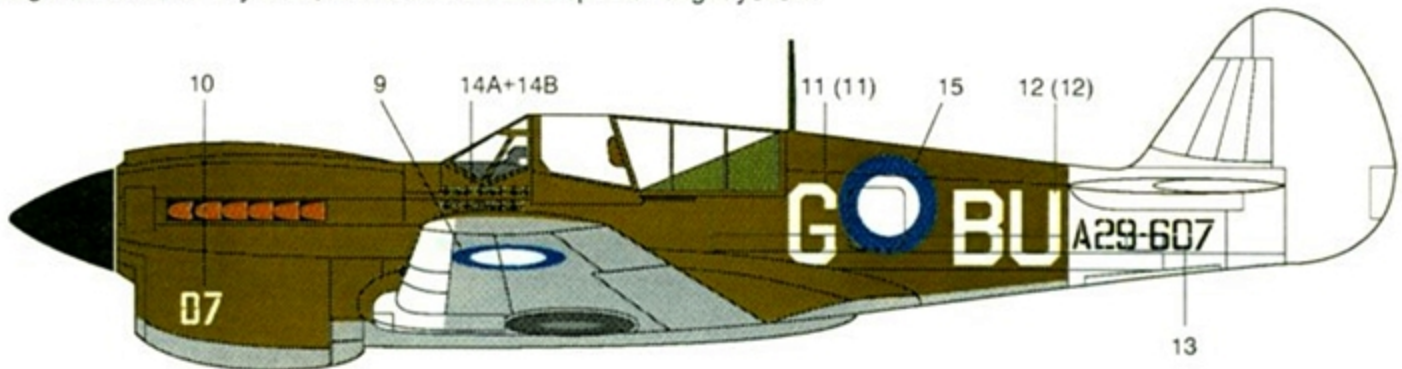

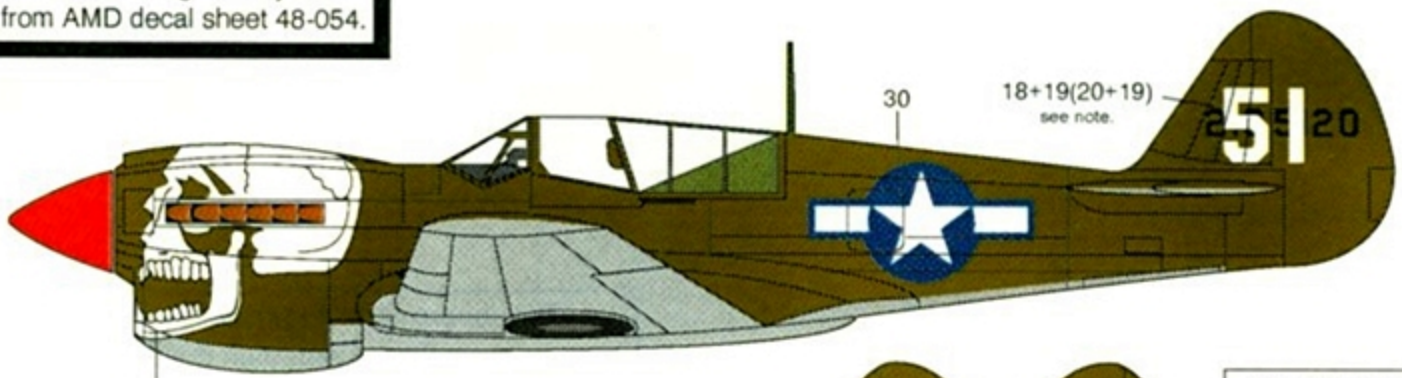

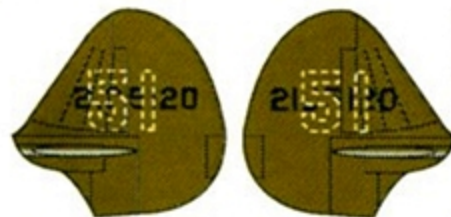

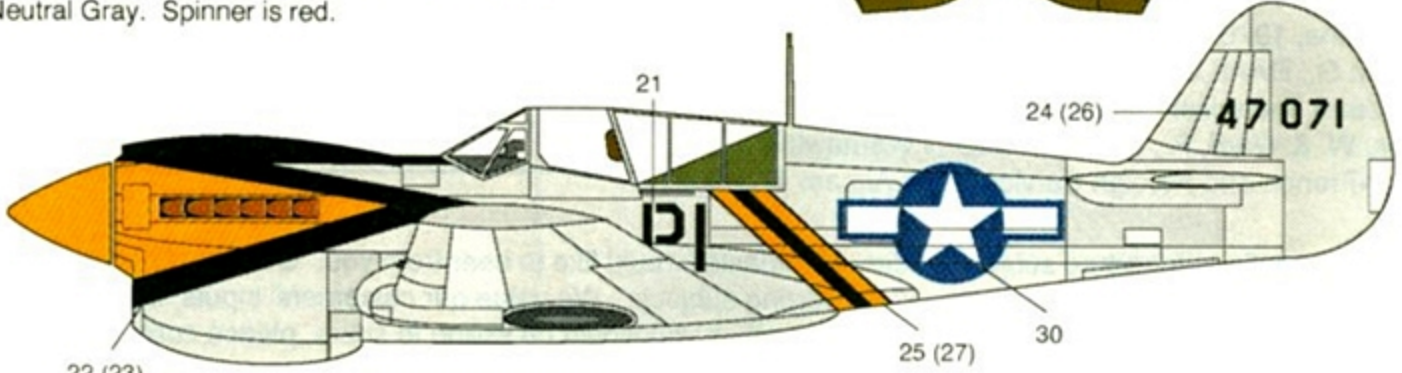

Note: Apply black piece first, then apply white "51".



