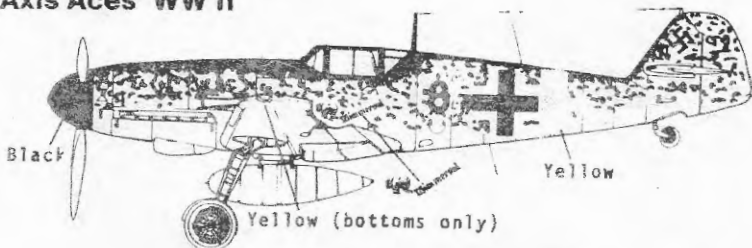


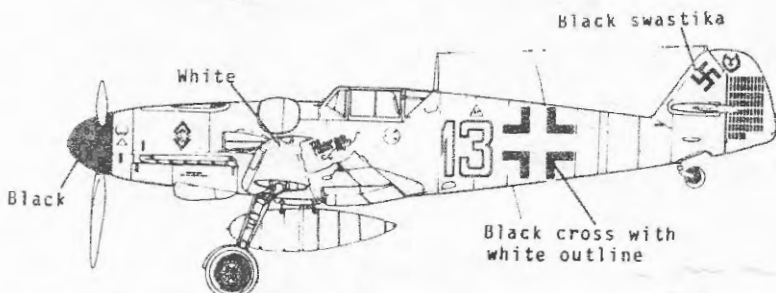

No black edge to fuselage cross.

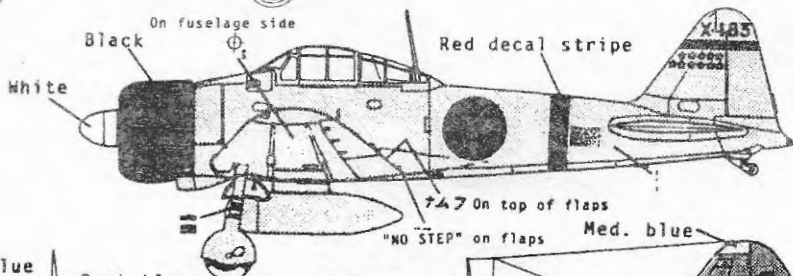


Bf 109G IV/JG 27

Camouflage as above.

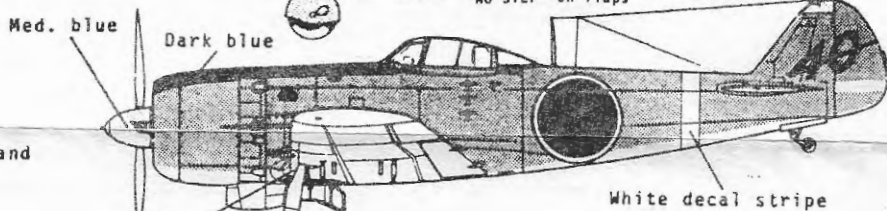

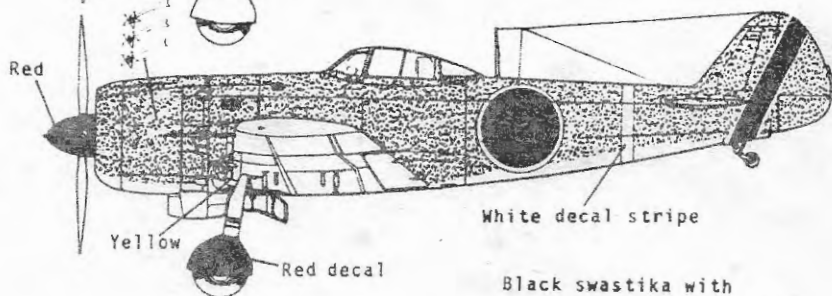
Mitsubishi A6M2 Zero-Sen

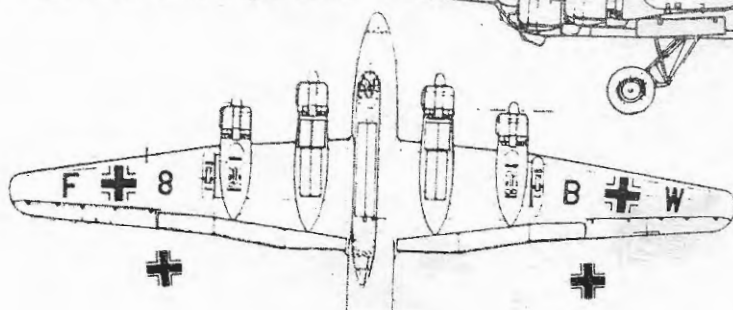
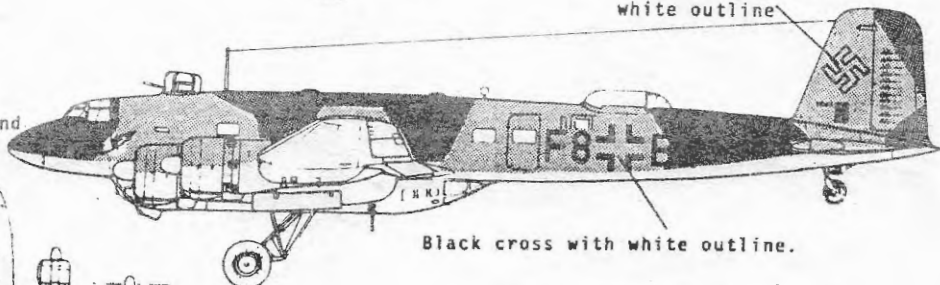
Nakajima Ki 84 Hayate
