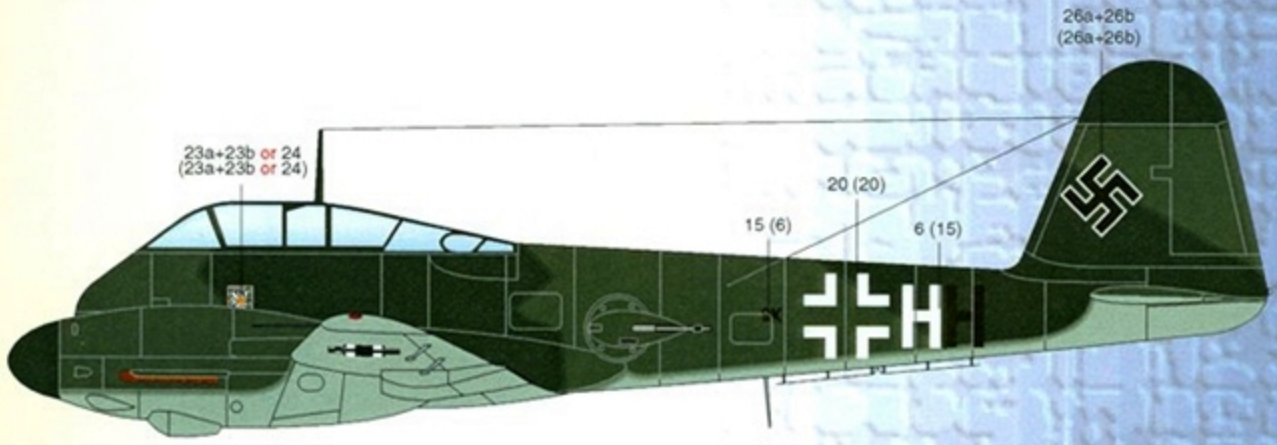

Camouflage is standard scheme of RLM 74 Graugrün and RLM 75 Grauviolett uppersurfaces and RLM 76 Lichtblau undersurfaces, fuselage mottling is 74/75 and RLM 02 Grau. RLM 70 Schwartzgrün spinners with thin white bands. Note RLM 04 Gelb fuselage band. Photo on page 44 of reference 1 and also on back cover. Right side reads: —  -2



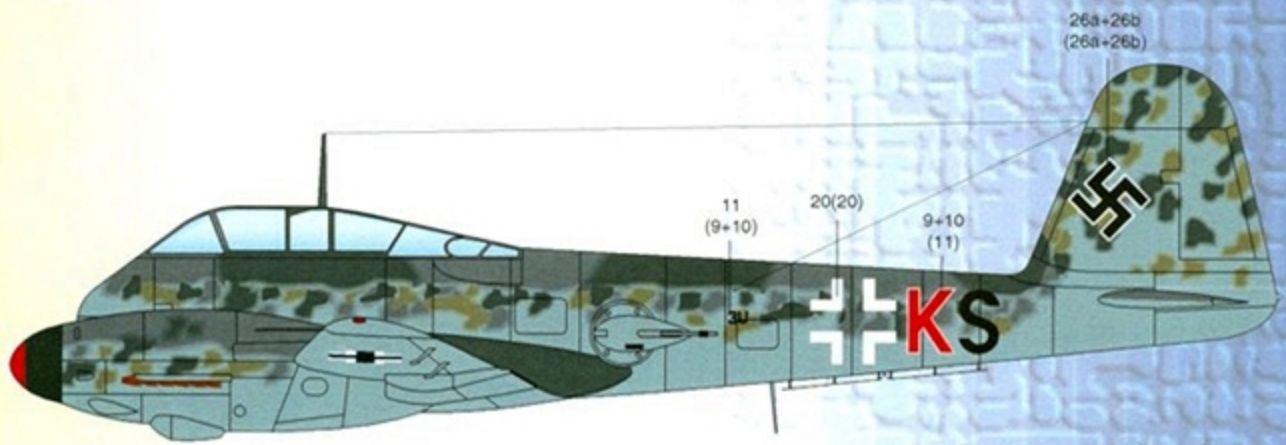
AIRCRAFT 2 • Me-410B-2/U2/R2 of Egr.Gr.KG51 (Jagd), Germany, 1944. Camouflage is standard scheme of RLM 74 Graugrün and RLM 75 Grauviolett uppersurfaces and RLM 76 Lichtblau undersurfaces, fuselage mottling is 74/75 and RLM 02 Grau, factory codes overpainted with RLM 75. Note RLM 04 Gelb and RLM 23 Röt fuselage band. RLM 04 Gelb spinners. Photo on page 41 of reference 1 and also on center fold. Right side reads:  V.



