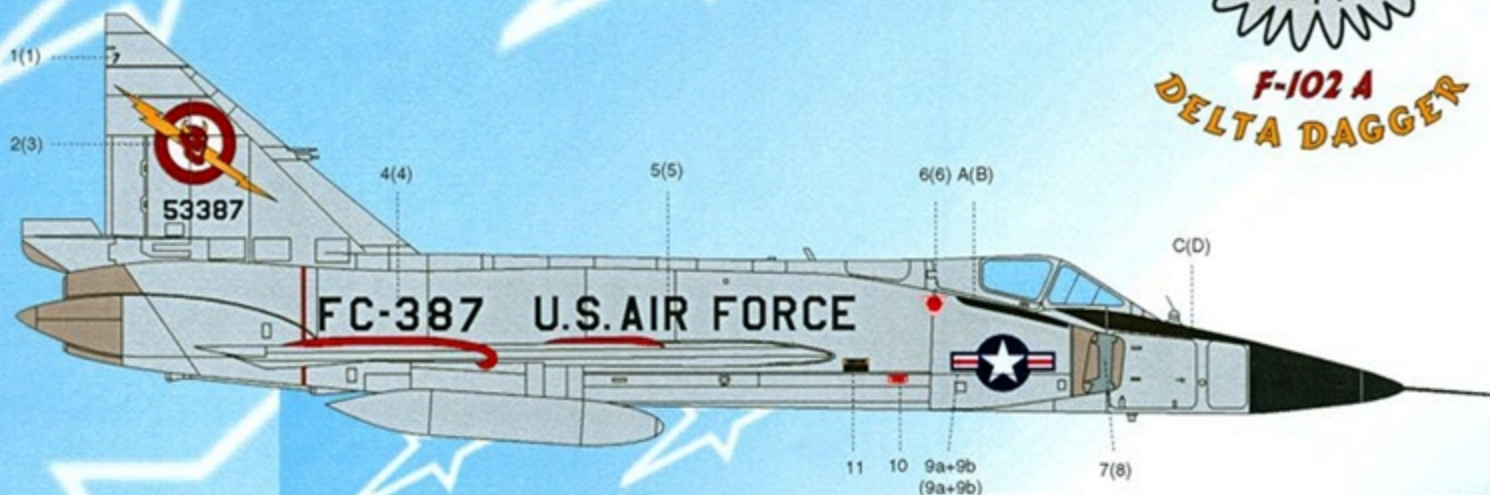


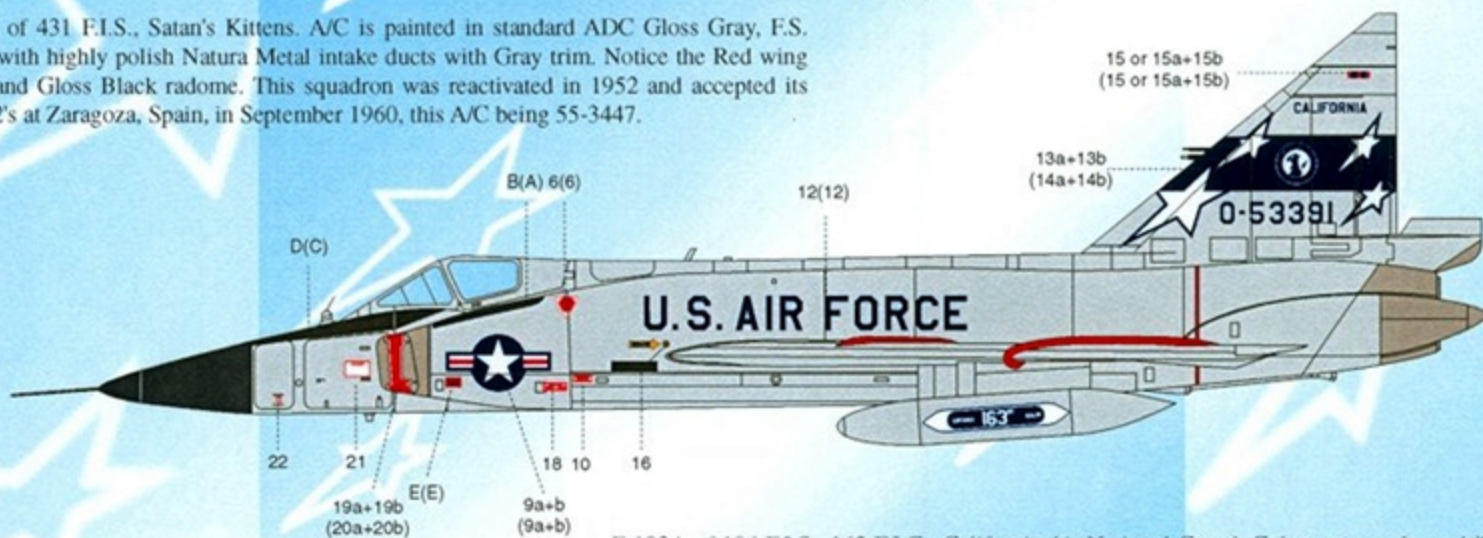

Suggested Kit: Monogram F-102A Delta Dagger



F-102A of 431 F.I.S., Satan's Kittens. A/C is painted in standard ADC Gloss Gray, F.S. 16473, with highly polish Natura Metal intake ducts with Gray trim. Notice the Red wing fences and Gloss Black radome. This squadron was reactivated in 1952 and accepted its first 102's at Zaragoza, Spain, in September 1960, this A/C being 55-3447.



F-102A of 196 F.I.S., 163 F.I.G., California Air National Guard. Colors as per above A/C with the exception of the intake duct trim, which is Red. Second unit in California to equip with the 102 flying these birds from 1965 to 75. Believe it or not, this squadron had to give up the Dagger due to complaints about excessive noise and pollution around Ontario International Airport, where they were based. Imagine going from 102's to 0-2A?!! The four stars on the tail marking depict the Southern Cross!
