

Aircraft 2 - P-51D-15 'Babe'. Lt. Vernon Judkins, East Wretham, 1945. Natural metal finish. Red canopy frame, antenna mast and rudder. Note on actual aircraft there was a thin chipped area between the Green nose and Red stripes lending a ragged appearance. Pilot failed to score during his tour.

Aircraft 3 - P-51D-15 'Josephine II'. Capt. Jimmy Shoffit, East Wretham, 1945. Natural Metal finish, Medium Blue rudder, Red antenna mast. This aircraft later became Skeeter's Scooter and was flown by Lt. John Mc Alevey. Notice that some serial numbers are placed on an unpainted section of the rudder, showing its aluminum doped finish.
