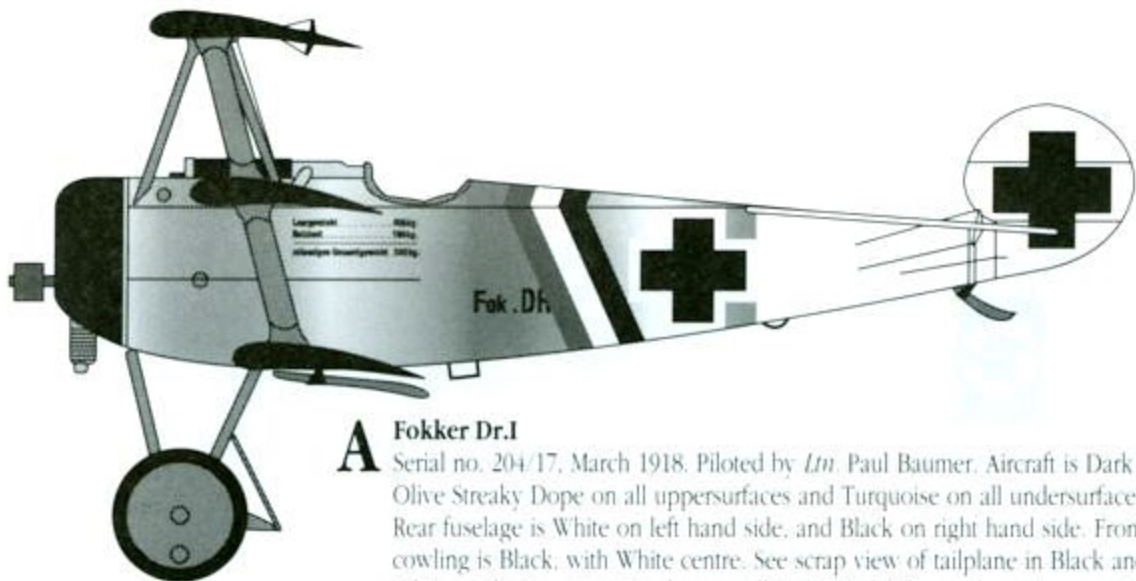

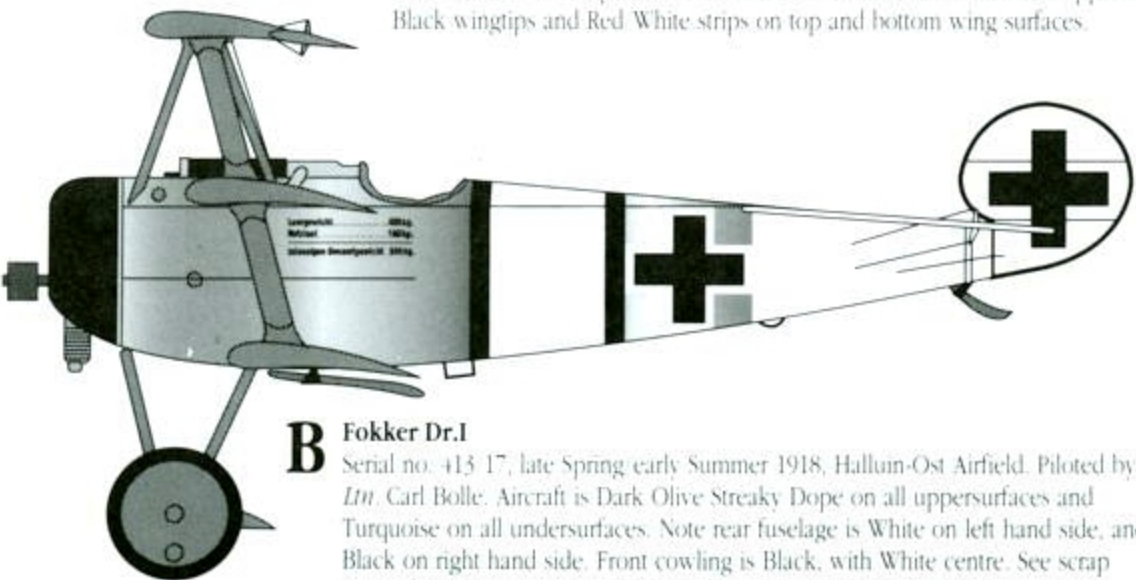
THE FOKKER DR.I'S OF JASTA 2

A 1/48 scale decal sheet set for four of Jasta 2's colourfully marked Fokker Dr.I's during 1918



