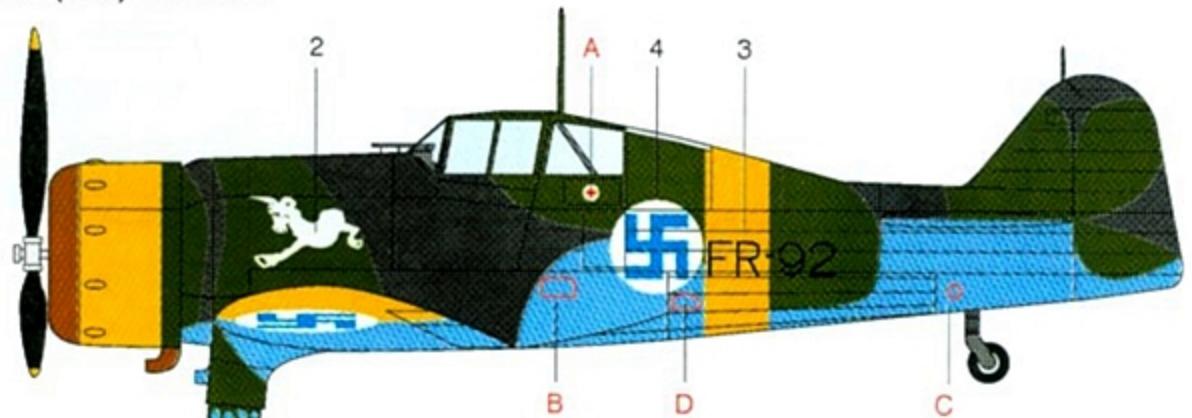

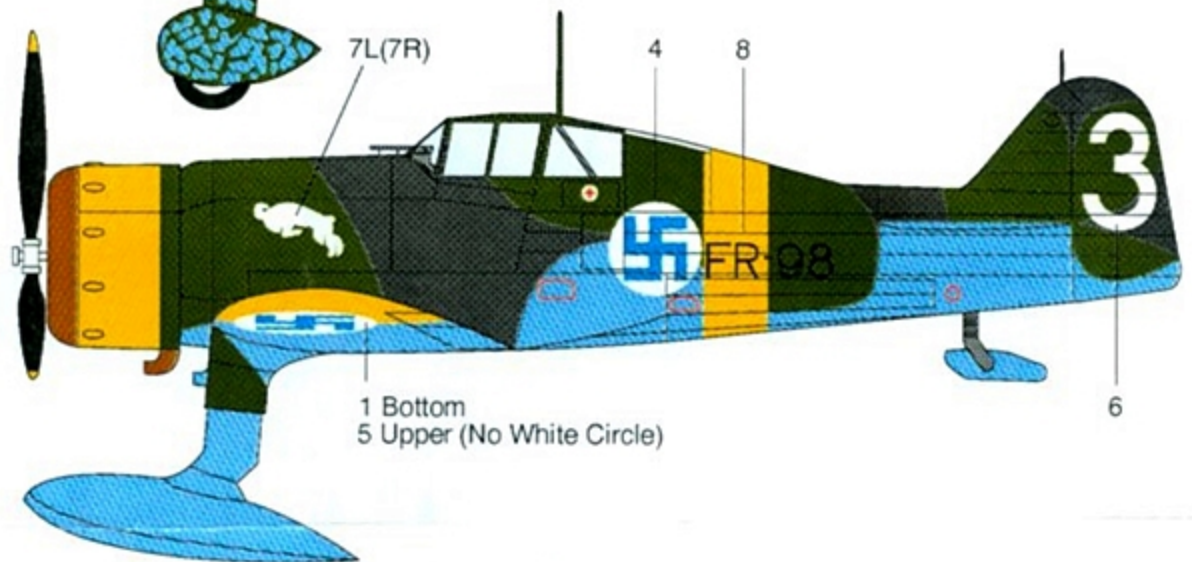

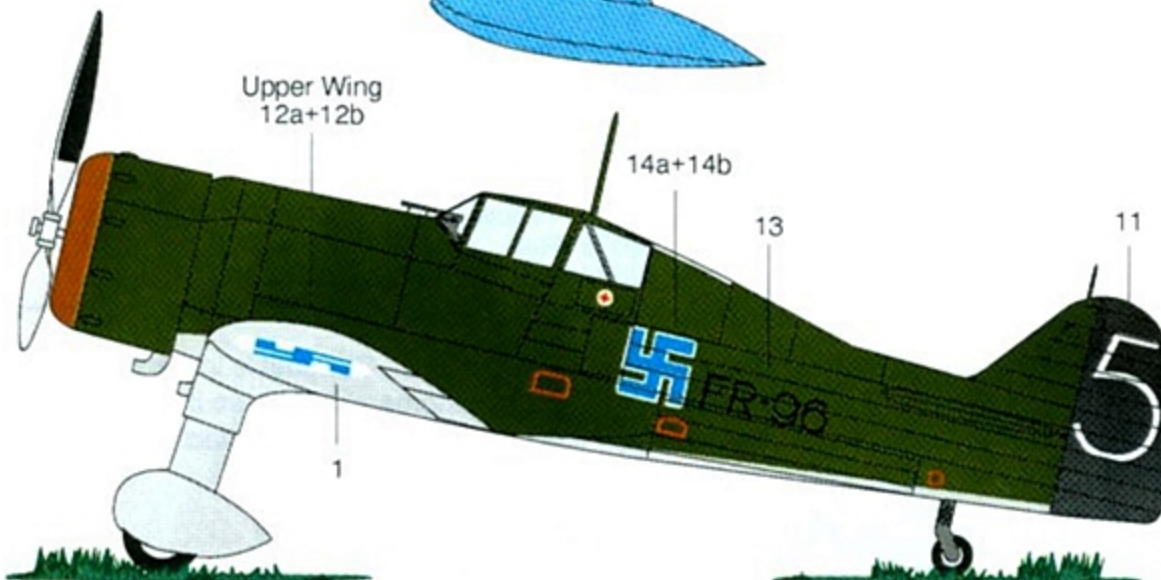
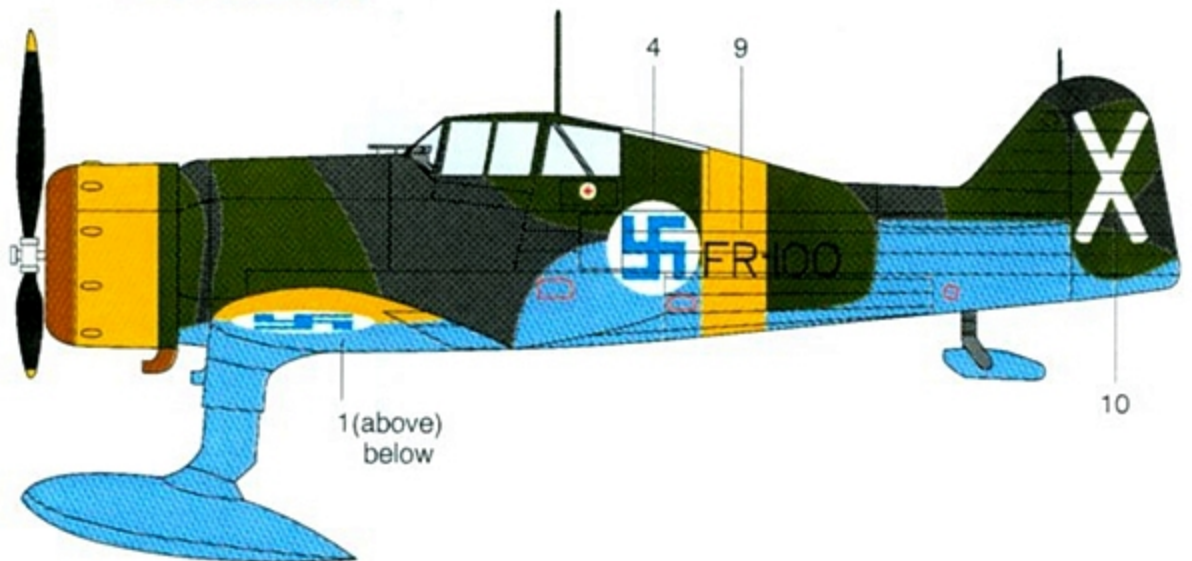
Finnish Air Force Fokker D.XXI, FR-92, piloted by Capt. E. Metsola, of 2/LLv 12, 1942. Camouflage consists of Dark Olive Green and Black over Sky Blue in the standard "Continuation War" pattern. Yellow cowling (aft of the collector ring), lower wing tips and rear fuselage stripe are standard Finnish Eastern Front identification devices. The propeller features Black blades with Yellow tips. The Finns eventually painted-out the top wing and fuselage insignia's white portions in Dark Olive Green, which we have also supplied as extra decals 22 and 23.



