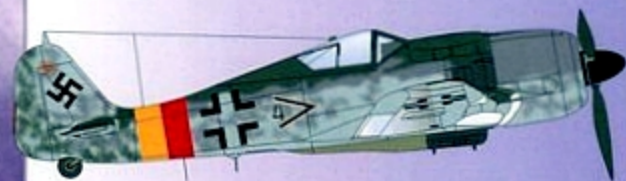

A/C Type Fw-190 F/B W.Nr. 330786.

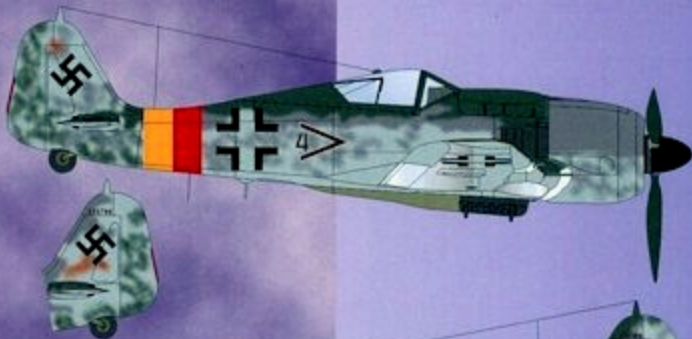
Unit 1./JG. 301.

Locale & Date Germany, 1945.

Camouflage & Markings A/C seems to wear the standard camouflage of 75/82/76 with a Black spinner. Several parts of this A/C underbelly seem to be unpainted or primed in RLM 52, such as the rear of the bomb/rack.

A/C Type Fw-190A/B, W.Nr. 350189 (tentatively).

Unit 12./JUG/5.

Locale & Date Unknown, early Spring '45.

Camouflage & Markings RLM 82, 75 over RLM 78 with Yellow/Black Reich defense bands. Black cowling and spirated spinner.

A/C Type Fw-190 A/4 W.Nr. 611.

Unit SG2 or SG 10.

Locale & Date Tunisia, early 1943.

Camouflage & Markings RLM 79/76/76. RLM 78 was used only on the fuselage sides of this A/C. The bottom was RLM 76. This A/C was apparently re-painted and kept the 76 undersurfaces and lower rudder. Fuselage cross was also oversprayed in possibly RLM 76. Notice tropical filter.

Pilot & Unit Odt. Waldi Radener 11./JG 26.

Locale & Date Tunisia, early 1943.

Camouflage & Markings Typical camouflage of the period with RLM 74/75/76, RLM 70 prop/spinner and Yellow lower cowling and rudder.
