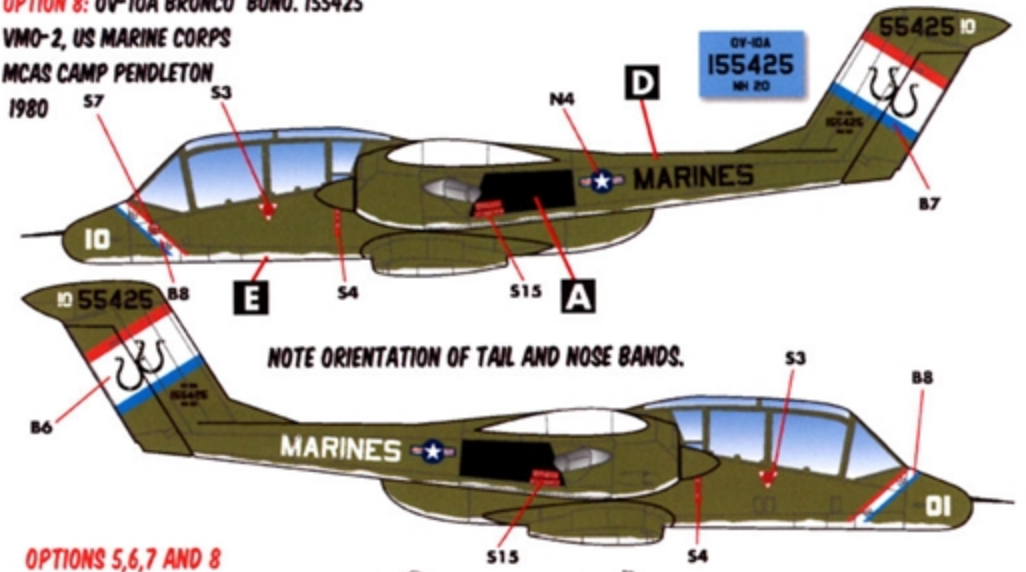

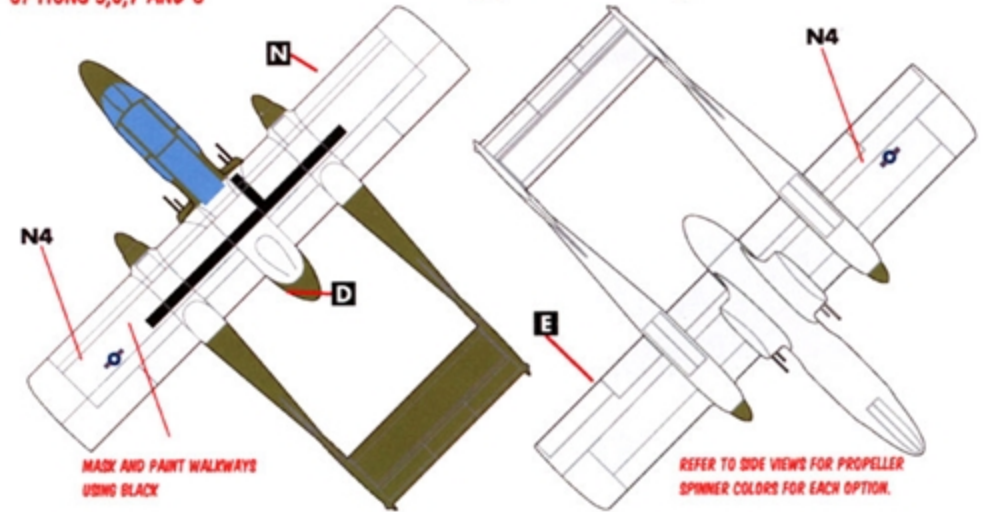

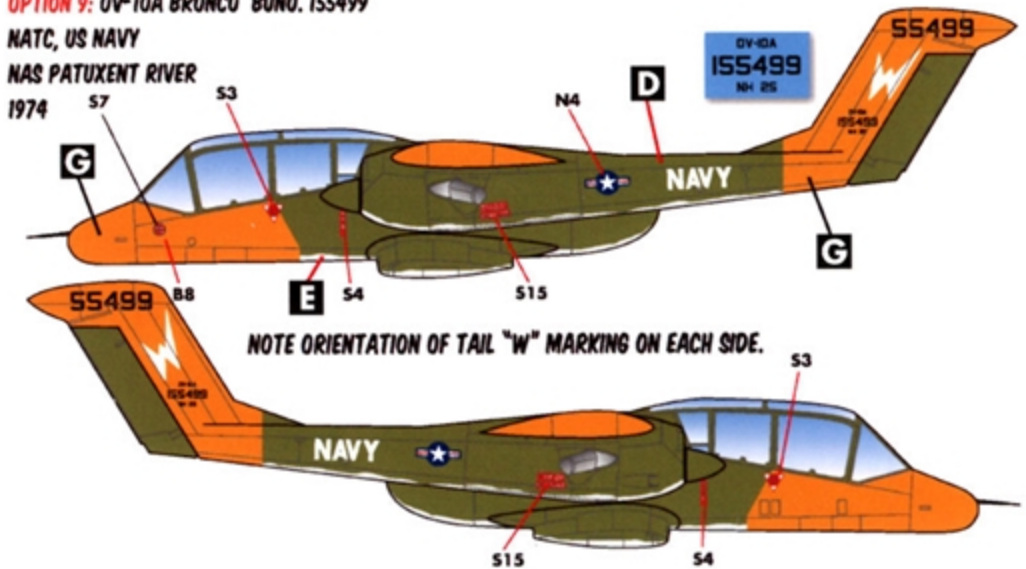

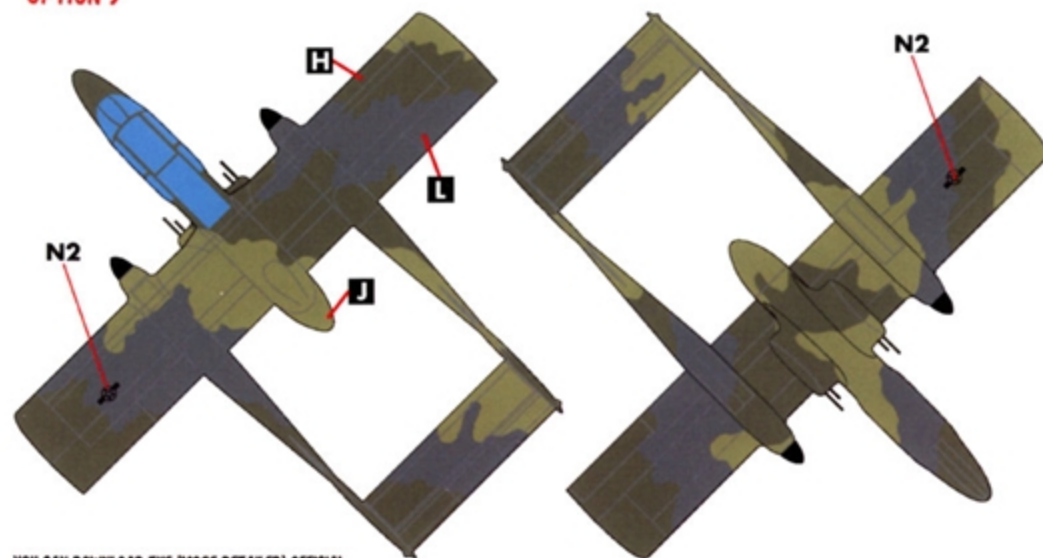

OUR DECALS REPRESENT THE AIRCRAFT BEFORE THE UPGRADE - USE STANDARD 3-BLADED PROPELLERS ON YOUR MODEL.

THE CAMOUFLAGE SCHEME ON THE INNER-FACING SIDE OF THE BOOMS IS THE SAME AS THE OUTSIDE FACE OF THE OTHER BOOM. SEE EXAMPLE BELOW:

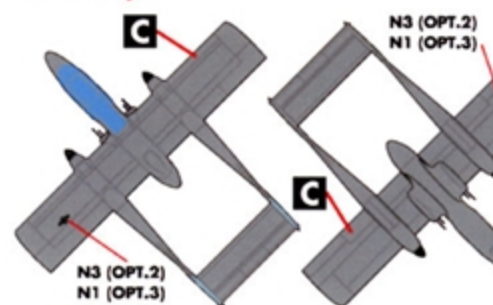