AIRCRAFT 3 • Me-410A-1 of I./KG51 'Edelweiß', Beauvais, France, 1944. Camouflage is standard early scheme of RLM 70 Schwartzgrün and RLM 71 Dunkelgrün uppersurfaces (or 81/82) and RLM 65 Hellblau undersurfaces. RLM 70 spinners. Right side reads:  H



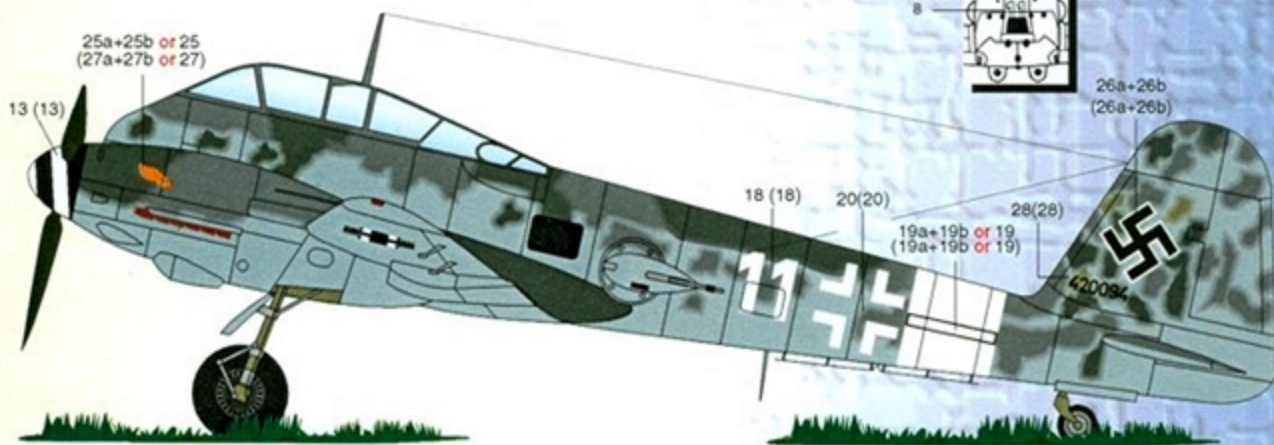
AIRCRAFT 4 • Me-410A-1/U2 of 8./ZG.26. Camouflage is standard scheme of RLM 74 Graugrün and RLM 75 Grauviolett uppersurfaces and RLM 76 Lichtblau undersurfaces, fuselage mottling is 74/75 and RLM 02 Grau. RLM 70 Schwartzgrün spinners with red tips. Right side reads:  KS



