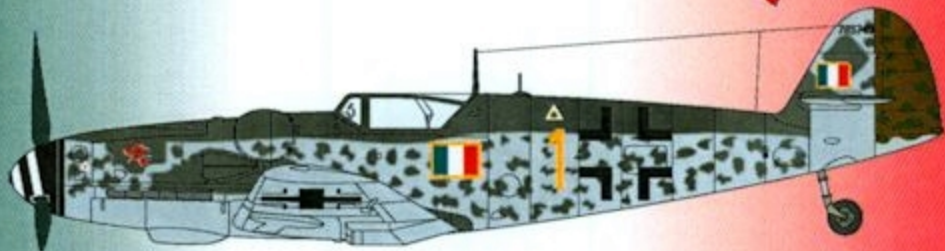

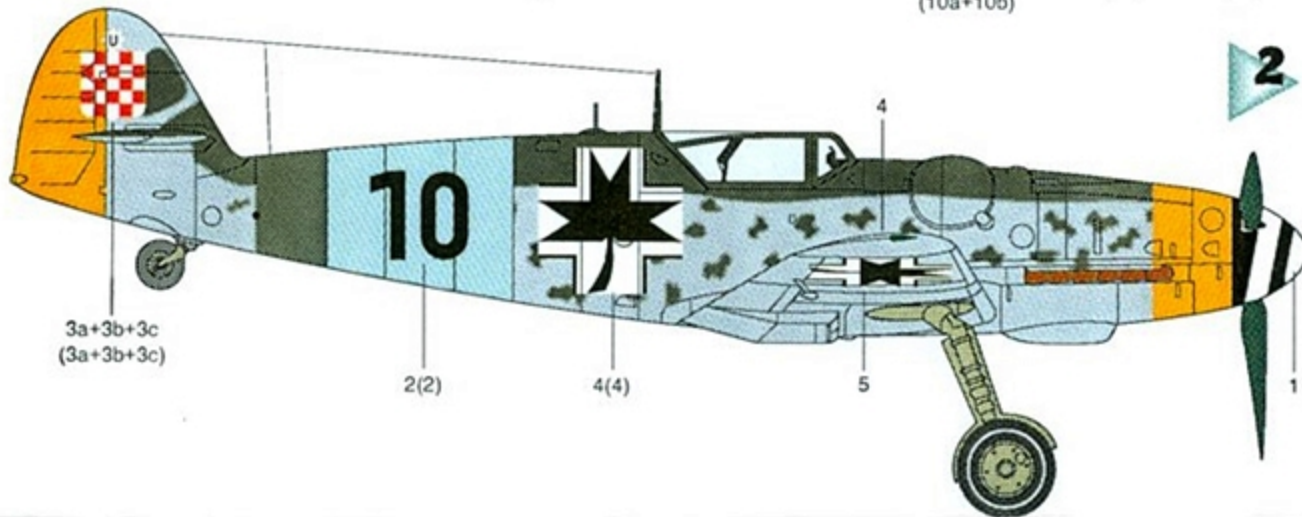
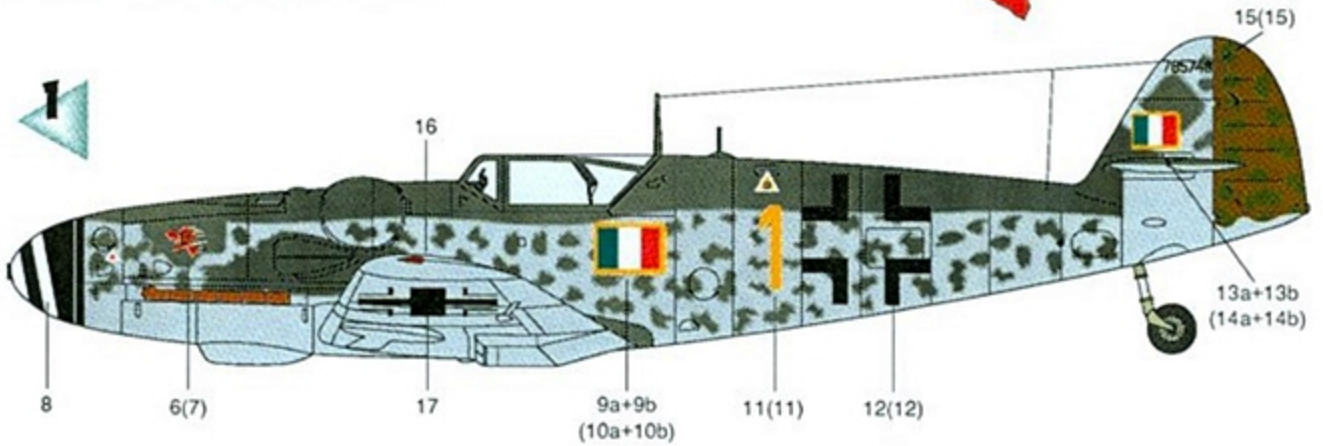

