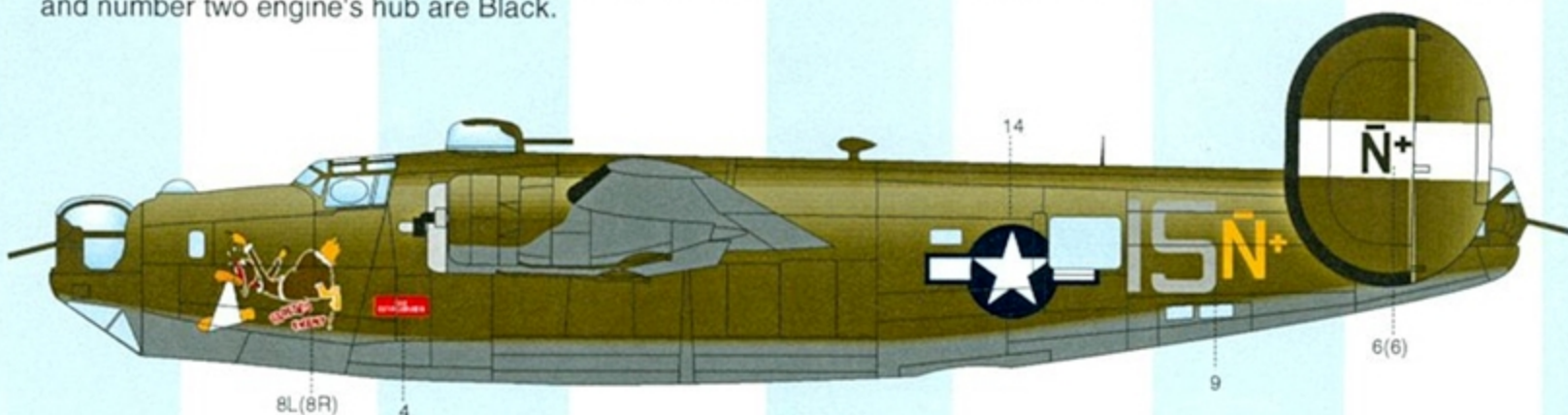
B-24 J-105-CO 42-109805 "GIPSY QUEEN" 44th Bomb Group, Shipdham. This aircraft survived the war and was extensively modified during its career. It is shown with a navigator's scanning window added to the side of her nose. Standard camouflage, with a Black and natural metal vertical stabilizer. Flat Black prop Hub & spinners.

B-24 H-15-CF "BLASTED EVENT" 445th Bomb Group, Tibenham. This Liberator formerly flew with the 3rd. Divisions 487th Bomb Group. It was salvaged as war weary on 29 May 1945. Overall Olive Drab with Neutral Gray undersides. Number two engine front cowling ring seems to be a replacement with natural metal finish. Number one engine's spinner and number two engine's hub are Black.



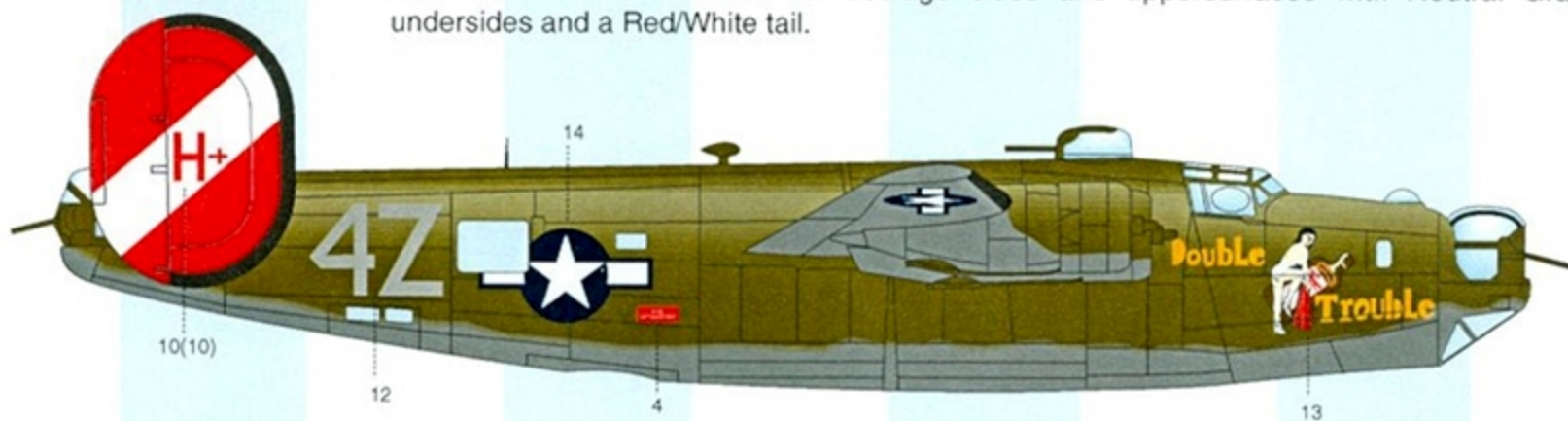
B-24 H-15-CF 42-252487 "BLASTED EVENT" 487th Bomb Group, Harrington, 1944. Overall Olive Drab with Neutral Gray undersides.

Our Thanks to Phillip Huston of California for supplying us with the photo of "Blasted Event" while with the 487th BG. His father, Lewis Huston, (see photo - back row, far left) was the aircraft commander of this A/C. According to Phillip, the photo was taken in early 1944 at Harrington, Nebraska before the 487th took off for Florida, Brazil, Morocco, and up to England.





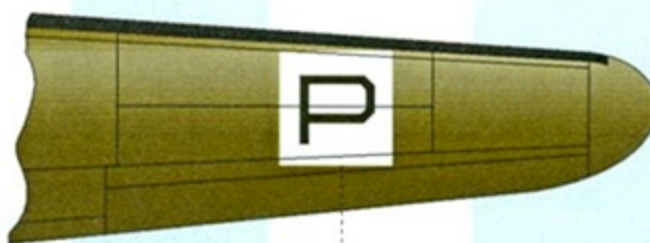
