



BF-109K-4, Wk. Nr. 330230, 9/JG 77, Tillburg, Belgium, January 1, 1945. Flown by Uffz. Heinrich Munninger (from 10/JG 77) who was shot down by AA fire. Scheme is RLM 81/82 with spots of RLM 82 and whisps of RLM 81 over RLM 84 sides. Undersides are RLM 76.




BF-109K-4, Wk. Nr. 330204, 9/JG 77, Rosendaal, Holland, January 1, 1945.


Flown by Lt. Herbert Abendroth who was shot down by friendly anti-aircraft guns and then taken prisoner. Scheme is RLM 81/82 with spots of RLM 82 and whisps of RLM 81 over RLM 84 sides. Undersides are RLM 76.



FW-190A8, Wk. Nr. 732088, 15/JG 54, Brussels, Belgium, January 1, 1945. This plane was flown by Uffz. Gerhard Ohlenschlager and was forced down by Allied fire. He belly landed and was taken prisoner. Scheme is RLM 81/82 with splotches of RLM 82 over RLM 76.



FW-190D9, Wk. Nr. 210045, 11/JG 54, January 1, 1945. This plane was flown by Hauptmann Willi Bottlander on the New Years Day raid and did not return home. Scheme is RLM 81/82 on upper surfaces with splotches of RLM 82 over RLM 76. Rudder and underside of engine cowling are RLM 04 yellow.


