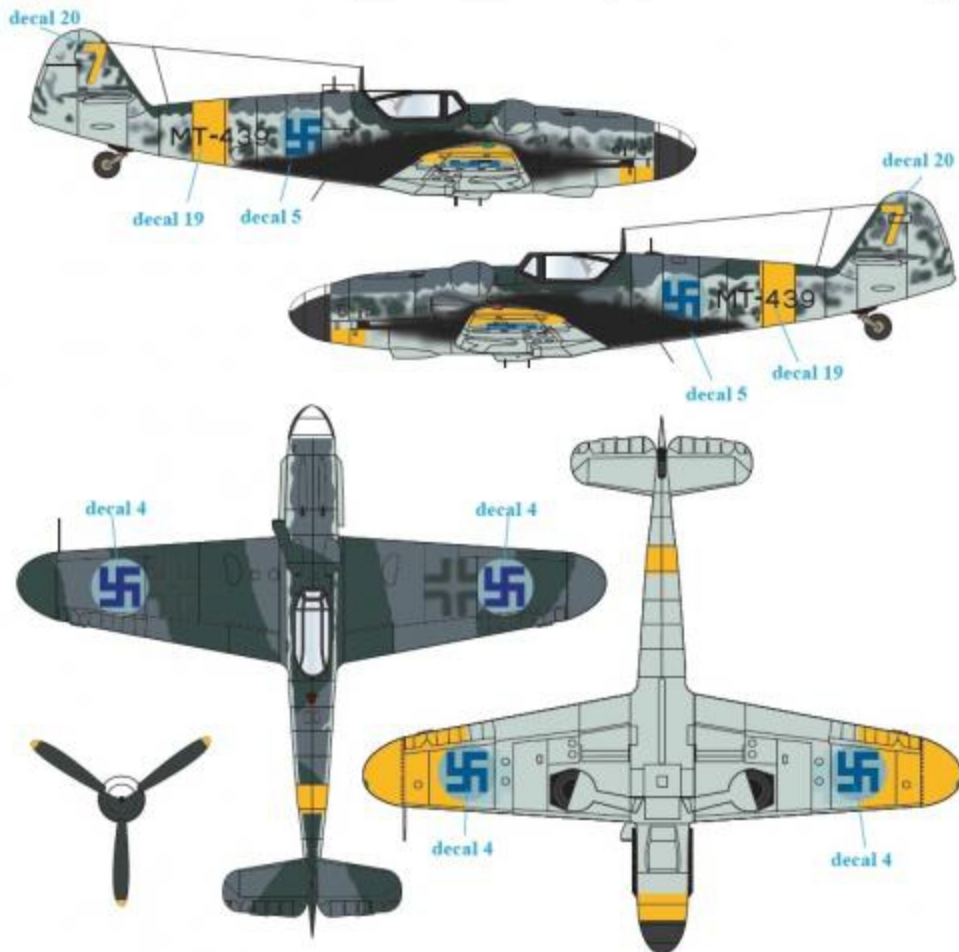
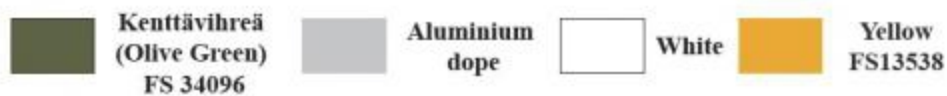
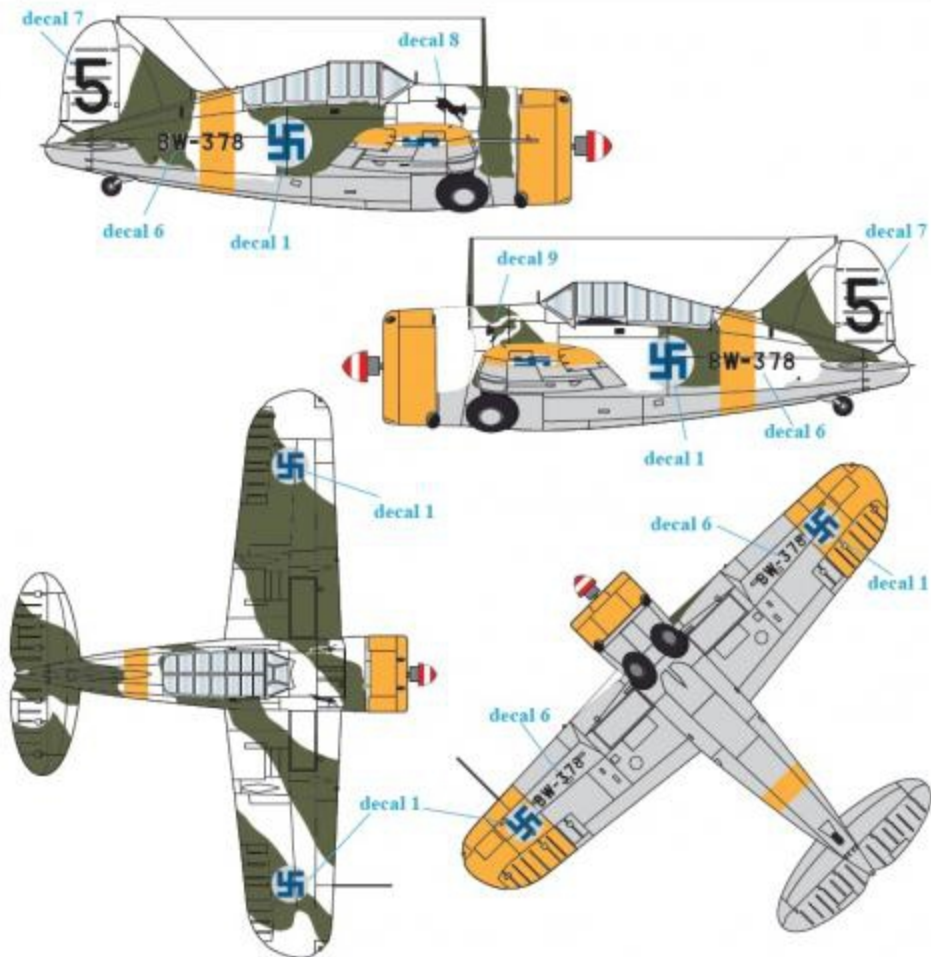