Fokker D.XXI, FR-98, piloted by w/o Ritavouri, 1/LLv 12, 1942. "Continuation War" scheme again features Dark Olive Green and Black over Sky Blue. Note that the forward-most swath of Black is missing from this machine. Yellow cowling (aft of the collector ring), lower wing tips and rear fuselage stripe — with Yellow-tipped, Black propeller blades.



Fokker D.XXI, FR-100, 1/LLv 14, 1942. Pilot Lt. Tainio. "Continuation War" scheme again features Dark Olive Green and Black over Sky Blue. Yellow cowling (aft of the collector ring), lower wing tips and rear fuselage stripe are standard Finnish Eastern Front identification devices. The propeller sports Black blades with Yellow tips.

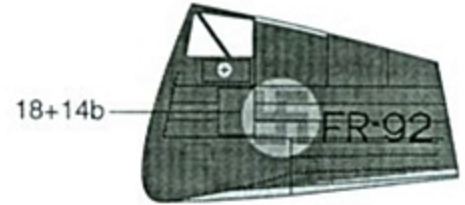
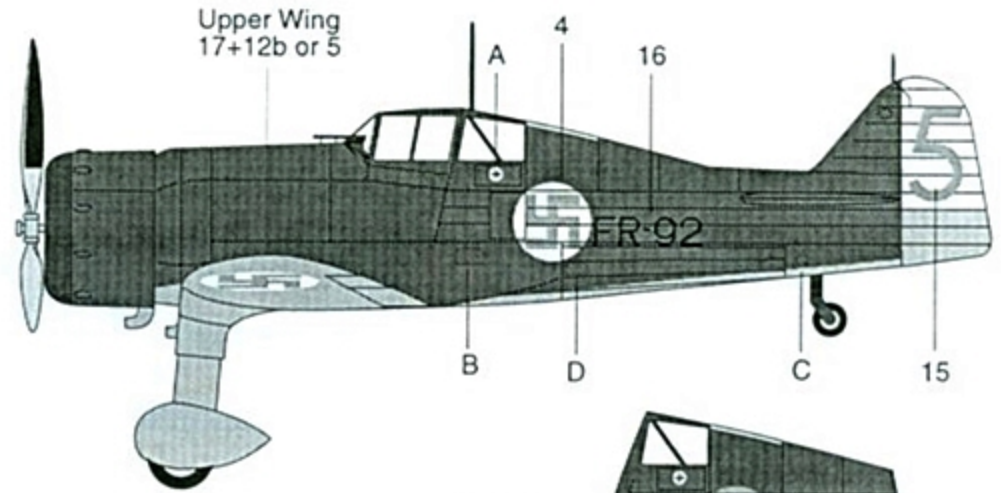


Finnish Air Force D.XXI, FR-96 of Lentorykmentti 2 (Air Wing 2) during the Winter War, 1940. Dark Olive Green/Gray Scheme. Black rudder. Note that the propeller blades are Aluminum — with only a portion of the backs in anti-glare Back. Note, too, the "toned-down" national markings on all upper surfaces, with regulation blue/white national insignia beneath the wings.