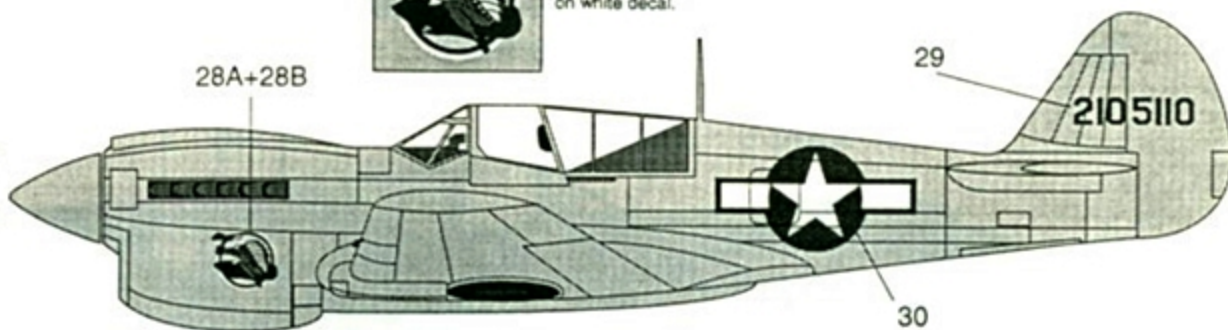
P-40N-30-CU, flown by Maj. Ben Preston, CO, 13th Pursuit Group. Overall natural metal, trimmed in black and orange.

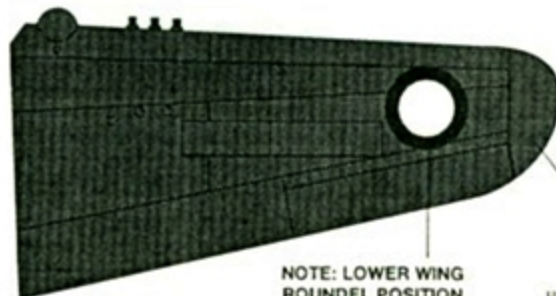


Apply white decal first, then center black border of Indian on white decal.

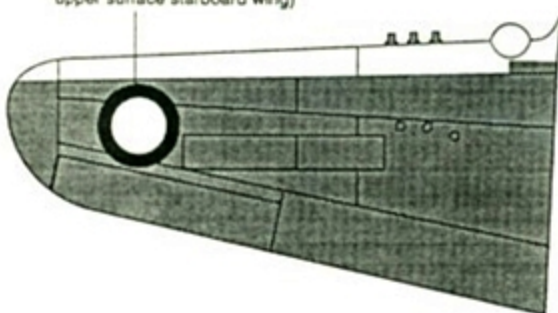
NOTE: UPPER WING

upper surface starboard wing)



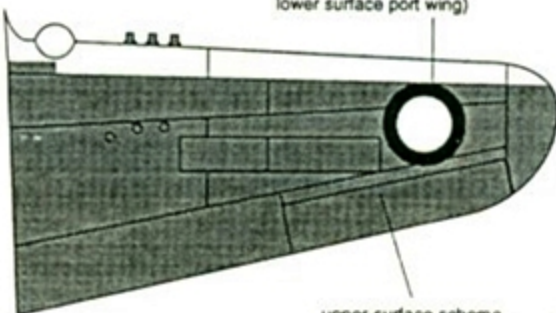
NOTE: LOWER WING

lower surface port wing)



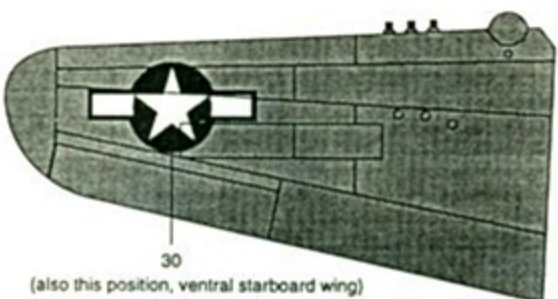
upper-surface scheme,
aircraft no. 1



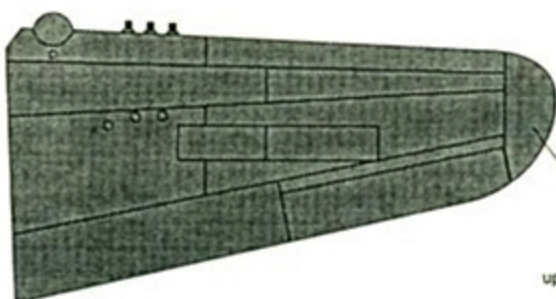
upper-surface scheme,
