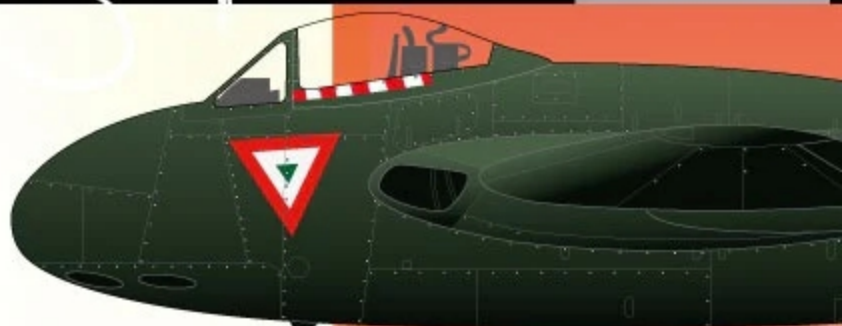

After the conflict between Mexico and Guatemala known as *Cerro de Pasé* (December 20th 1958-September 13th, 1959), in 1960, México quickly acquired from *Blount Inc.* in Wisconsin, from 15 were ex-BCAF (*Royal Canadian Air Force*, operated between 1948-1956) DH.100 Mk.III Vampires, that they couldn't sell as private jets due the restrictions of the *American Royal Aviation Administration*. The Vampires arrived at beginnings of 1961, and entered in service in February 14th, 1961, with the *Fuerza Aérea Mexicana* (Mexican Air Force, FAM), becoming their first combat jets. As *Elterway Inc.* though to use them for civilian purposes, the Vampires didn't have their four 20 mm cannons, so they had to get buy in the United Kingdom. Only 14 vampires were operated by the FAM, and were numbered FAM1-FAM14, the 15th was used for spare parts.

The Vampires were assigned to the *Escuadrón Aéreo de Pelea 200* (200th Air Squadron) with the mission of:

"Day fighters of double purpose, assigned to missions of air defense and tactical support to ground units"

For a long time, the *Escuadrón 200* was a *ghost squadron*, because only existed in paper, because of this, the Vampires adopted the ghost insignia that the *FAM A-21 Bandera* & *AT-6 Texas* wore, and also wore for the first time the shark mouth. The Mexican pilots had to familiarize with the Vampires through ground school training. In 1983, with the arrival of the 20 mm cannons, Mexican technicians re-armed and reconfigured the Vampires.
