a/c 1- F-84F-35 RE, S/N 52-6426, 163 FBS/122 FBG, Indiana Air Guard. Overall Natural Metal with OD antiglare panel. Black dorsal section and fin tip. Leading edge. Notice gun positions have been taped over with a dark colored tape, possibly Red ?. Very colorful Guard aircraft. Fotos Menard via Graser.

a/c 2- F-84F-40 GK, S/N 519524, 169 FIS/182 FIG, Peoria, ILL., Illinois Air Guard. Another overall Natural Metal aircraft with Black antiglare panel. Flat Black dorsal section and fin tip. All trim is Copper color, some edged in Black as indicated. Information provided by Lt. Col. Steve Konie via Norris Graser. Wing buzz numbers presumed to be on the wings, although they are not visible on our pictures.

NOTE: Tech order specified that US AIR FORCE, USAF and ANG-buzz should be Insignia Blue. However, it stated that if this color was not available, use Black. Talking to several sources, Norris Graser found out that both colors were widely used and that it took a very close inspection to discover the color used on that particular machine. We decided to go the Tech order way and used Insignia Blue on our decals. Notice also that some a/c had a lower belly Red stripe (decal M)
