




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
THIS AIRCRAFT IS PAINTED IN THE TYPICAL RESCUE SCHEME THAT APPEARED AROUND 1955.
THE ANTI-GLARE PANEL, DE-ICING BOOTS AND RADOME WERE BLACK.


PLEASE DO NOT FOLLOW THE TRUMPETER INSTRUCTIONS AND PAINT YELLOW WING WALKWAYS.
THE WING WALKWAYS WERE GRAY!!! USE THE WALKWAY DECALS PROVIDED.







ANOTHER AIRCRAFT IN THE RESCUE SCHEME, MODIFIED FOR USE IN ARCTIC REGIONS

THE ANTI-GLARE PANEL. DE-ICING BOOTS AND RADOME WERE BLACK.











NOTE HOW THE "US AIR FORCE" SCRIPT INTERSECTS THE PROPELLER WARNING LINE.
CUT THE WHITE PROPELLER WARNING STRIPES AND PLACE ACCORDINGLY.



THE OVERALL BLACK SCHEME WAS USED FOR AIR COMMANDO SQUADRONS DURING THE 1960S.





THIS AIRCRAFT IS PAINTED IN THE EARLY US COAST GUARD SCHEME THAT WAS BASED ON THE USAF RESCUE SCHEME OF THE PERIOD. THE MORE COLORFUL USCG SCHEMES THAT ARE GENERALLY ASSOCIATED WITH USCG ALBATROSSES DID NOT APPEAR UNTIL LATER, AFTER MOST AIRFRAMES WERE CONVERTED TO THE SA-168.

THE ANTI-GLARE PANEL, DE-ICING BOOTS AND RADOME WERE BLACK.
