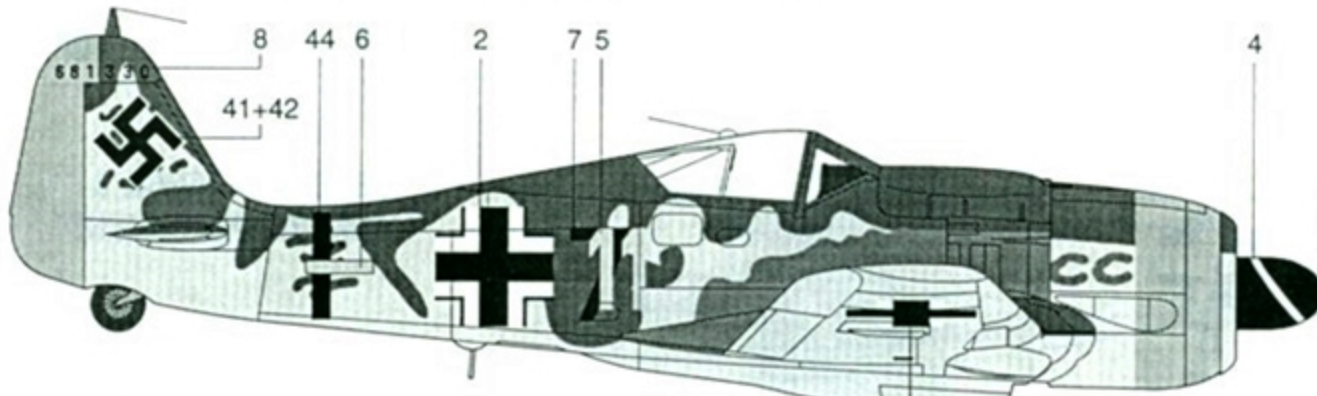

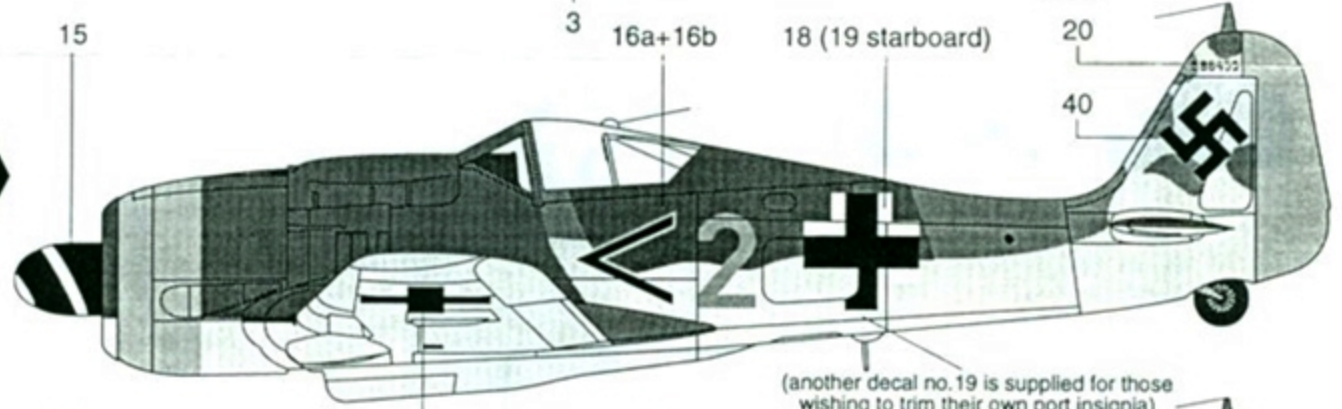

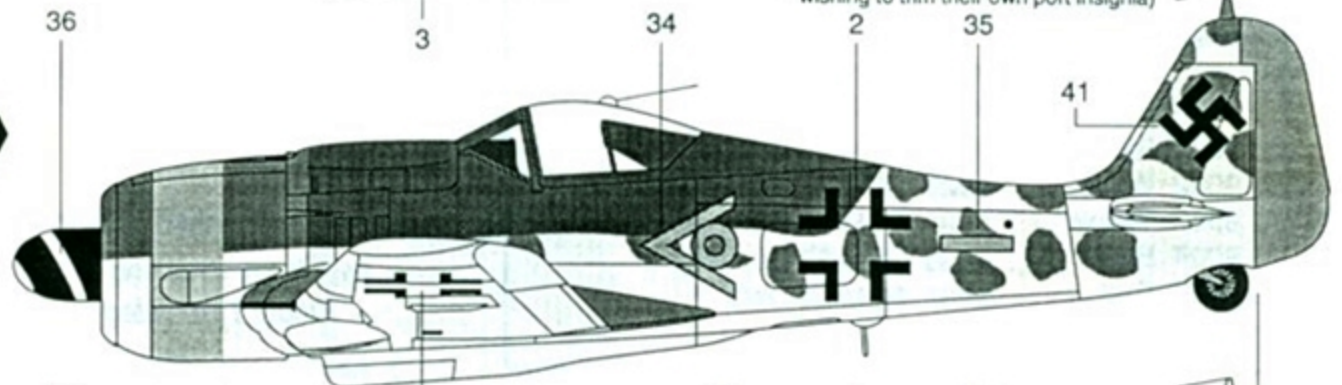

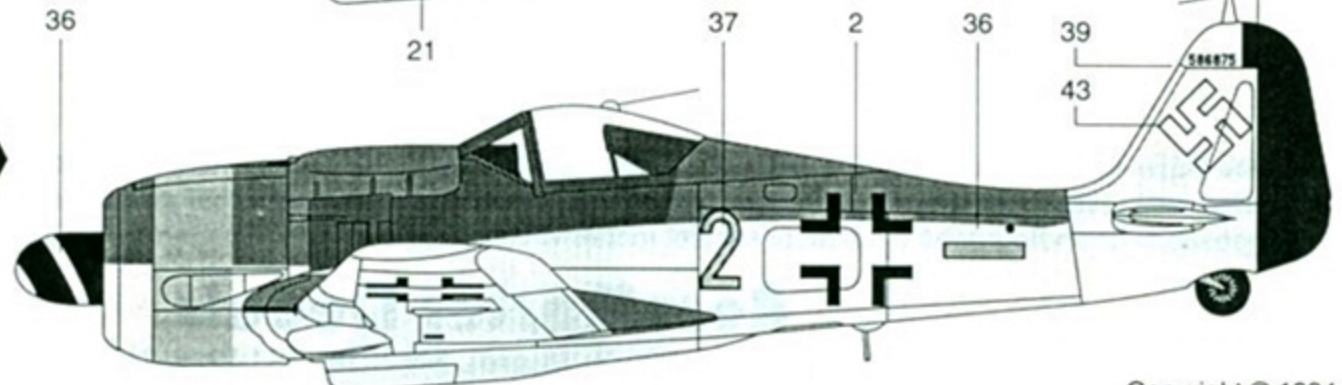

Focke-Wulf Fw190F-9, unknown ground attack unit, Spring, 1945. Scheme is RLM 74 Graugrün and RLM 75 Grauviolet over RLM 76 Lichtblau. Black spinner with RLM 04 yellow cowl band and RLM 23 red rudder.