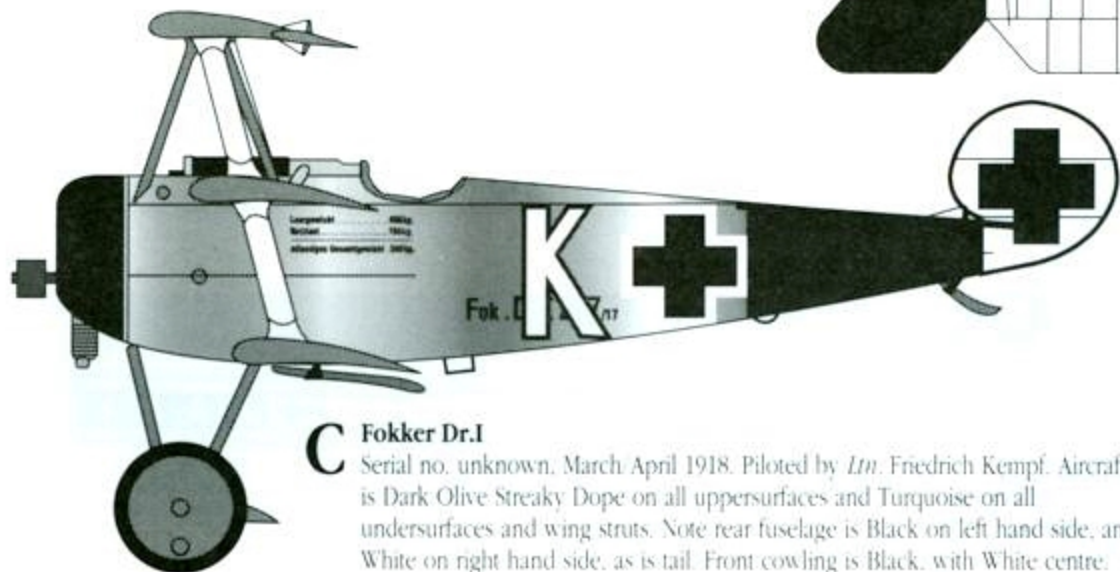
A Fokker Dr.I

Serial no. 204/17, March 1918. Piloted by *Ltn.* Paul Baumer. Aircraft is Dark Olive Streaky Dope on all uppersurfaces and Turquoise on all undersurfaces. Rear fuselage is White on left hand side, and Black on right hand side. Front cowling is Black, with White centre. See scrap view of tailplane in Black and White, and note overpainted cross. All struts Dark Olive. Also note opposite Black wingtips and Red White strips on top and bottom wing surfaces.



B Fokker Dr.I

Serial no. +13 17, late Spring early Summer 1918, Halluin-Ost Airfield. Piloted by *Ltn.* Carl Bolle. Aircraft is Dark Olive Streaky Dope on all uppersurfaces and Turquoise on all undersurfaces. Note rear fuselage is White on left hand side, and Black on right hand side. Front cowling is Black, with White centre. See scrap view of tailplane opposite in Black and White. All struts Dark Olive. The wing scrap view opposite shows cross position for Aircraft B.



C Fokker Dr.I

Serial no. unknown, March/April 1918. Piloted by *Lt.* Friedrich Kempf. Aircraft is Dark Olive Streaky Dope on all upper surfaces and Turquoise on all undersurfaces and wing struts. Note rear fuselage is Black on left hand side, and White on right hand side, as is tail. Front cowling is Black, with White centre.