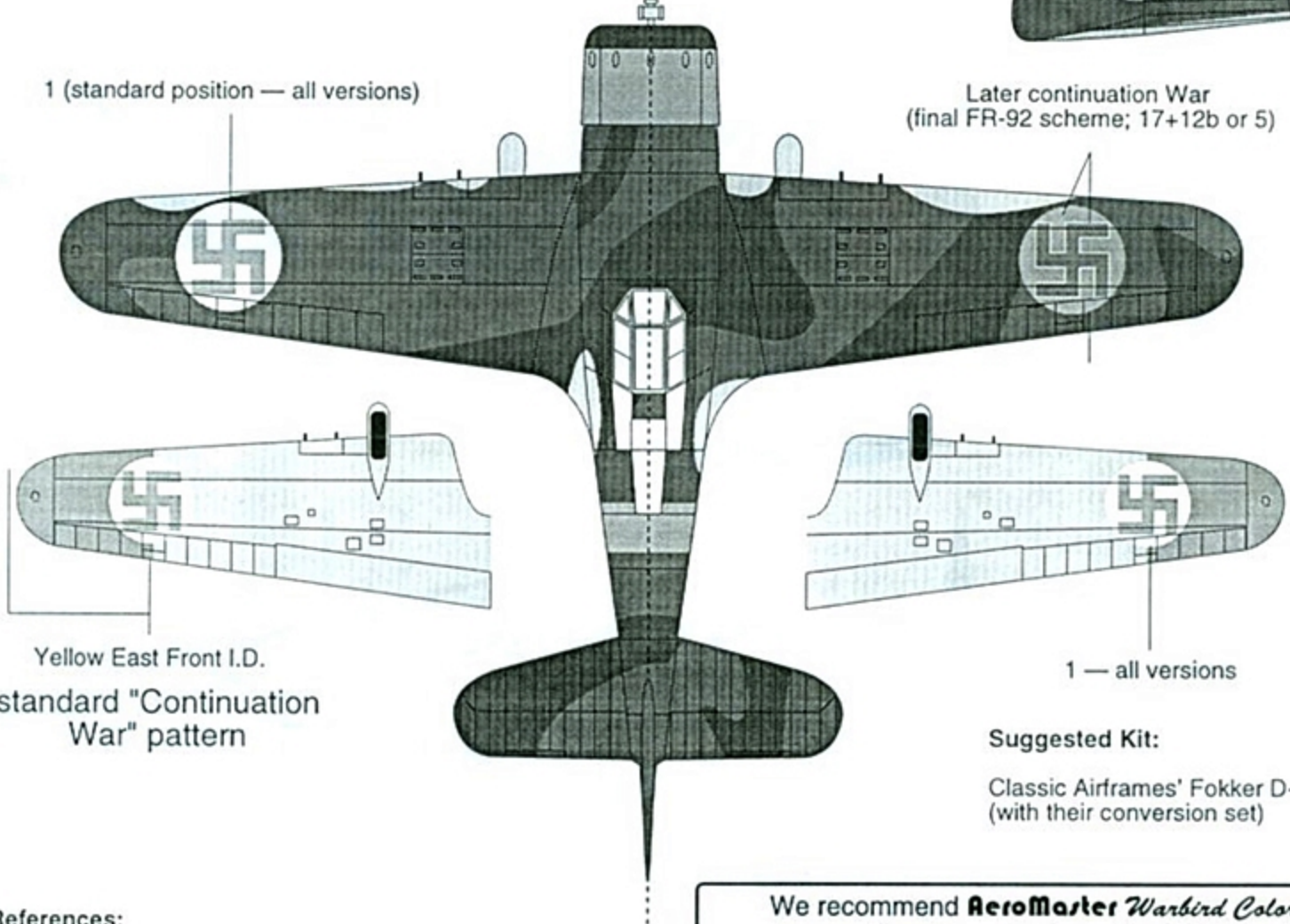
# AeroMaster Decals™

Finnish Air Force D.XXI, FR-92, 4/LLv 24, during the "Winter War," 1940. Dark Olive Green applied over Light Gray, with the rudder divided horizontally in white (top) and Finnish insignia blue (bottom). Natural aluminum propeller blades again feature only a portion of the backs in anti-glare black paint. Note that this sheet affords you the opportunity of constructing FR-92 during at least three "markings" phases of its operational career.