Messerschmitt Bf 109 G-6, MT-439 of 3/HLeLv 24, Lappeenranta, June 1944.

 plane and in just ten days.

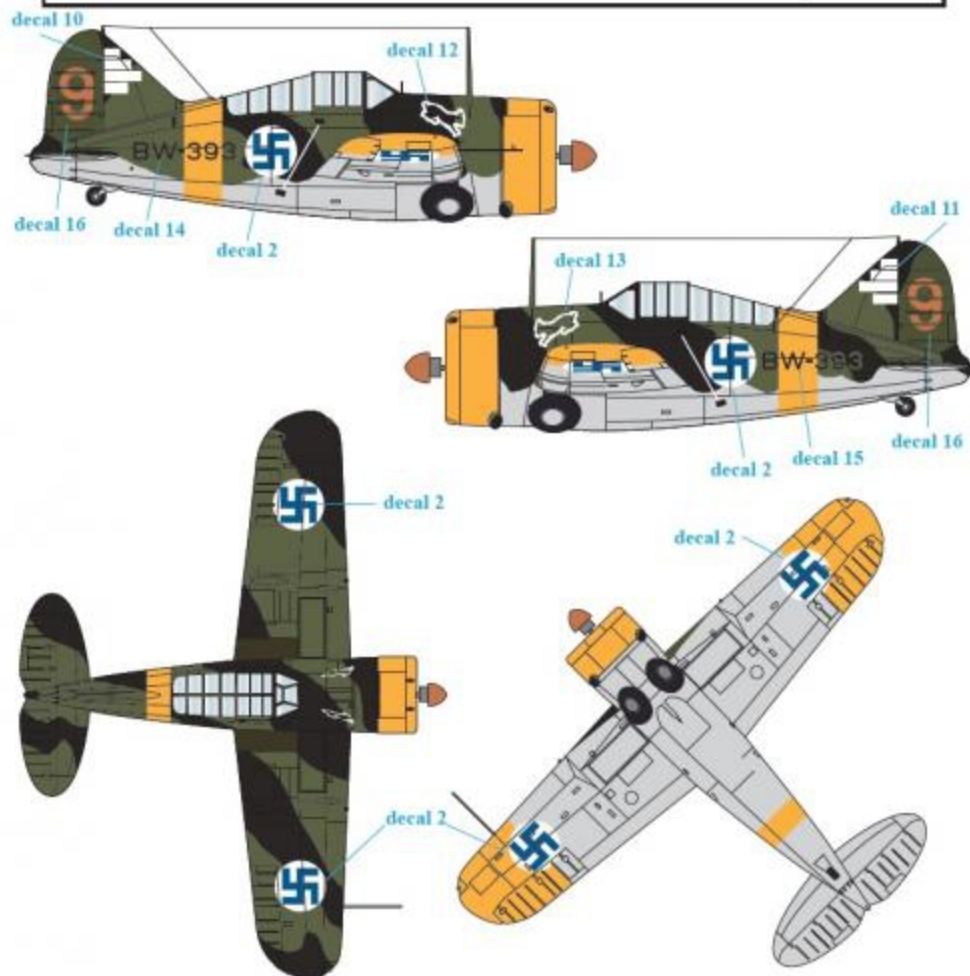

