Command. Note the unusual
size changes to the code letters.

Spitfire F.22 SR65 Squadron, Southern 16L(16R) Rhodesian Air Force, (14a+h) 15(15) Salisbury, Rhodesia, June 1953. F.22 Spitfires equipped 1 and 2 Squadrons of the SRAF **SR65** until early 1954. The finish of these aircraft was an overall gloss Light Grey.

613 (City of Manchester) Squadron, Royal Auxiliary Air Force, Gatwick, July 1949. Photographic reference of this aircraft shows a high gloss finish. Note the extra thin code letters and squadron badge on tail fin. Colors on A/C 2 and 4 were originally glossy but due to wear and tear they may have turned semi gloss.
