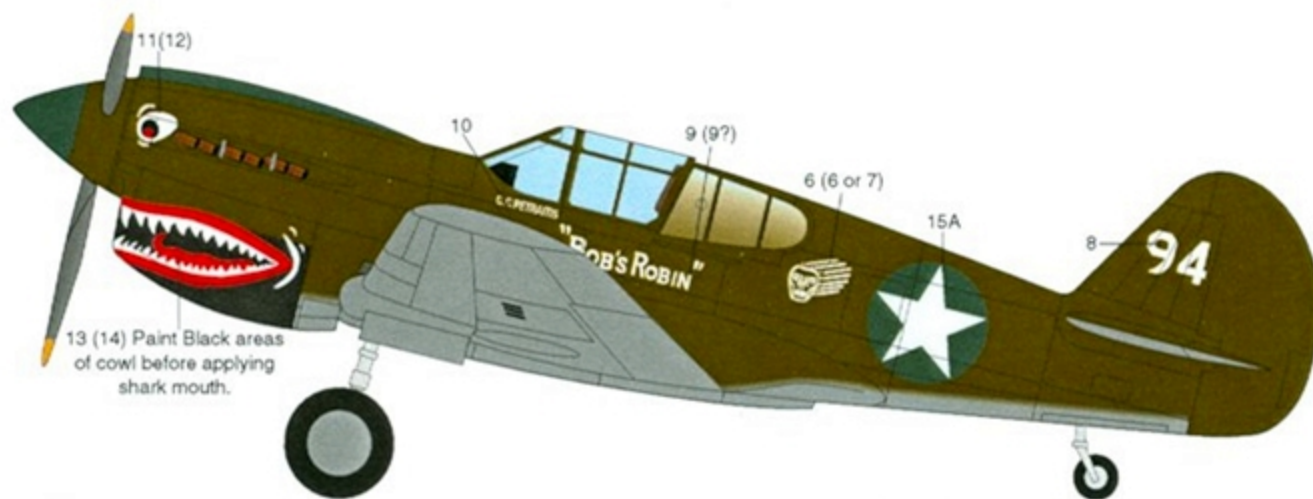
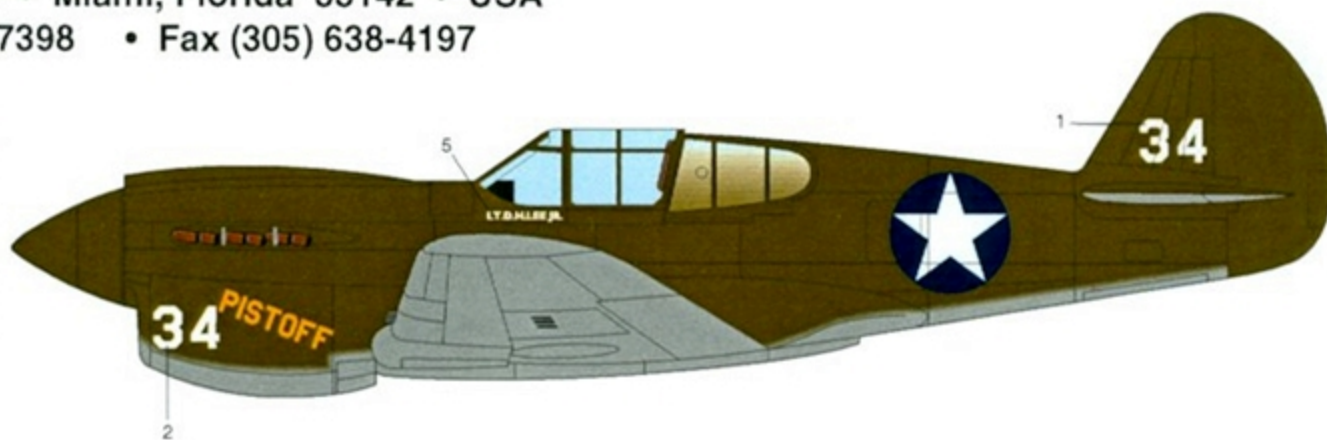

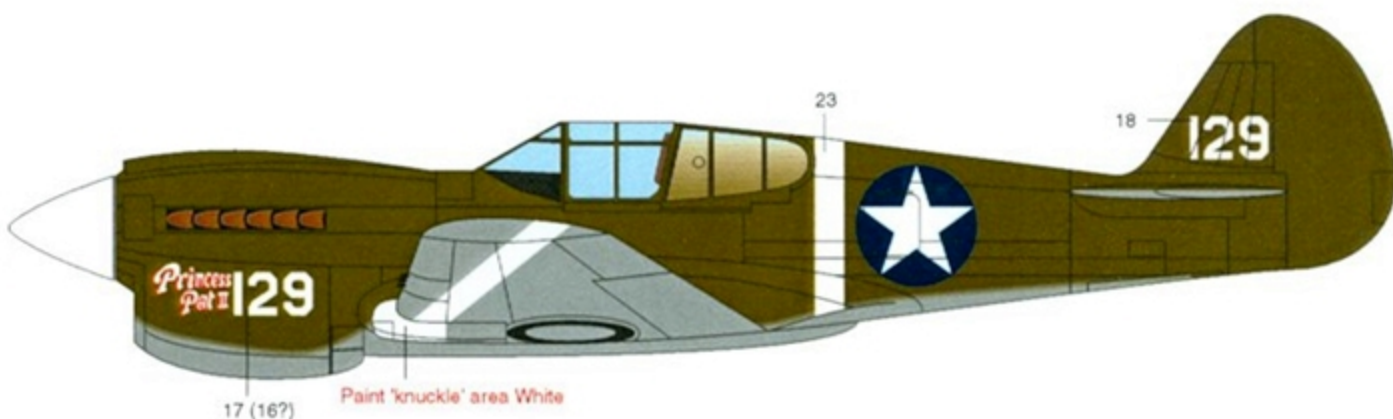

P-40E flown by Lt. Donald H. Lee, 7th F.S., 49th F.G. This Warhawk carried the standard O.D. and Neutral Gray colors. As it is unknown if the nose art was repeated on the stbd. side, an extra set of decals (#3 & #4) are supplied.



P-40E flown by Lt. Bob Vought, 9th F.S., 49th F.G. This Warhawk carried the standard O.D. and Neutral Gray colors. References show this aircraft to have Medium Green national insignia, but this is unconfirmed through other references. The insignia under star board wing should be blue (item 15A). Note that a blue set of insignias is also provided should you choose to not use the green. The upper cowl air scoop and forward spinner are also painted Medium Green.

P-40M flown by Col. Robert B. Westbrook, 44th F.S., 18th F.G. Standard O.D. and Neutral Gray colors with a White spinner.



P-40N flown by Capt. E.A. Harris, 8th F.S., 49th F.G. Standard O.D. and Neutral Gray colors with a Yellow spinner and White tail.
