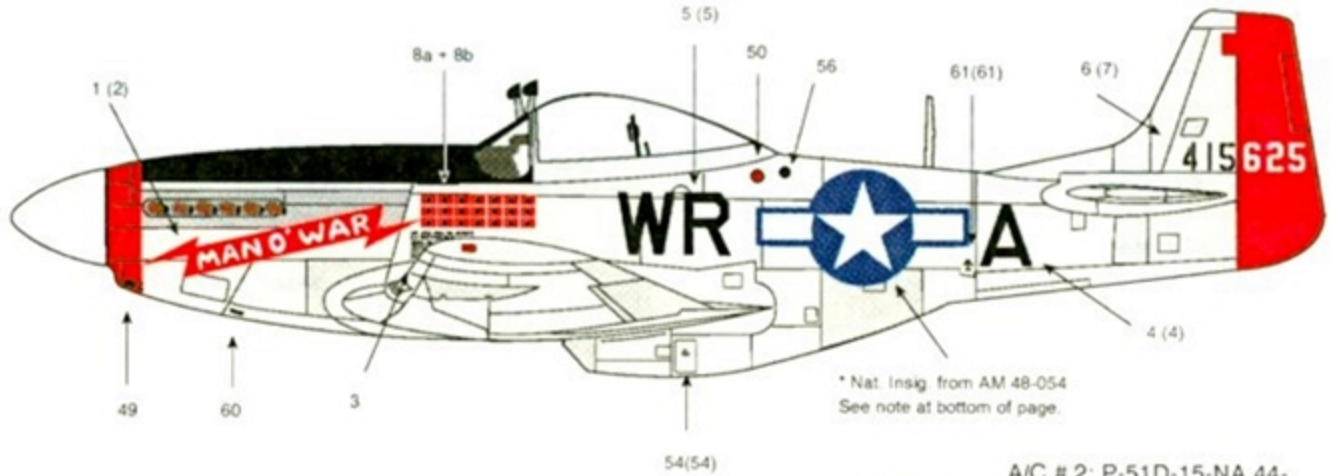

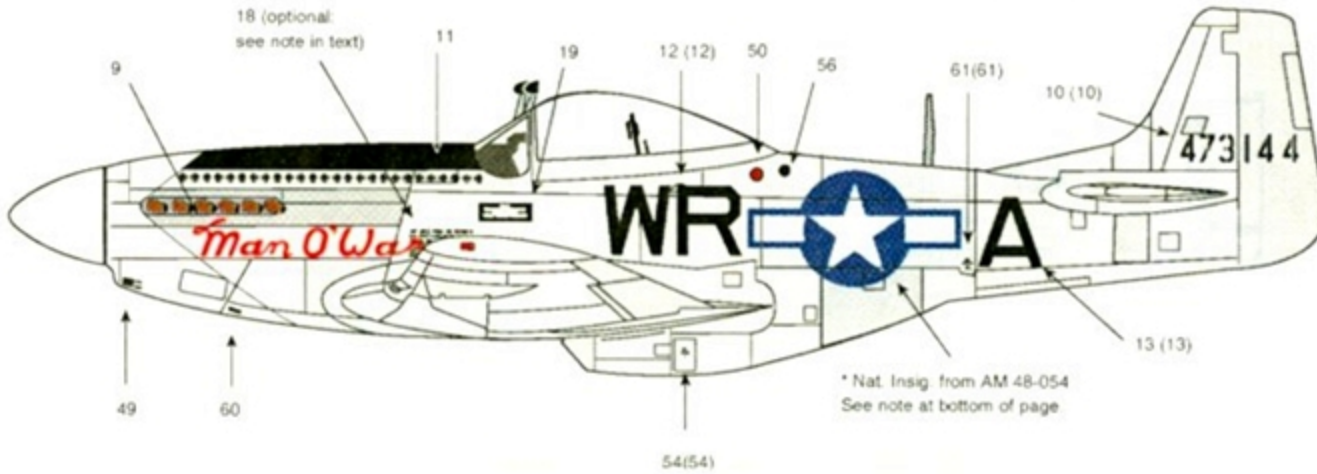

mirrors, painted black.



