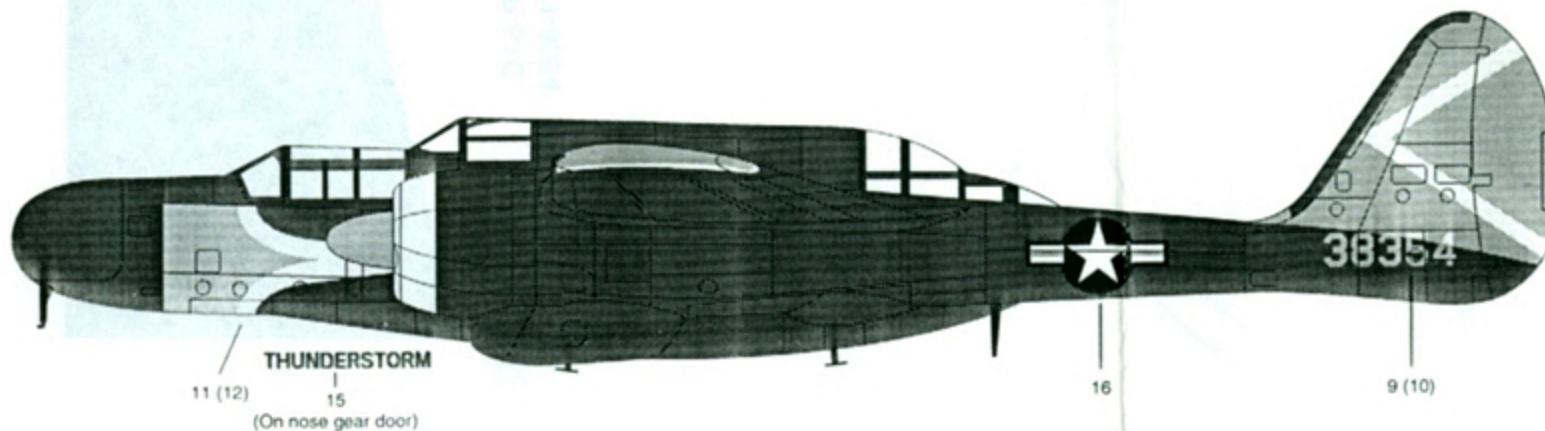
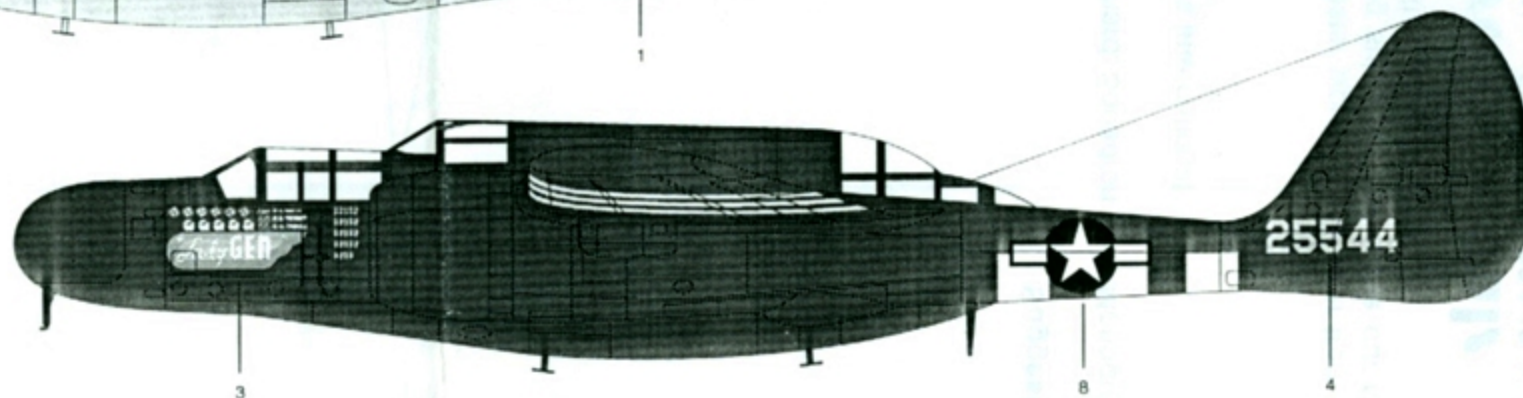

P-61A 42-5528, "Jap-Batty", 6th Night Fighter Squadron, Saipan, 1944. Olive Drab and Neutral Gray camouflage with natural fibreglass radome. Note long range ferry tank in place of upper gun turret.



P-61A 42-5526, "Nightie Mission", 6th Night Fighter Squadron, Kagman Point Airfield, Saipan, 1944. Olive Drab and Neutral Gray camouflage with natural fibreglass radome. Note added upper gun turret.

P-61A 42-5544, "Lady Gen", 422nd Night Fighter Squadron, France, 1944. Overall gloss black finish with white D-Day invasion stripes on lower booms and lower wings. Spinner (black) not shown for clarity.



P-61C, 43-8354, Air Force All Weather Flying Center, Clinton County AFB, Ohio, 1947. Used for weather research in Project Thunderstorm. Overall gloss black with large yellow bordered red areas on nose, wings and tail. Forward cowl yellow, spinner red. Red decal is provided for tail, while nose and wingtips require the red areas to be painted. Use the templates provided on the reverse side for painting. Note added cowl intakes and lower cowl scoop on P-61C.
