












Assembly Instructions

I recommend that the white decal be applied first, then the yellow piece over the top. This will minimize the tendency of the blue paint to bleed through the yellow decal, and alter the All 'Caledonian Yellow' decal components are provided with a corresponding white copy. RB

Assemble the model according to the instructions provided with the kit Painting the Model


