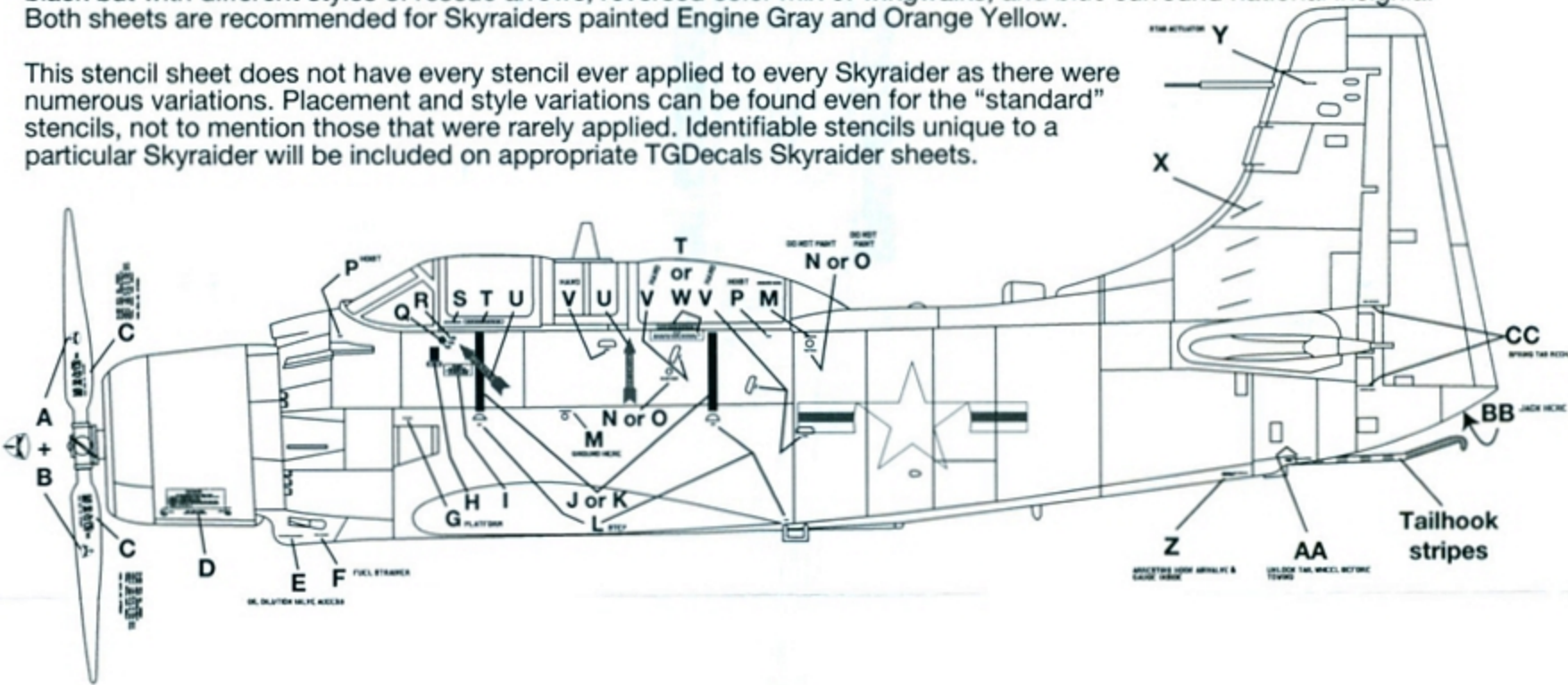

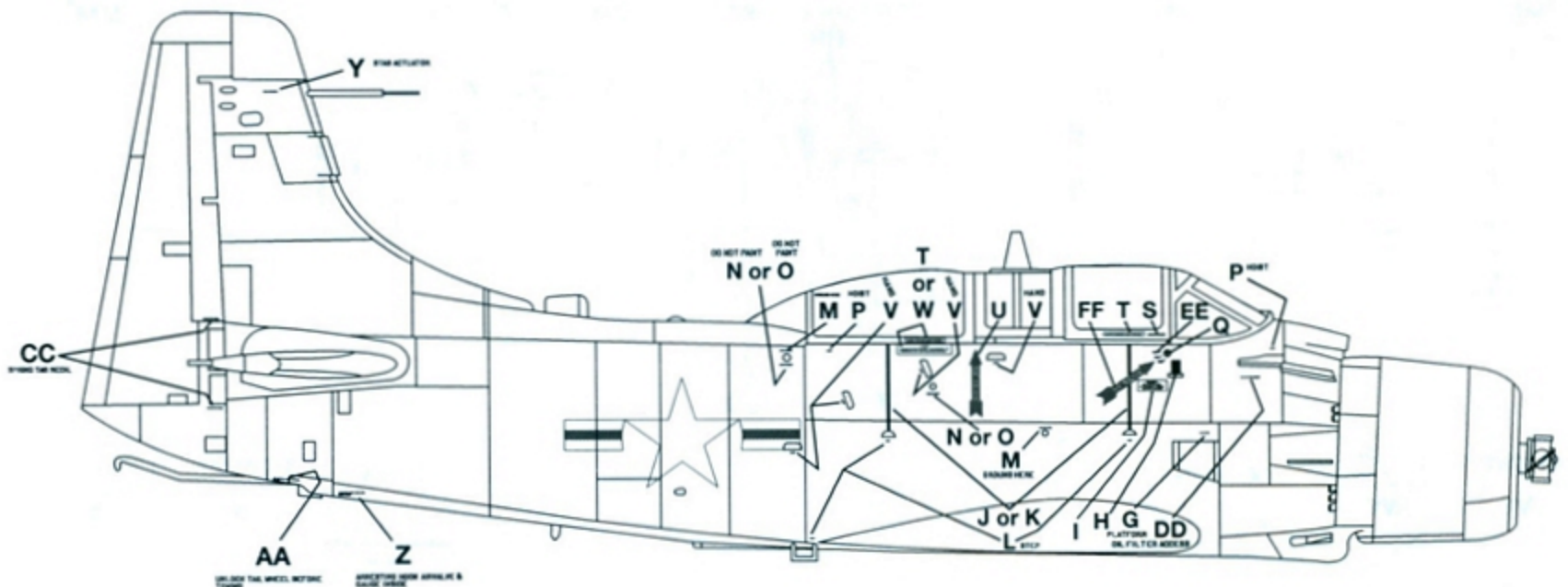
Stencils (White)

Glossy Sea Blue Skyraiders usually had black or matt Sea Blue anti-glare panels. Wingwalks, when applied, were usually black, though Matt Sea Blue and gray have been observed. Propeller blades were black. Propeller blade tips were usually yellow or striped red/white/red on the face with yellow backsides. Rescue arrows varied in size, style, color and orientation. Landing stripes (X) were usually carried on the left side of the vertical fin, though their placement varied. Please check your references before applying these stencils. This sheet may be used in conjunction with TGDecals 48-020, which features the same stencils in black but with different styles of rescue arrows, reversed color mix of wingwalks, and blue surround national insignia. Both sheets are recommended for Skyraiders painted Engine Gray and Orange Yellow.

This stencil sheet does not have every stencil ever applied to every Skyraider as there were numerous variations. Placement and style variations can be found even for the "standard" stencils, not to mention those that were rarely applied. Identifiable stencils unique to a particular Skyraider will be included on appropriate TGDecals Skyraider sheets.
