Suggested Kit: Monogram/Revell/Hasegawa Ju 87D



Ju 87D-3, of 4/SG 2, Russia, summer, 1943. Scheme is standard RLM 70/71 on upper surfaces with RLM 65 on lower surfaces. Bottom wing tips and fuselage band are RLM 04. Tip of the prop spinner is White.



Ju 87D-3, from 9/SIG 77, Wschodni Front, Russia, winter 1943. Scheme is White over RLM 65/70/71 with RLM 04 fuselage band and lower wing tips. Spinner is RLM 70 with RLM 04 and White stripes. White distemper color seems to be fading or washing off.



JU-87D-3, 861, of 3/6 Dive Bomber Group, Royal Romanian Air Force, September, 1944. Paint scheme is standard Luftwaffe pattern of RLM 70 and RLM 71 over RLM 65. Former Luftwaffe markings painted over prior to application of new national markings. Yellow tail stripe is 48 cm wide. Yellow panels on outboard undersides of both wing tips. Propeller and spinner are RLM 70 with white spiral stripe. Under wing crosses over painted with light blue, similar to RLM 65.



Notice oversized bottom wing crosses

Note:
Apply underwing cross before gluing the
dive brake. Then apply dive brake decals.
