


Suggested Kit: Revell Monogram 1/48 scale Invader.

B-26B Invader, 44-34552, "Brown Nose", 731st Bomb Squadron, 452nd Bomb Group, Pusan, Republic of Korea, mid-1951. Overall Olive Drab camouflage. Wing and vertical tail tips are White. Prop hubs Natural Metal. Relatively fresh paint with little fading or chipping.

B-26B, 44-34317, "Jersey Bounce", 90th Bomb Squadron, 3rd Bomb Group, Korea, 1952. Overall Natural Metal with Yellow tips on wings, vertical tail and horizontal stabilizers. Engine nacelles Black with forward portion in Natural Metal. Red prop warning stripe. Heavy Brownish Grey exhaust staining on the Black nacelles was common. Note lower gun turret. Glass nose retrofitted to this aircraft.


A-26B Invader, 44-34553, Hollywood Hangover, 728th Bomb Squadron, 452nd Bomb Group, Miho AB, Japan, 1950. Overall Natural Metal with Olive Drab anti-glare panel. Wing, tail and stabilizer tips are bright Green (approx. F.S. 14193). Prop hub natural metal.
