






Anti-glare in front of windshield flat black. National insignias on upper left and lower right wings only.



F8F-1B Bearcat, No. 5167, GC 1/22 Saintonge, Tonkin, French Indochina, 1953. Overall Sea Blue Gloss (ANA 623/F.S. 15042). Note two 20mm cannon in wings.