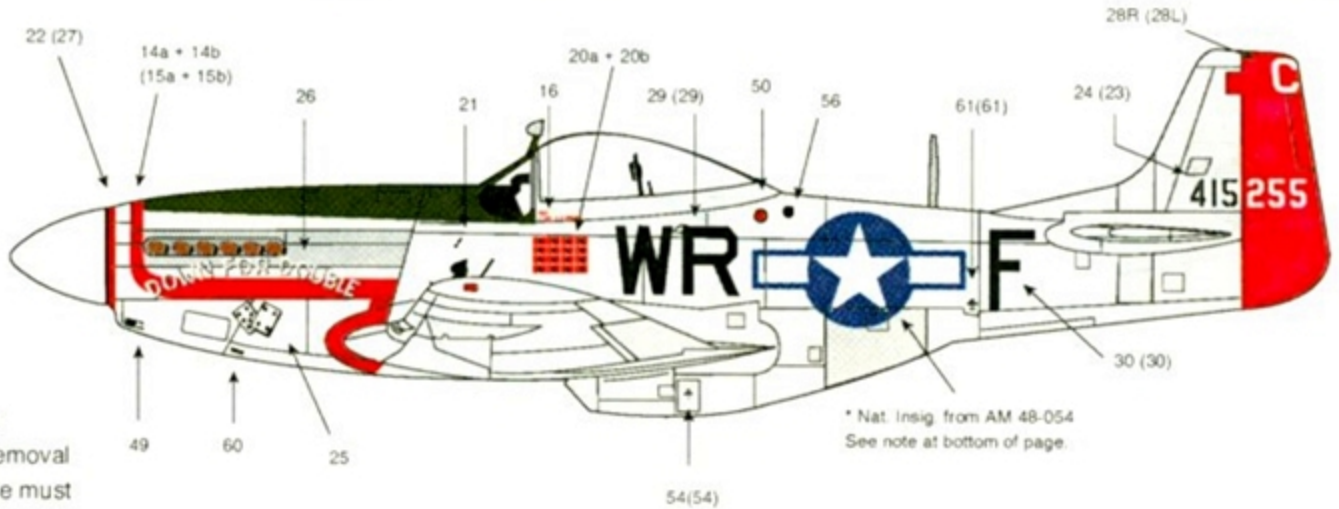

duraluminum finish with white
spinner and forward nose.
Weathered black anti-glare
panel. Two rear view mirrors
painted black. A/C data block
(decal 18) has been provided
even though references
appear to show its removal by
this point in time.