Tactical marking Black 5 on White rudder. Wind flew this plane for six months, but claimed only one shared victory with it.



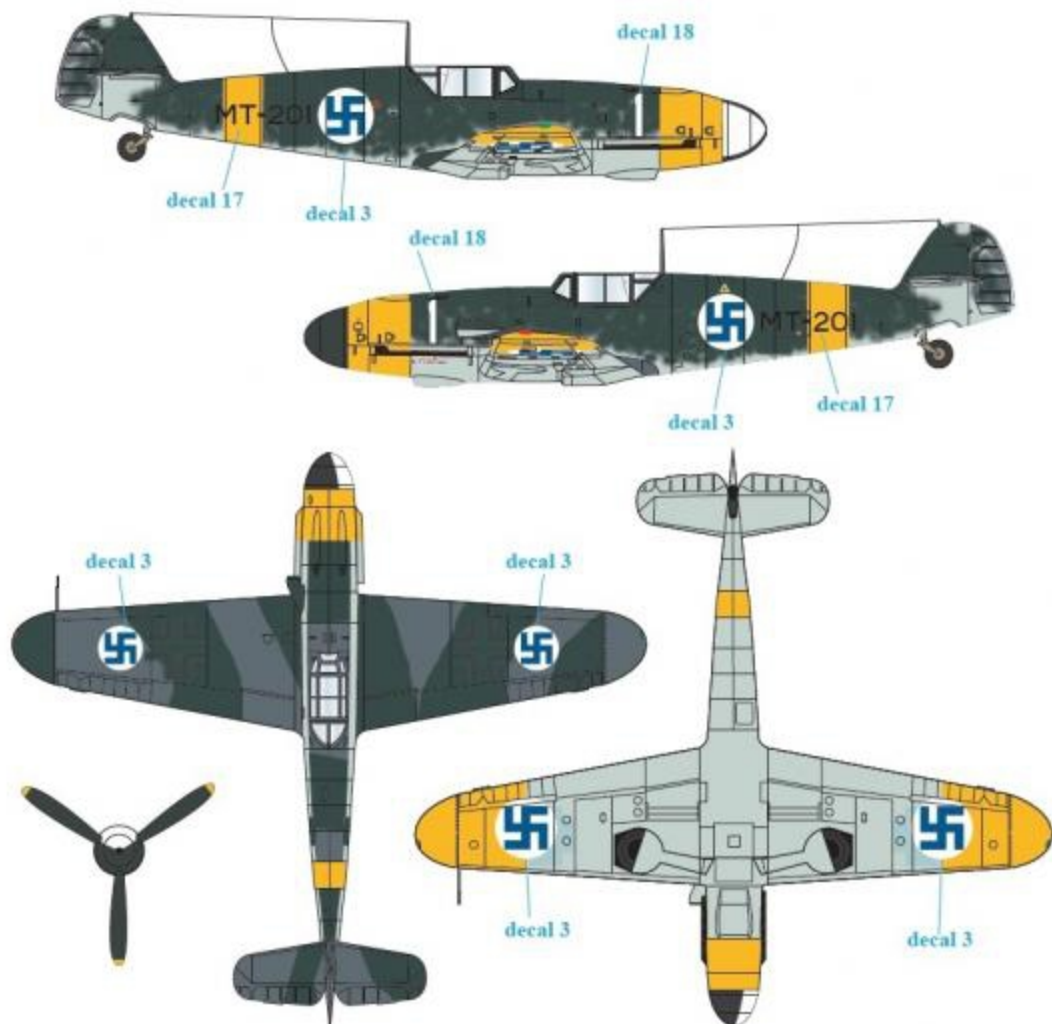
