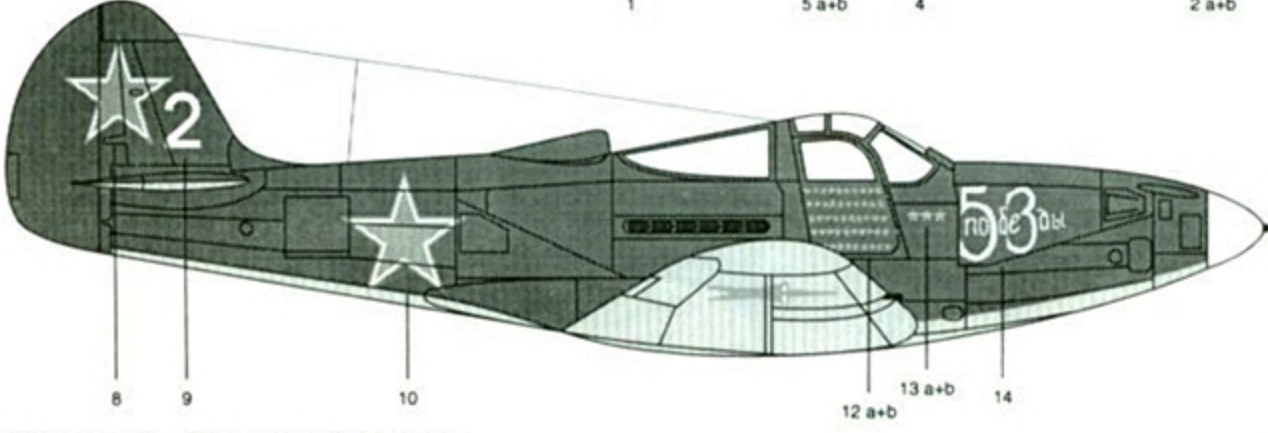

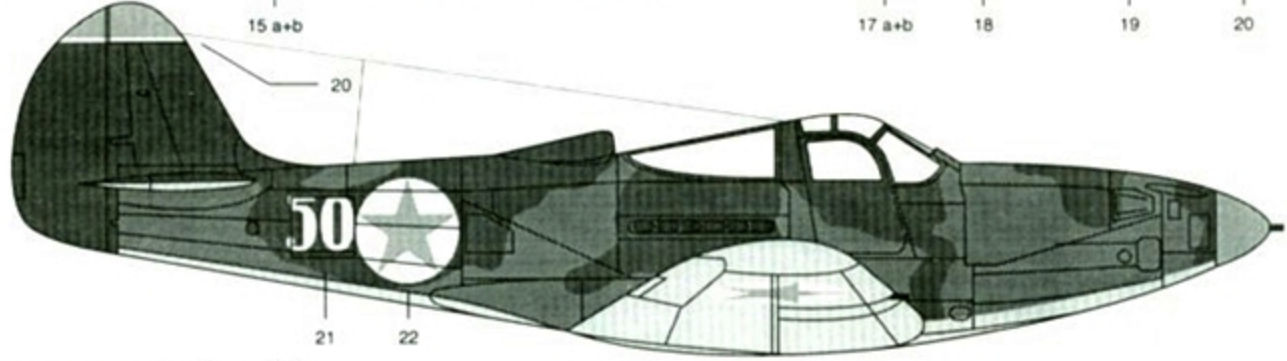
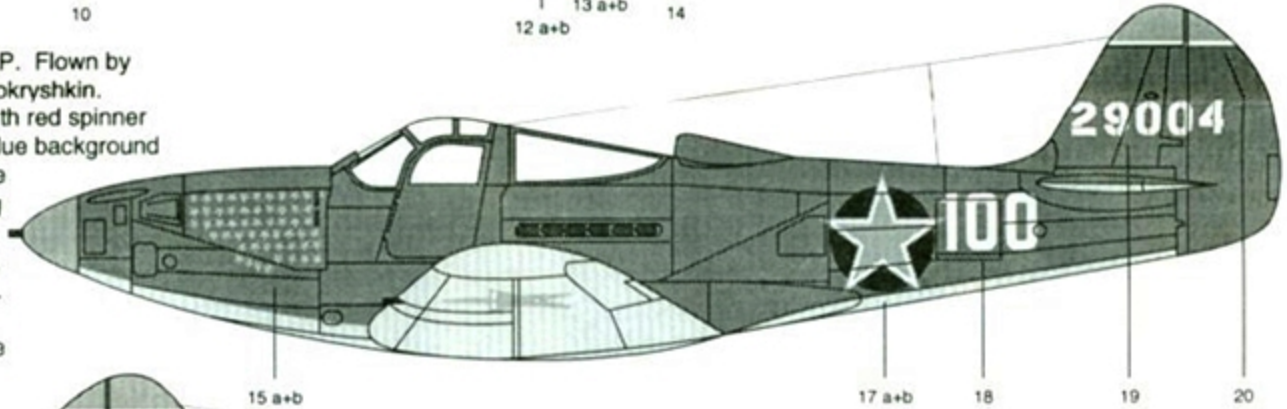
P-39N Airacobra, 9th Guards IAP, 1943. Flown by Maj. Sultan Amet-Khan. U.S. Olive Drab and Neutral Gray camouflage with red spinner.



P-39N, 129th Guards IAP, 1944. Flown by Hero of the Soviet Union N.D. Gulyayev. Olive Drab and Neutral Grey camouflage with white spinner.



P-39N, 42-9004, 9th Guards IAP. Flown by Hero of the Soviet Union A.I. Pokryshkin. Olive Drab and Neutral Gray with red spinner and fin tip. It is likely that the blue background behind the stars is actually olive drab or dark green overpainting (grey or light blue on lower surfaces) of the type of insignia carried by aircraft no. 50 below. Templates are provided on the reverse side should you choose this option. Paint six insignia locations then apply stars.



P-39N, 9th Guards IAP. Flown by Hero of the Soviet Union K.V. Sukhov. Olive Drab and Neutral Grey camouflage with dark green overpainting. Spinner and fin tip red.
