Winged Ace of Clubs P-51D-15-NA 44-15422 B6 ★ F 363rd FS

Pilot: Major Donald Bochkay. Assigned as one of the originals of the 357th, Bochkay would be credited with 13.5 enemy aircraft during two tours. He was one of the very few aces to be credited with the destruction of two Me 262 jets.

Colors: Overall natural metal. OD glare panel. Rudder: Red. Black ID bands not applied.

Pilot: Major Tommy Hayes Jr. Seeing action in the Pacific and European Theaters, this 8.5 victory ace would have two Japanese flags painted on his colorful P-51. They represent two victories with the 17th Pursuit Squadron while stationed on Java.

Colors: Uppersurfaces: Likely RAF Green though OD a possibility.

Undersurfaces: Likely RAF Gray though Neutral Gray a possibility.

White ID bands on upper and lower surfaces of wings and horizontal stabilizer.

Black and White invasion stripes lower rear fuselage only.