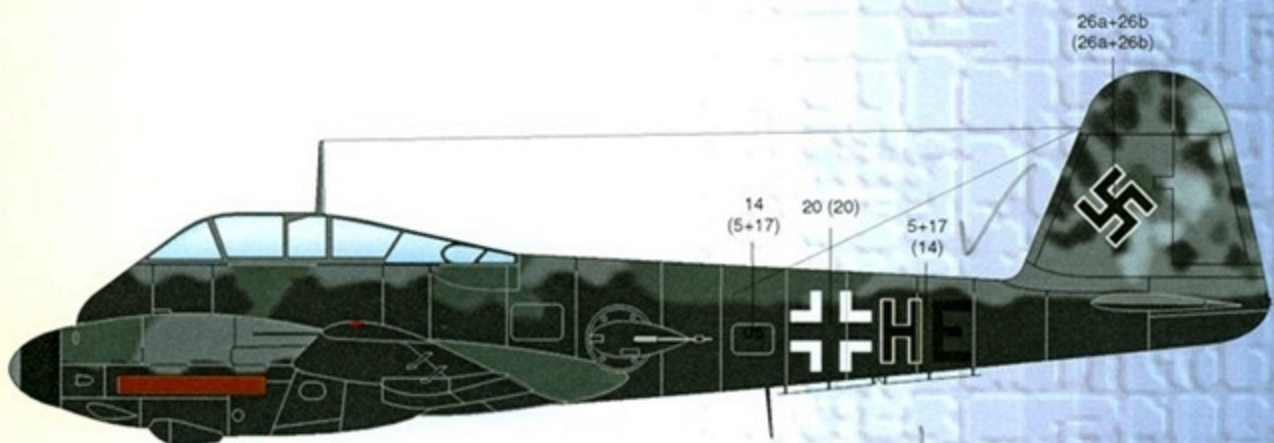

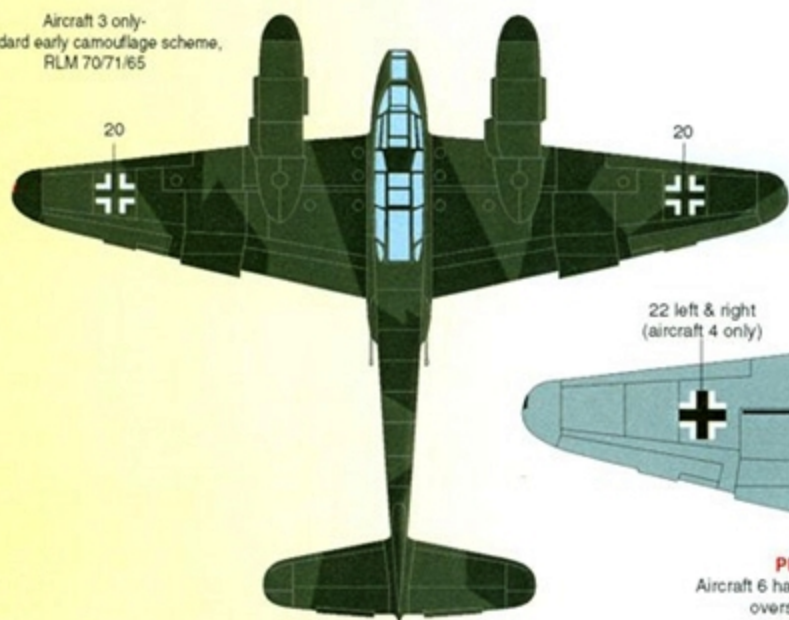
AIRCRAFT 5 • Me-410B-1/U2/R4 of II./ZG.26. Camouflage is standard scheme of RLM 74 Graugrün and RLM 75 Grauviolett uppersurfaces and RLM 76 Lichtblau undersurfaces, fuselage mottling is 74/75 with dabs of RLM 02 Grau. Note white fuselage band. Black spinners with white spirals. Ammunition access panel forward of fuselage barbette in RLM 66 Schwarzgrau. We do not know whether the serial number was carried on the right side. Right side reads: 



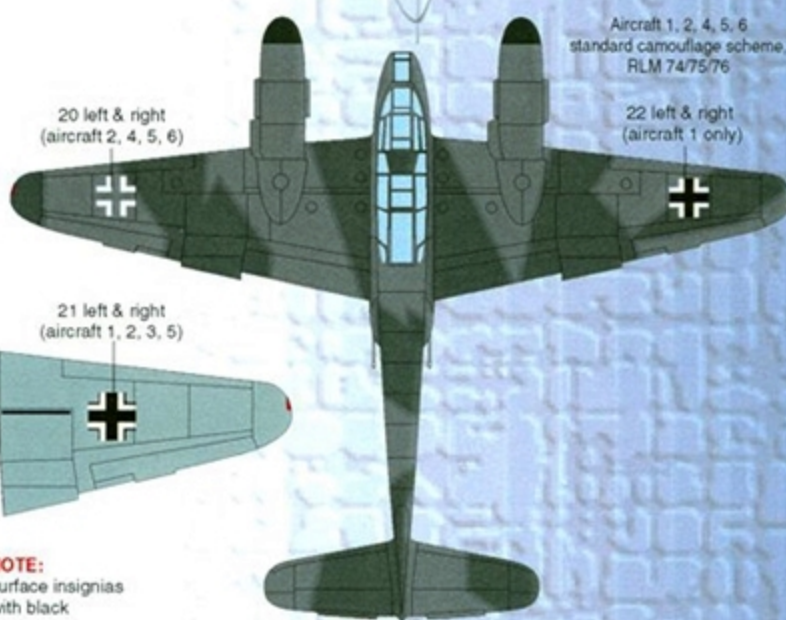
AIRCRAFT 6 • Me-410B-1 of 14./KG2, France, 1944. Camouflage is standard scheme of RLM 74 Graugrün and RLM 75 Grauviolett uppersurfaces and RLM 76 Lichtblau undersurfaces, nacelle sides and undersurfaces completely oversprayed with a washed out black, or RLM 66, tail lightly oversprayed. Note flame-damper exhausts. Spinners black with grey tips. Please note that Black U5 and E codes will not show unless you use a wash out Black paint on lowersurfaces. In the photo you could hardly see them. Right side reads: 



Aircraft 3 only - standard early camouflage scheme, RLM 70/71/65



Aircraft 1, 2, 4, 5, 6 standard camouflage scheme, RLM 74/75/76



PLEASE NOTE:
Aircraft 6 had undersurface insignias oversprayed with black undersurface color.