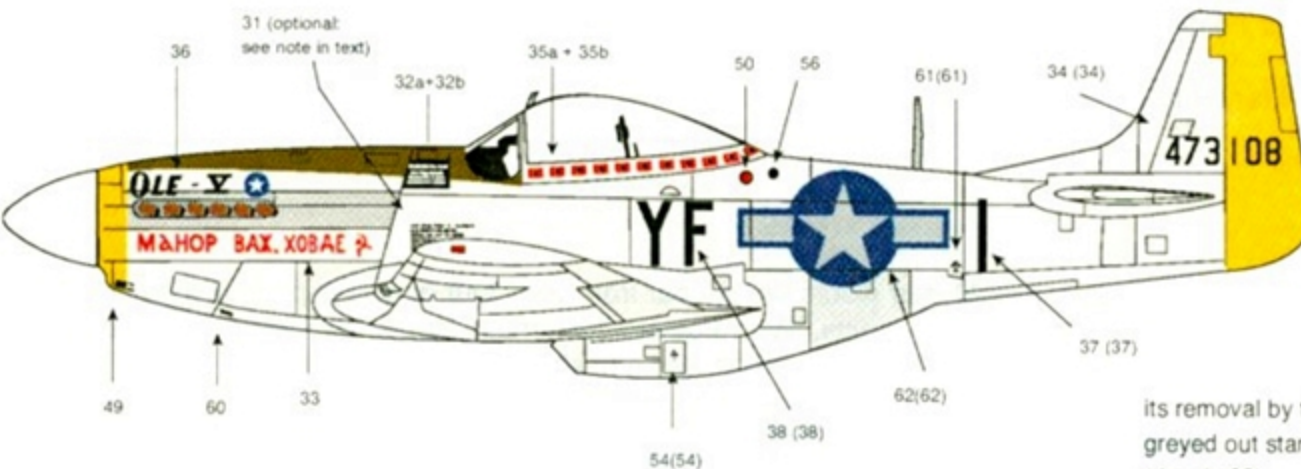

A/C # 3: P-51D-15-NA 44-
15255, flown by First Lt. Col.
Gordon Graham, 354th FS,
355th FG, March/April 1945.
Overall duraluminum finish
with white spinner, forward
nose, and lower forward
fuselage. Red rudder and
med. green anti-glare panel.
A/C data block (decal 17)
has been provided even though
references appear to show its
removal by this point in time.
Note: Nose must
be painted before decaling.



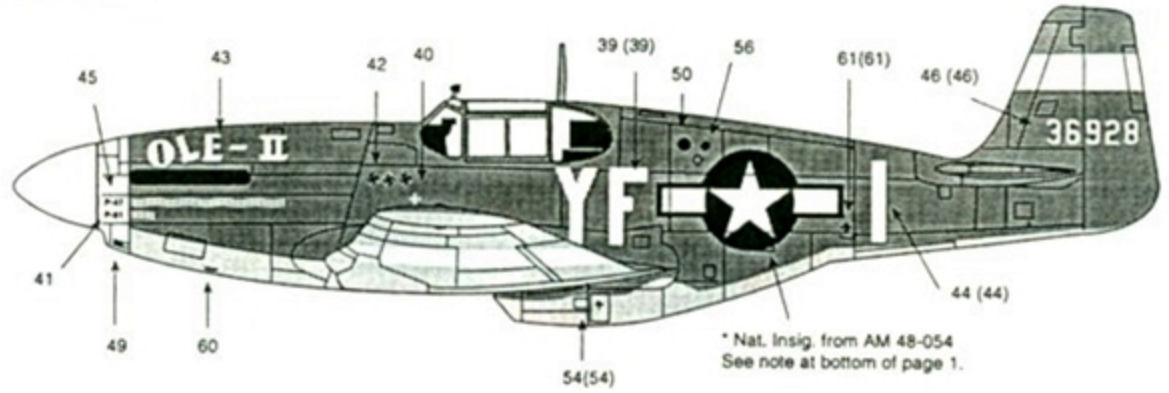

A/C # 4: P-51D-25-NA 44-
73108, flown by Maj.
William Hovde, 358th FS,
355nd FG, December
1944. Overall duraluminum
finish with white spinner.
Yellow nose band and
rudder. Olive drab anti-
glare panel. A/C data block
(decal 31) has been
provided even though
references appear to show
its removal by this point in time.
Note the
greyed out star and bars of the national insignia
(decals 62).



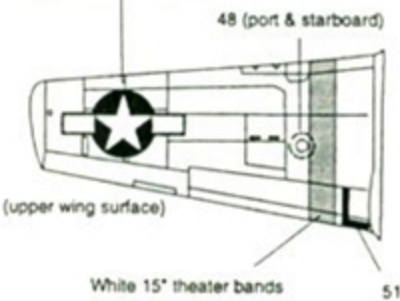

 show decal 40 instead.

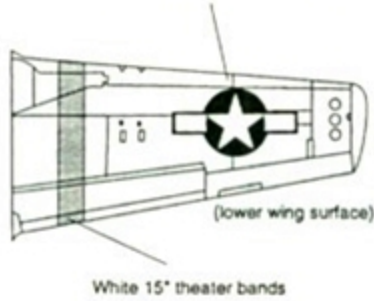

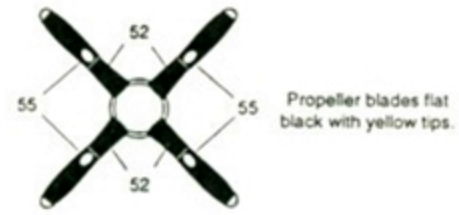
