Post Korean War Sabres



Suggested Kit: Hasegawa/ Academy F-86F Sabre.

F-86 F, s/n 52-4628, of the 69 FBS, flown by Lt.R.B. Ochs, Korea, post 1954, possibly 1957. Natural metal overall with Blue nose, canopy frame and fin/ rudder bands. Black lightning and White stars. Full Yellow ID bands.

NOTE:

Modeller must match and paint the Blue nose sections and canopy frames prior to decaling. Plan ahead!



F-86 F, s/n 52-4781 of the 69 FBS, Flown by Lt.B. B.Huffman, Osan, Korea, Nov 1955. Natural metal overall with Blue nose, fin/rudder band, canopy frame and Black lightning with White stars. Full Yellow ID bands.



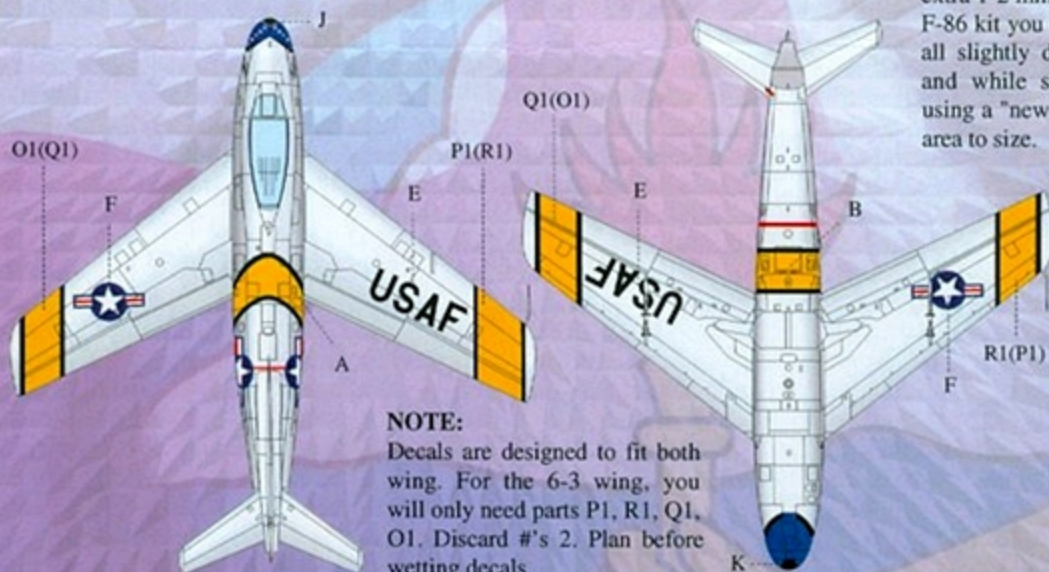
NOTE:

The nose lightning decal is a little oversize on the bottom section. These extra 1-2 mm. will allow you to use any F-86 kit you may want to use. They are all slightly different. Apply the decal, and while still wet, "CAREFULLY" using a "new" blade, cut the wheel well area to size.



NOTE:

Notice that both Lightning bolts meet on top of the nose and behind the radome Black patch.

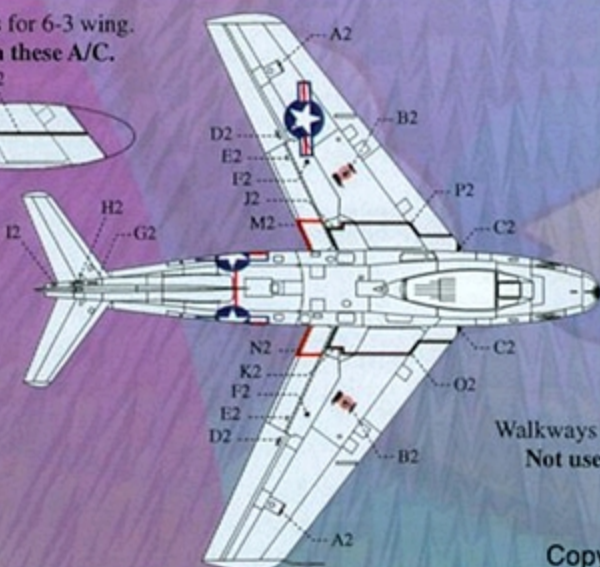


NOTE:

Decals are designed to fit both wing. For the 6-3 wing, you will only need parts P1, R1, Q1, O1. Discard #'s 2. Plan before wetting decals.