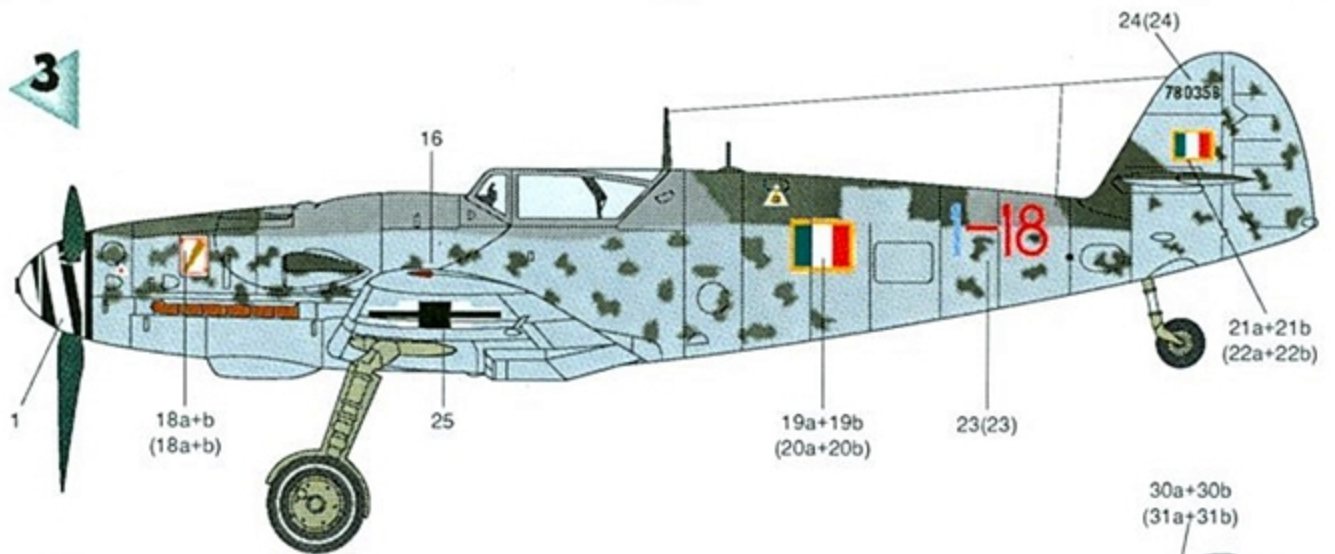


Magg. Bellagambi of the ANR's 5th Sq., IInd Fighter Group flew this Bf109G-14 out of Osoppo in Mar., 1945. Probable colors are RLM74, RLM75 and RLM76. Note the heavy fuselage mottling and replacement rudder in RLM81 and RLM82.



"Black 10," a Bf109G-14 flown by Fw. Cekovic of 2. Kroat Jagd Staffel, defected to the Allies in April, 1945. Probable colors of this aircraft are RLM74, RLM75 and RLM 76. Note the over-painted fuselage section — in RLM 74 and in either RLM65 or RLM 78 — as well as the yellow rudder and nose band. Note painted out areas below upper wing insignia (normally RLM 74 or 75)

Wearing RLM74 and RLM 75 over RLM76 Lichtgrau, this Bf109G-14/AS of the ANR's Ist Sq., Ist Fighter Group, operated from Lonate Pozzolo in March, 1945. Note the painted-out German fuselage cross.



This Bf109G-10/AS/R3 of the ANR's 2nd Sq., Ist Fighter Group in April, 1945, sports the standard RLM74 Dunkelgrau and RLM 75 Grauviolet over RLM 76 Lichtgrau. Paint the area behind the German fuselage cross RLM 74 before applying decal 29.
