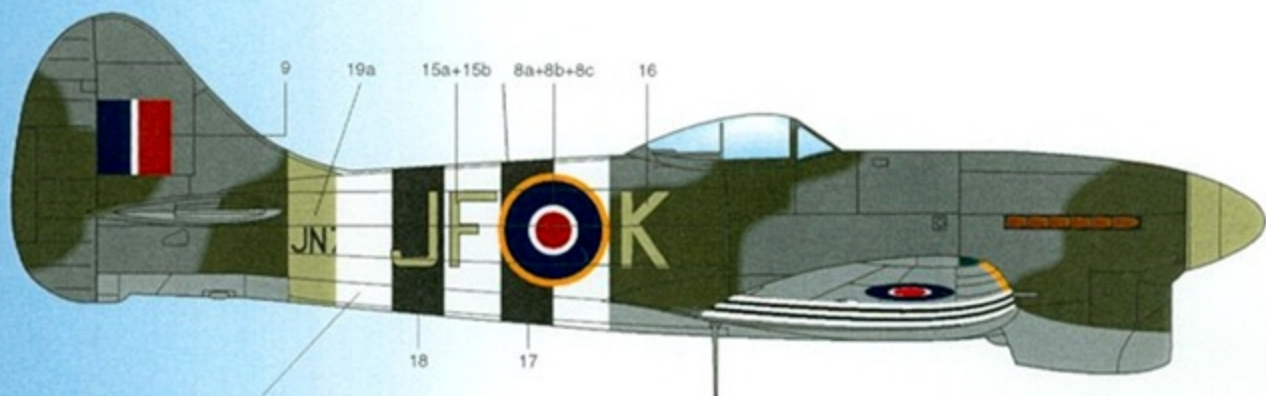

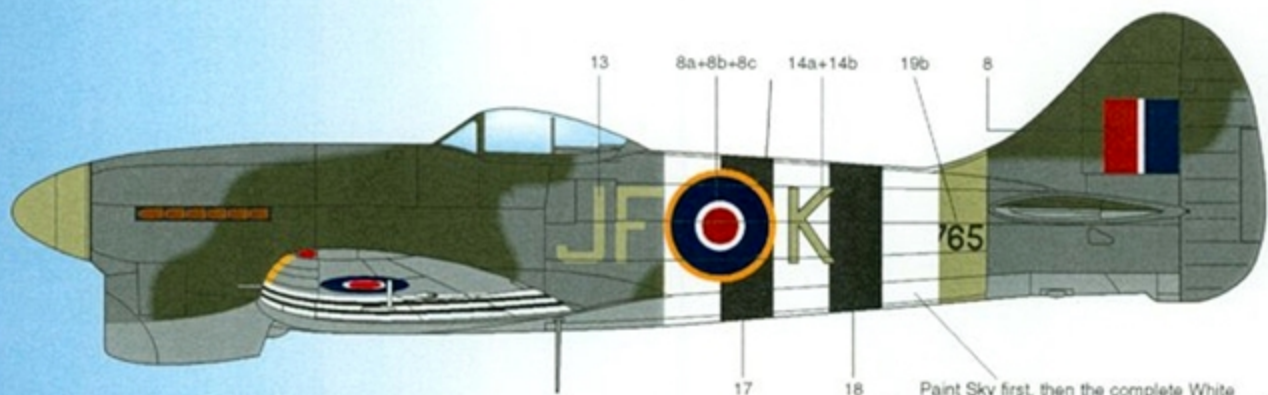

Flown by F.O. G.E. Kosh, this Tempest V, JN765/JF*K of No. 3 Squadron (at Newchurch, UK) was used in battle against V-1 flying bombs in June 1944. Note Sky spinner and fuselage band. The standard camouflage scheme was carried. A/C had long cannon barrels.

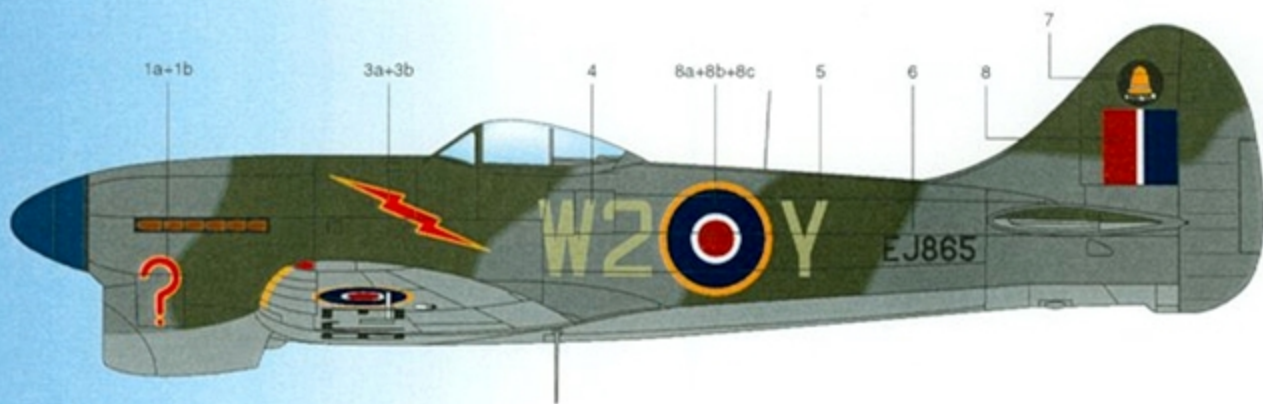


Paint Sky first, then the complete White segment, and finally apply the Black stripe decals.
