**AIRCRAFT 1** F-4E-35-MC Phantom 67-308, Betty Lou, of the 469th TFS. Crewed by the Commander of the 388th TFW, Colonel A.K. McDonald and his WSO, 1/Lt Jack Fisher, Korat in February of 1969. Standard SEA camouflage. Command stripes in the colors of the 388th's three component squadrons applied to both sides of the fuselage. Air and ground crew names were carried on the left and right side canopy frames in White on a squadron color (Green) field. Borderless national insignia, full Red turbine warning stripe and the "last three" in White on the Green nose bay door interior. Note the non-standard application of the aircraft serial number on the left side of the vertical tail. We have provided shark mouths for Hasegawa and ESCI/AMT F-4Es. A/C can be depicted with or without the fuselage bands. Your choice!!

**AIRCRAFT 1**  
Kit Modifications for Early F-4E:

1. Short Gun Gas Diffuser
2. No Wing Slats
3. No Formation Light Panels
4. No Triangular Braces on Upper Horizontal Tails

Kits: Hasegawa F-4E converted to early F-4E.  
F-4 Stencils (AMD Decal # 148-018; temporarily out of stock).

**NOTE:** 18" borderless National Insignia were applied to all upper surfaces at the factory. These were replaced with bordered insignia when the aircraft was repainted at the depot.

**AIRCRAFT 2 & 4**

Kits: Monogram F-105D/F/G.

**NOTE:** The fin tips on F 105's were mostly painted light gray. However, some camouflaged A/C had them painted the same surrounding color, which was Dk. Green. We do not have a clear picture of the fin tip of these aircraft.

**AIRCRAFT 3**

Kits: Tamiya/Monogram/ESCI A-1H.

**AIRCRAFT 2** "The Frito Bandito", F-105D # 59-1731, flown by Major Jose Olvera. 355th Tactical Fighter Wing, Takhli, 1970.

**AIRCRAFT 3** "The Good Buddha", A-1H, Serial #34609. 1st Special Operations Squadron, 56th Special Operations Wing, Nakhon Phanom, 1968. SEA camouflage, undersides Light Gray 36622. Aircraft carried national insignias on wings only.

**AIRCRAFT 4** "SAM FIGHTER", F-105G-1 #63-8311. Pilot Major Bill Scott, EWO Captain Cliff Gollino. 354th Tactical Fighter Squadron, 355th Tactical Fighter Wing, Takhli, 1970. Standard SEA camouflage scheme. It is very likely this A/C had White wheel hubs.
